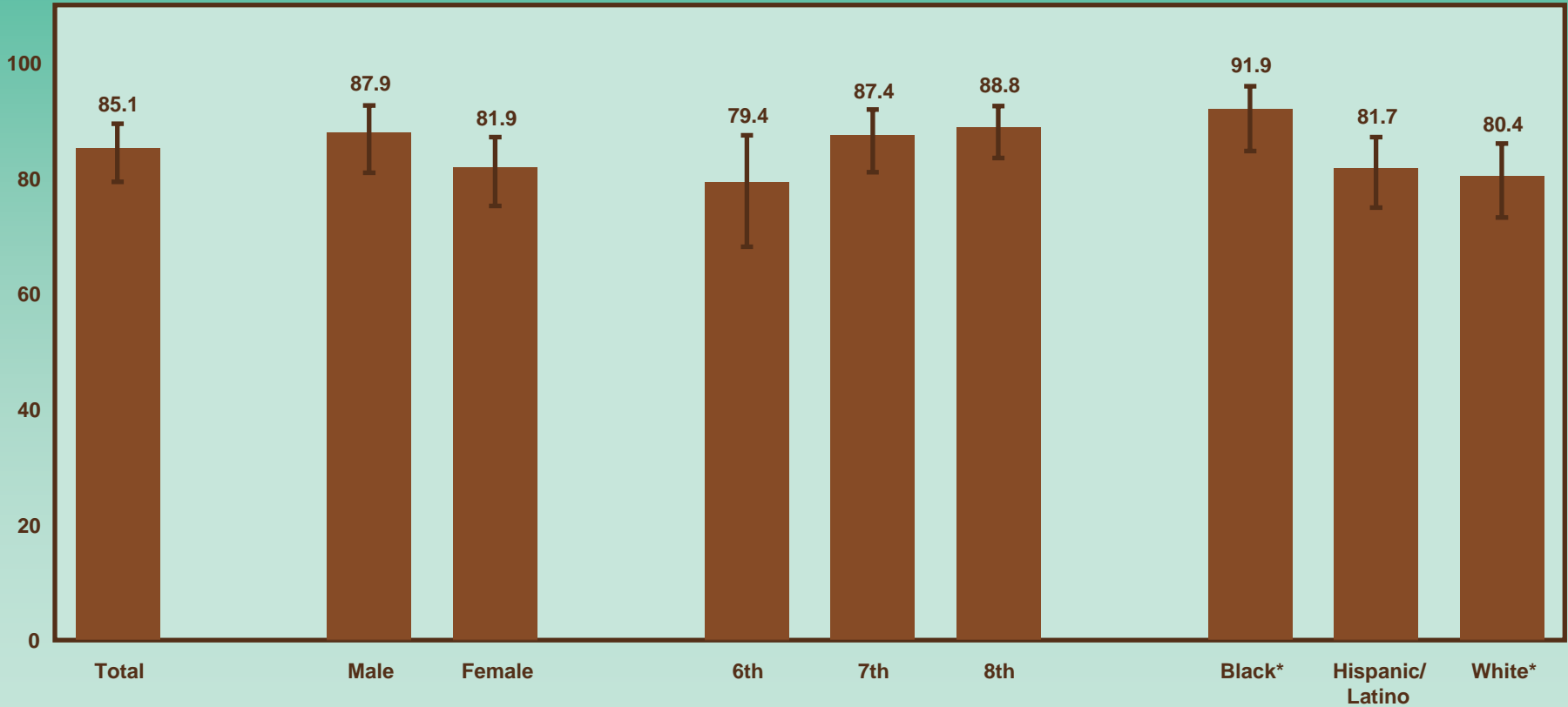

Among students who rode a bicycle, the percentage who never or rarely wore a bicycle helmet

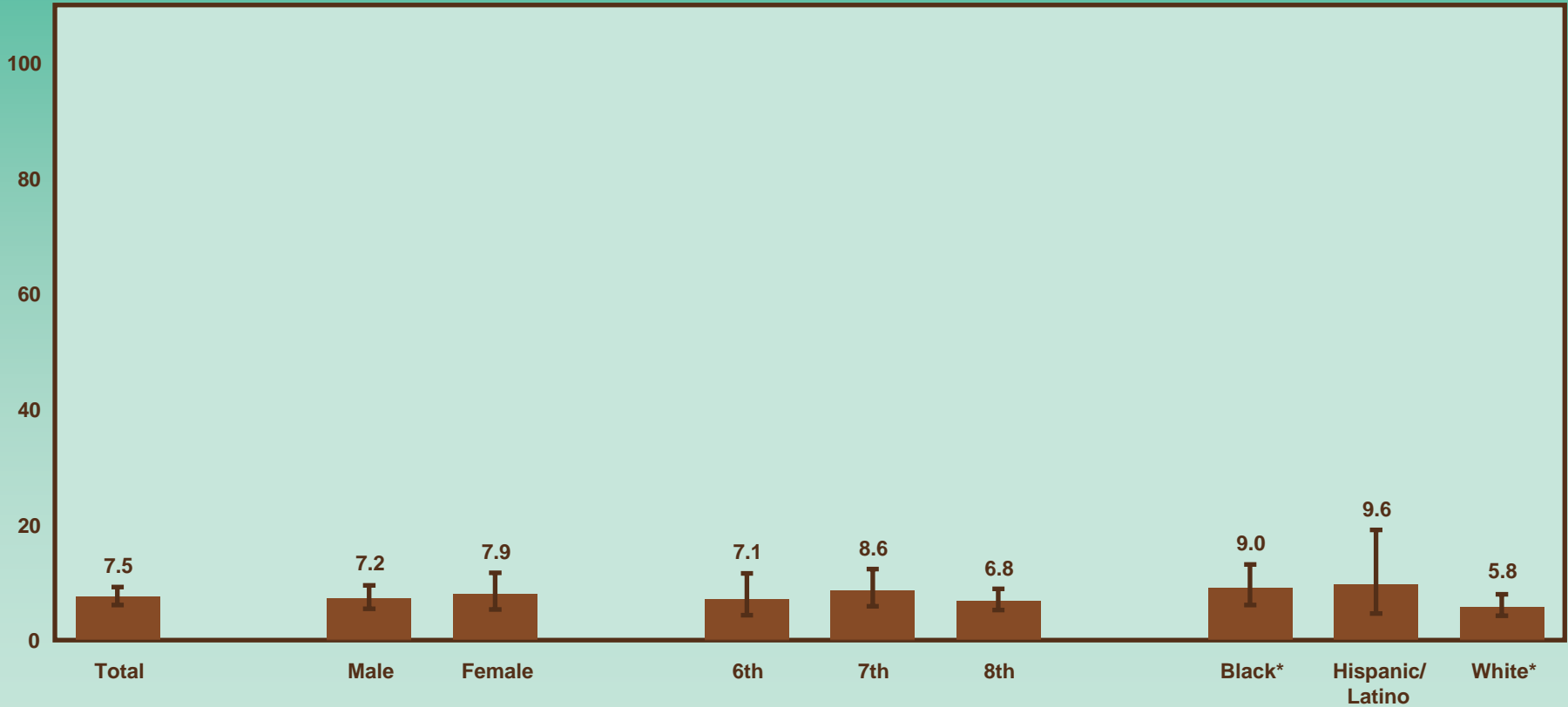

Percentage of students who never or rarely wore a seat belt when riding in a car



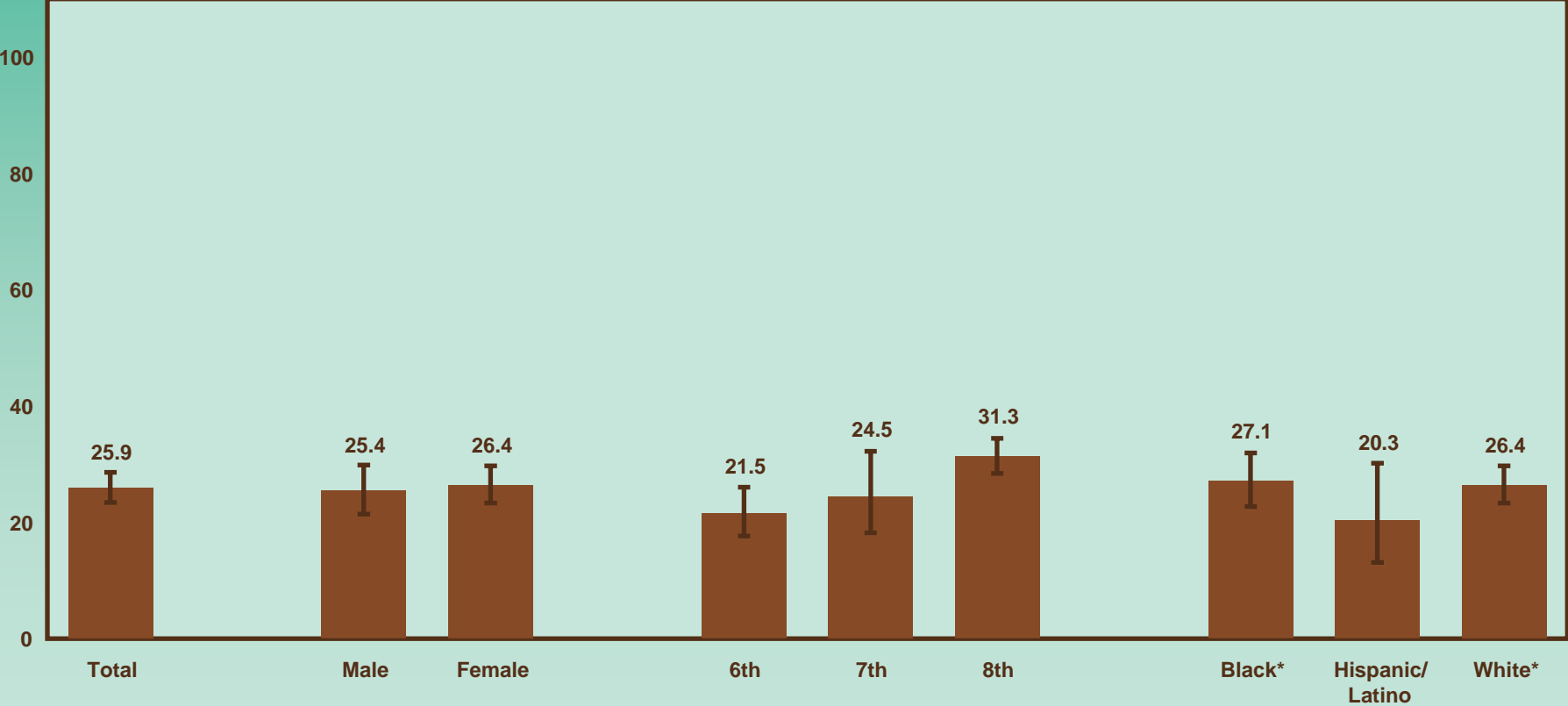

Percentage of students who ever rode in a car driven by someone who had been drinking alcohol

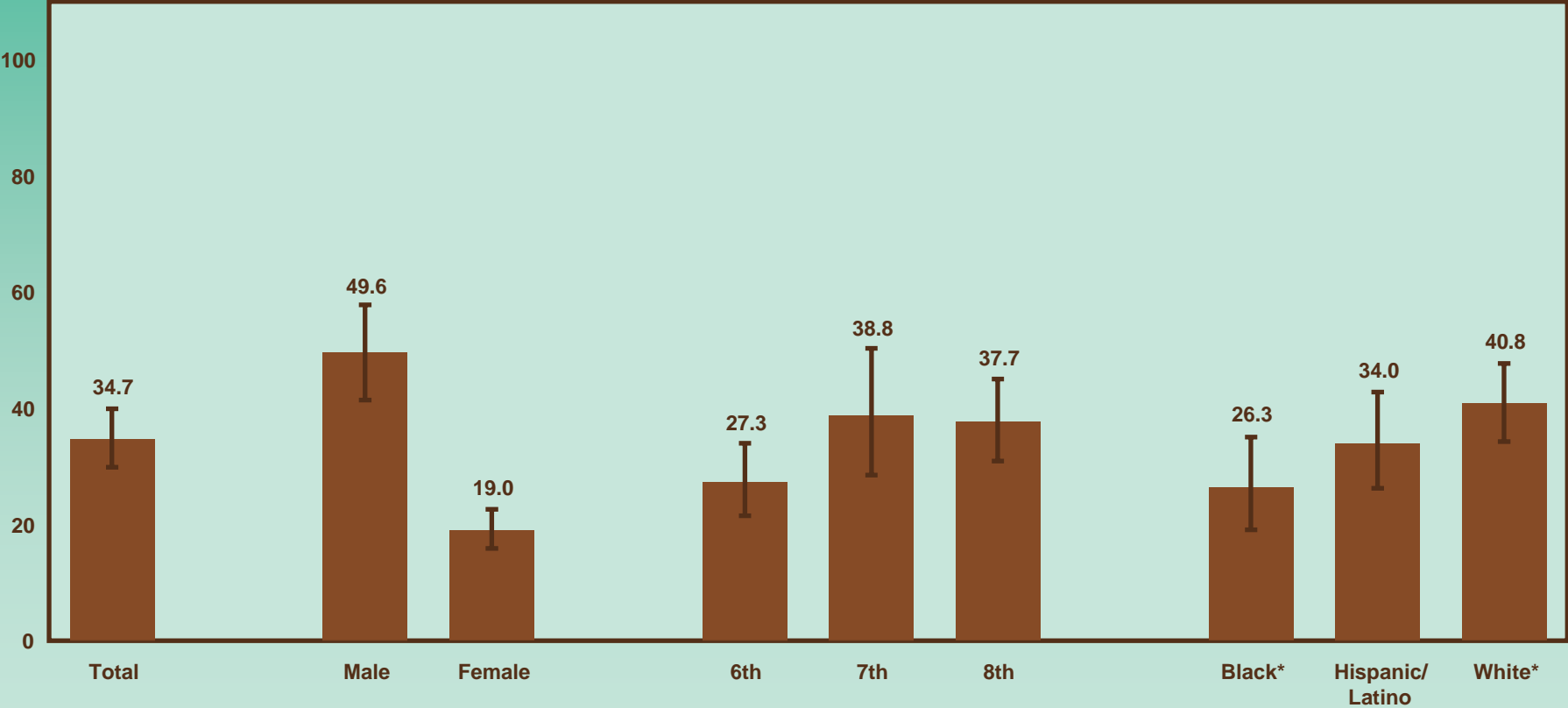

Percentage of students who ever carried a weapon, such as a gun, knife, or club

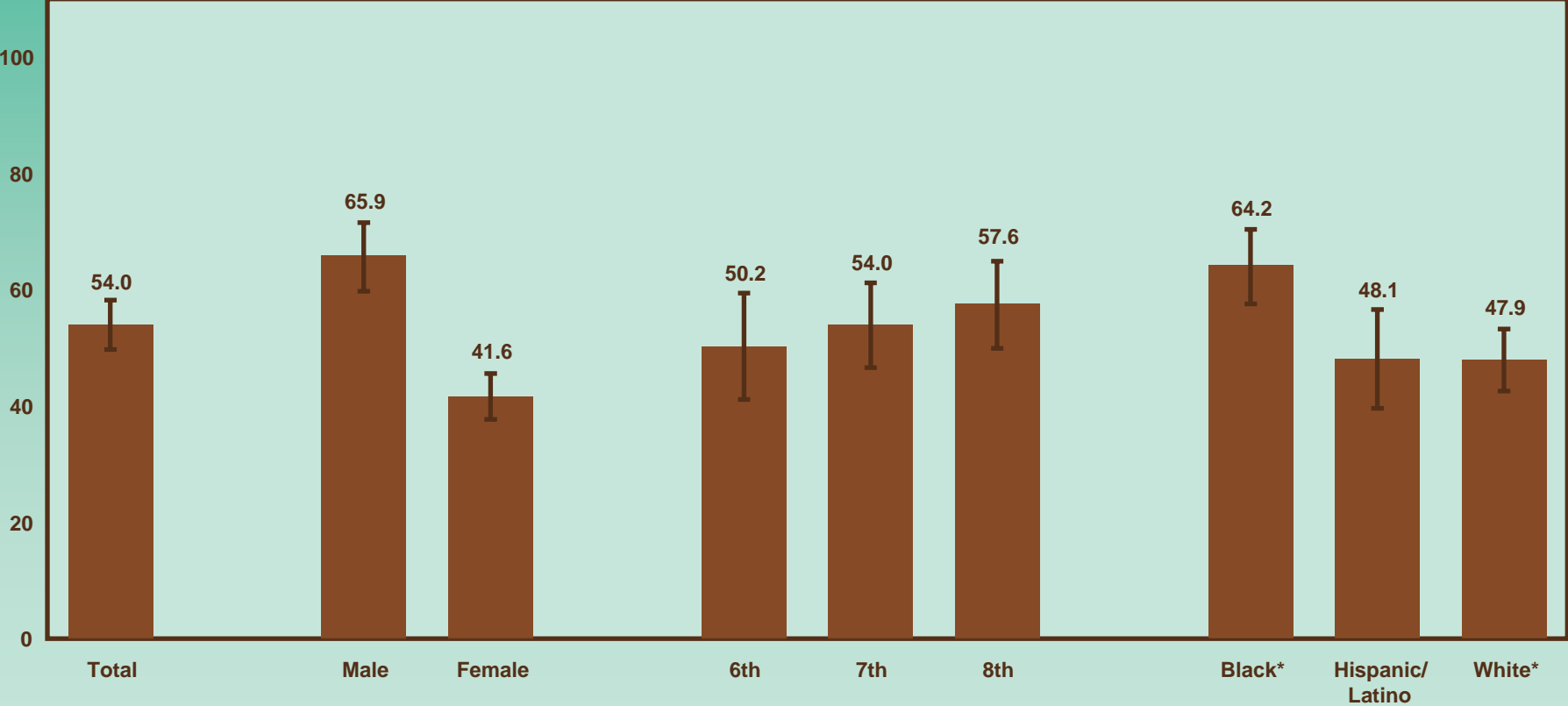

Percentage of students who have ever been in a physical fight

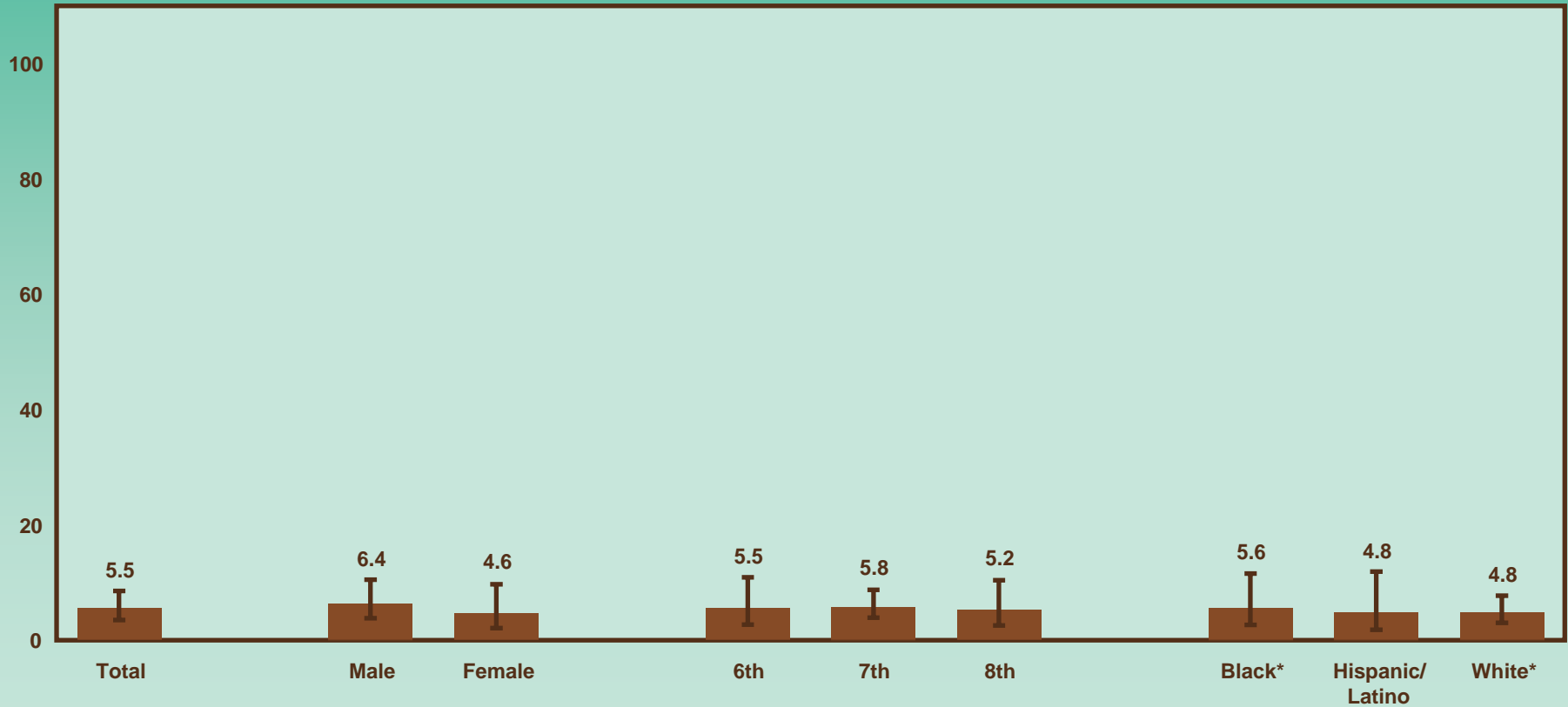

Percentage of students who were ever in a physical fight in which they were hurt and had to be treated by a doctor or nurse

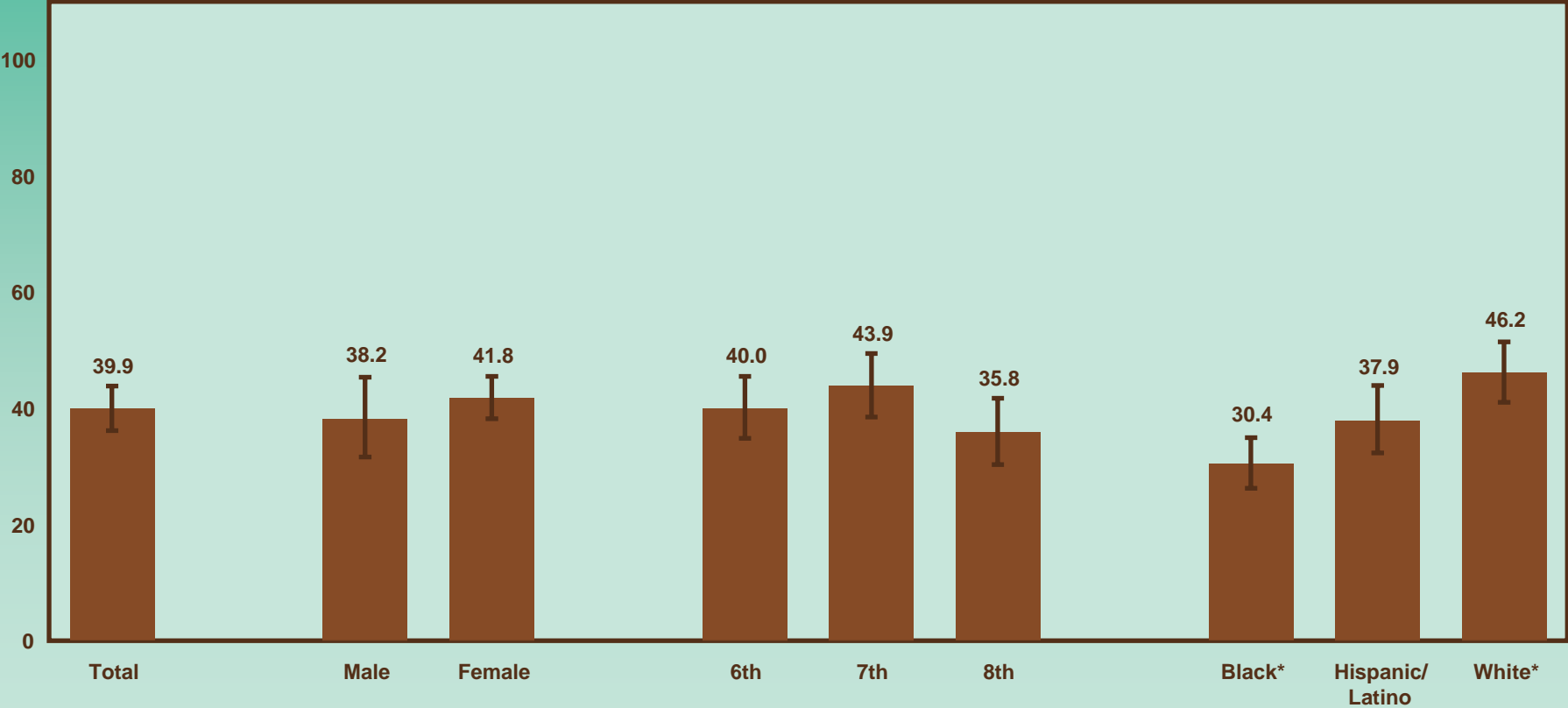

Percentage of students who had ever been bullied on school property

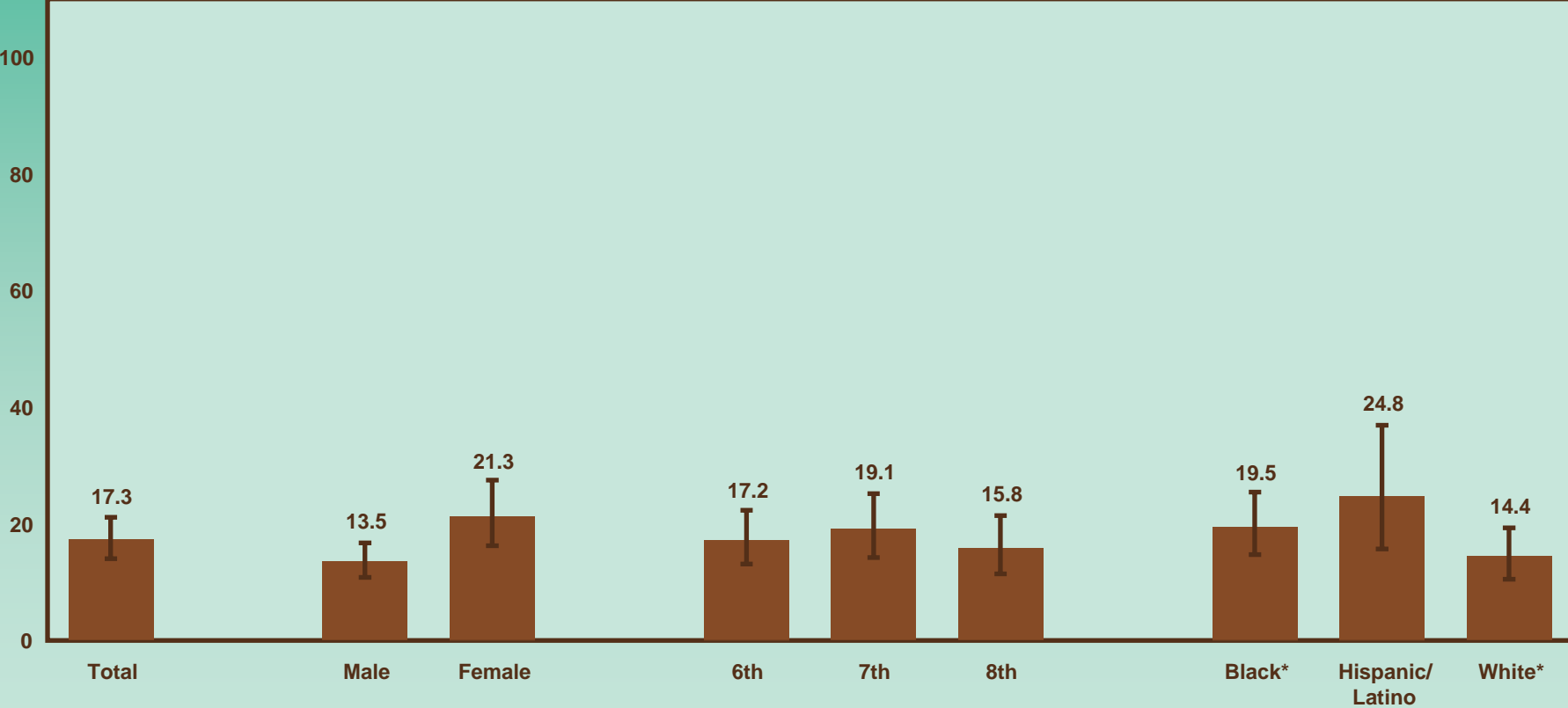

Percentage of students who ever seriously thought about killing themselves

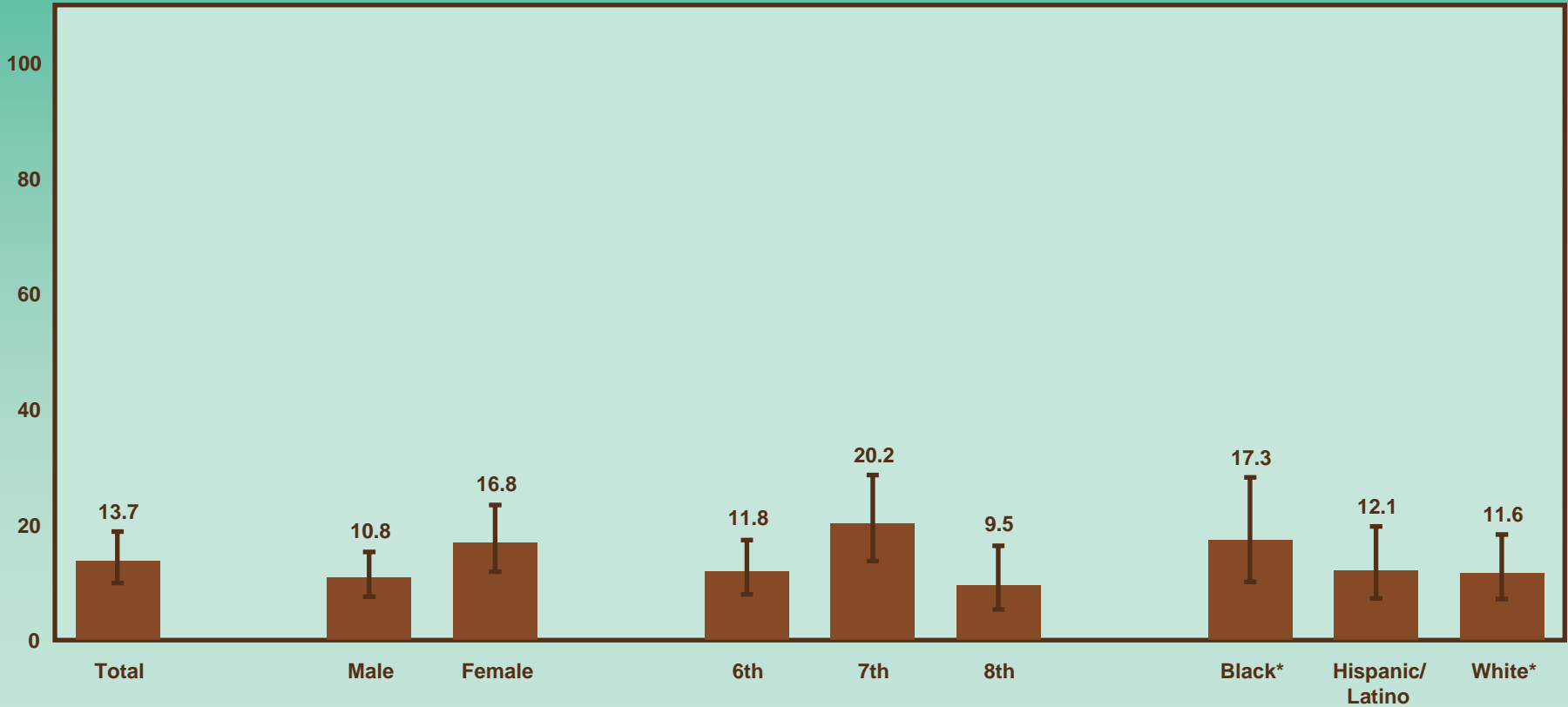

Percentage of students who ever made a plan about how they would kill themselves

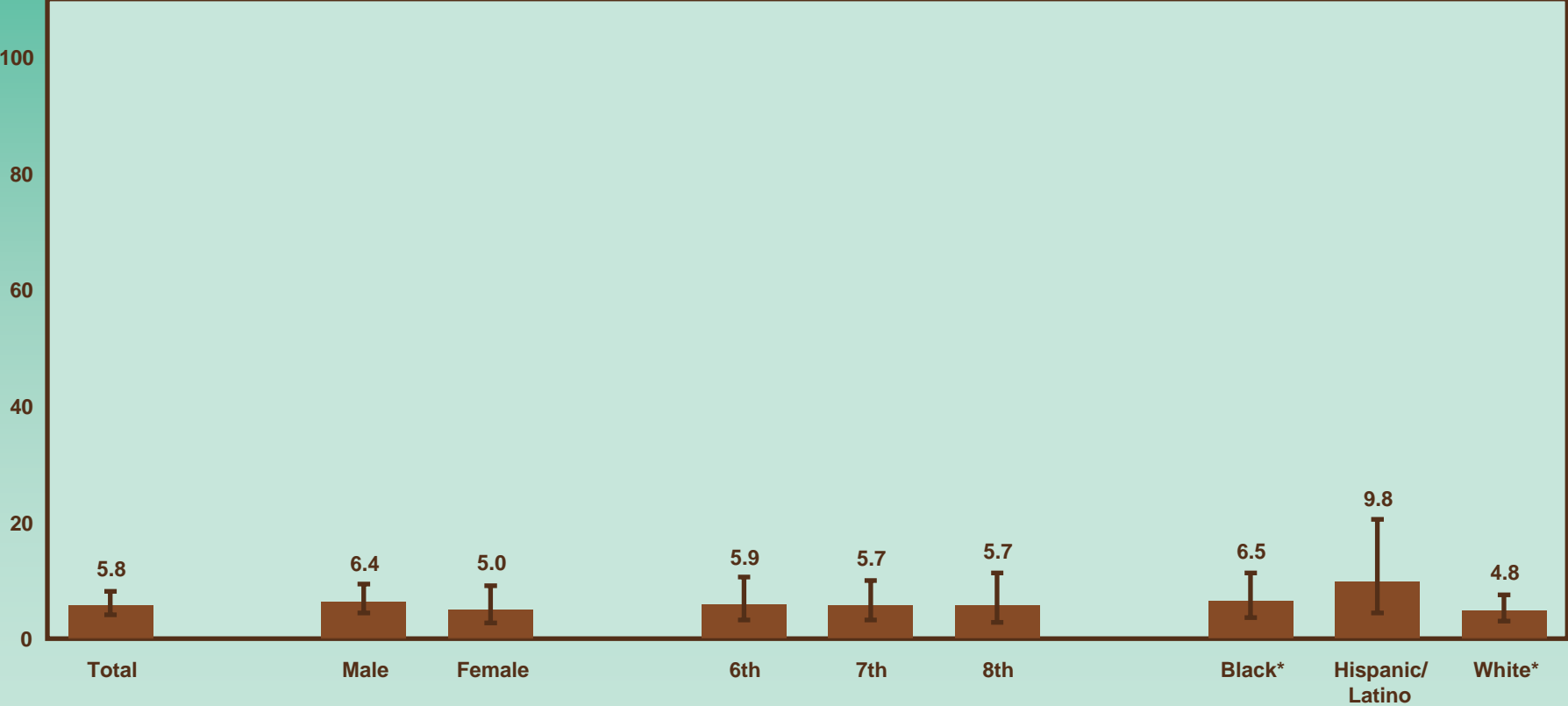

Percentage of students who smoked a whole cigarette for the first time before age 11 years

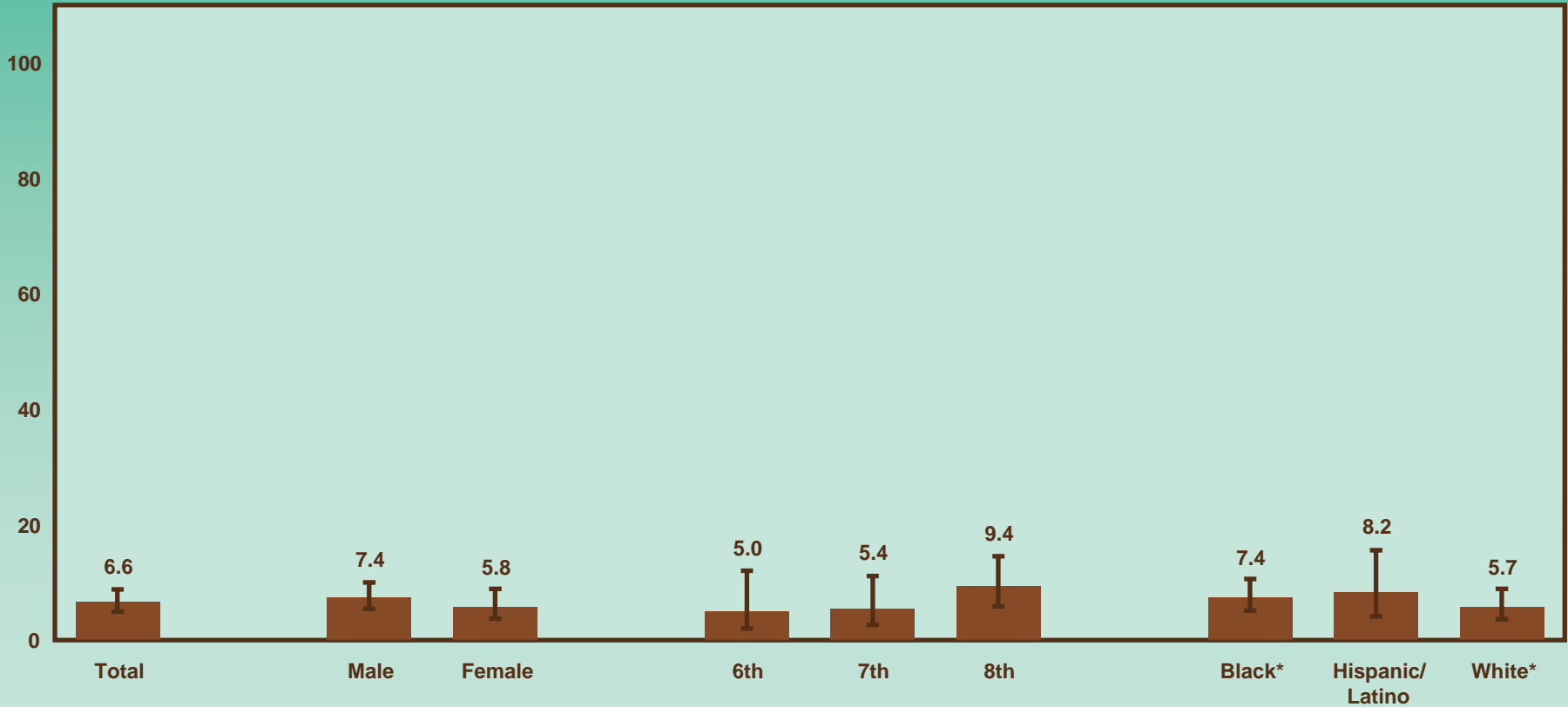

Percentage of students who smoked cigarettes on one or more of the past 30 days



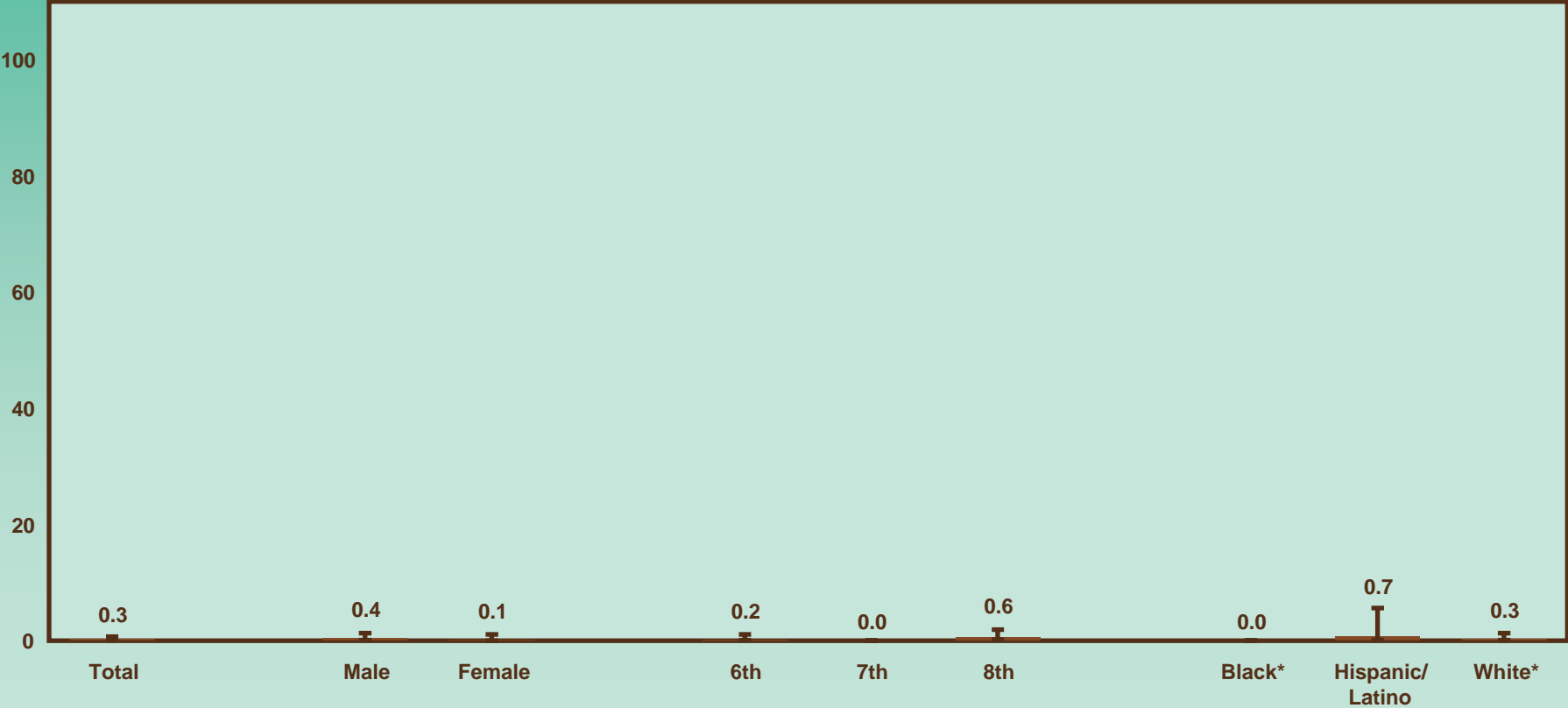

Percentage of students who smoked cigarettes on 20 or more of the past 30 days

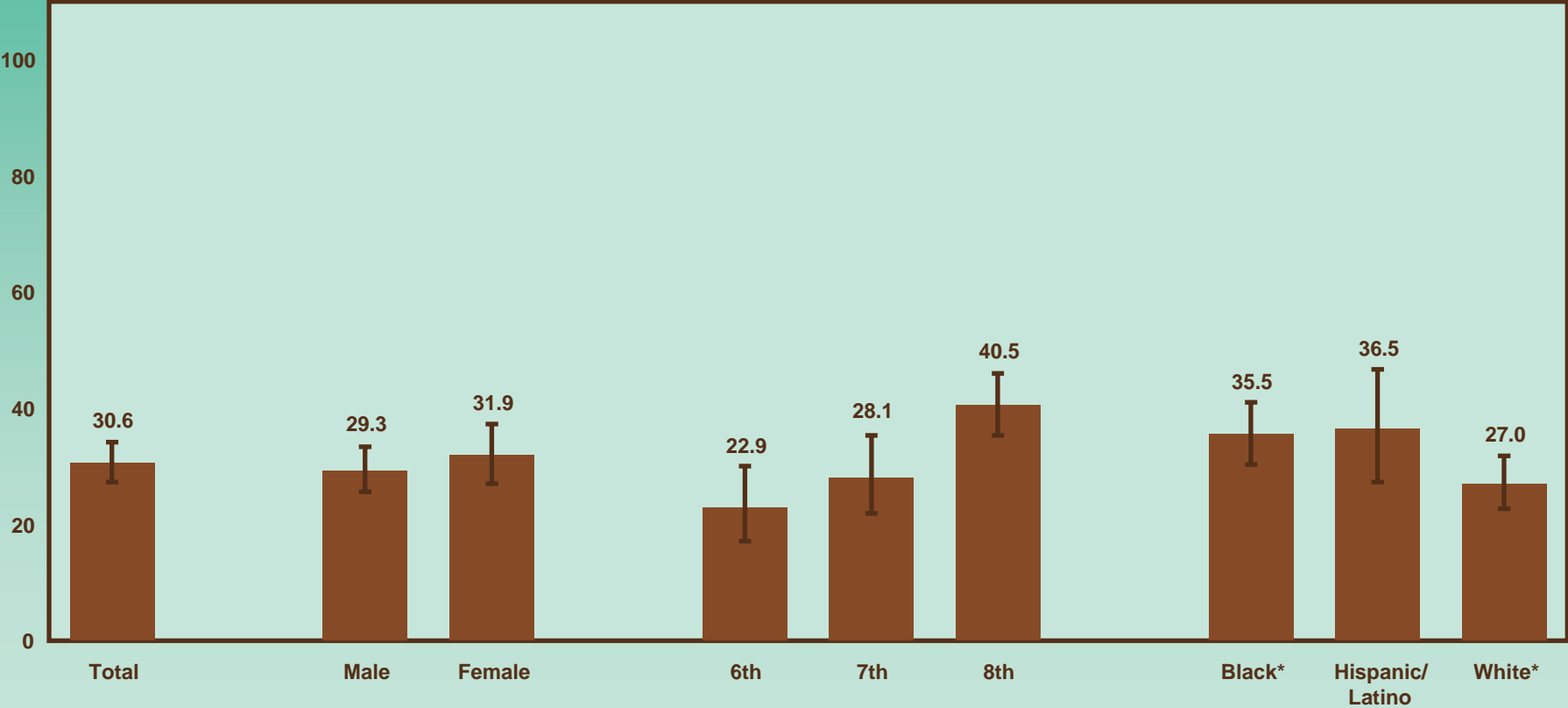

Percentage of students who ever had a drink of alcohol, other than a few sips

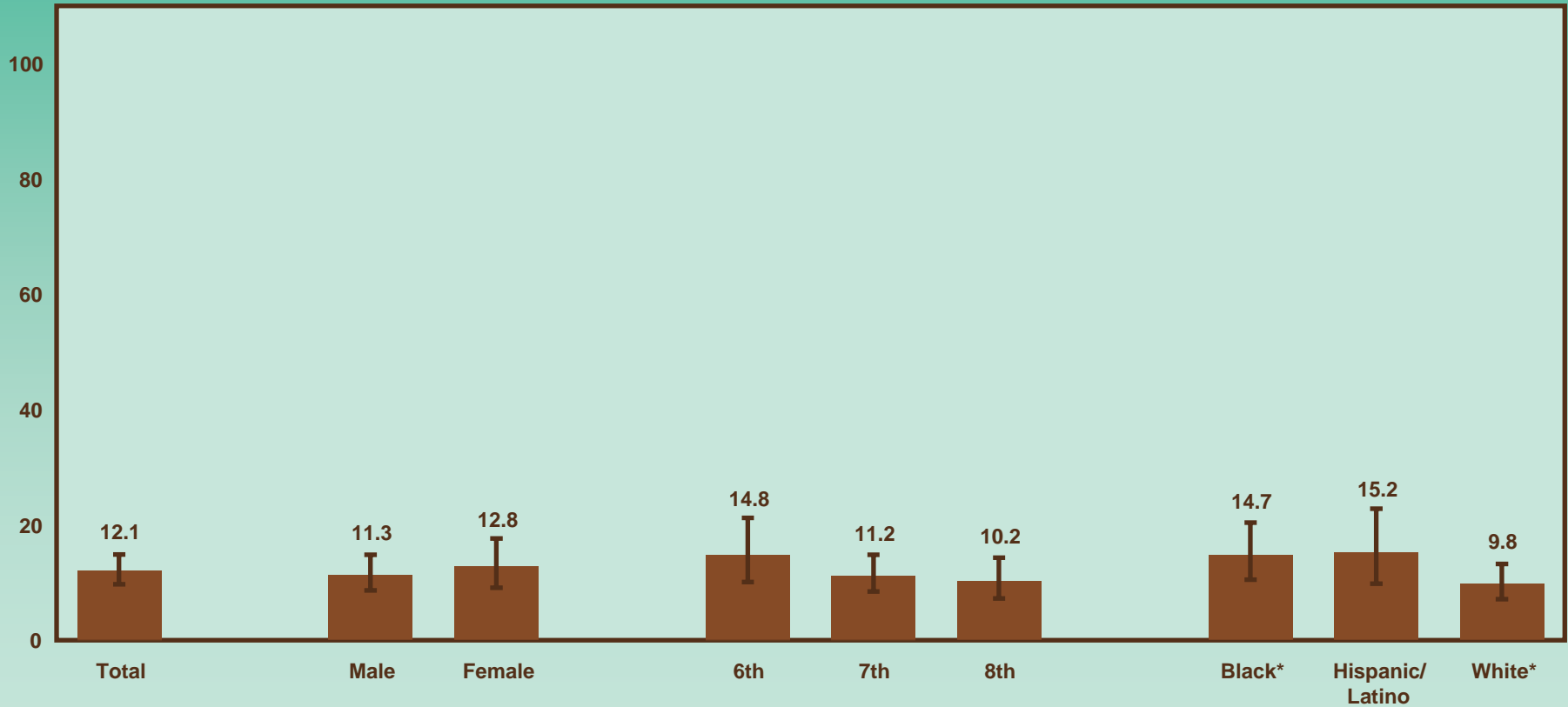

Percentage of students who had their first drink of alcohol other than a few sips before age 11 years



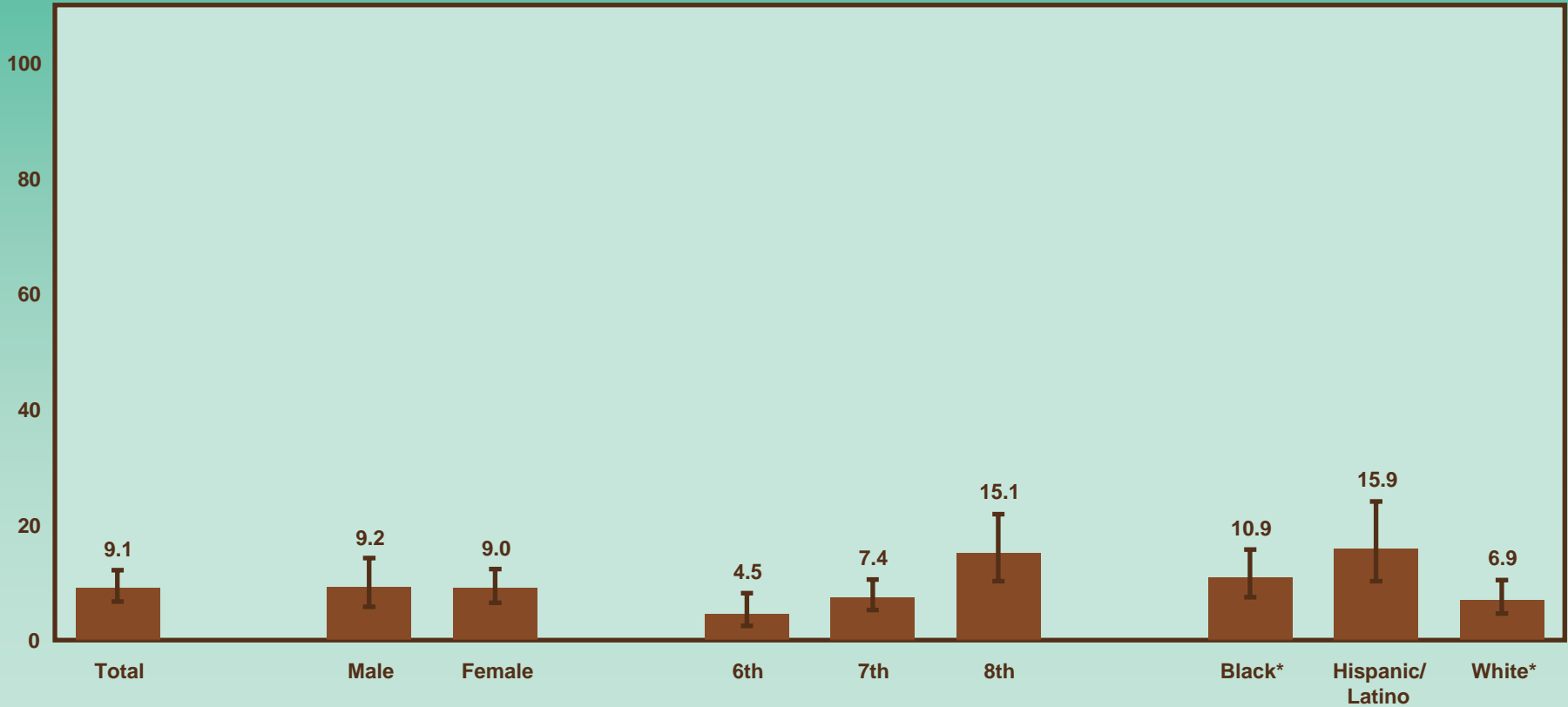

Percentage of students who ever used marijuana

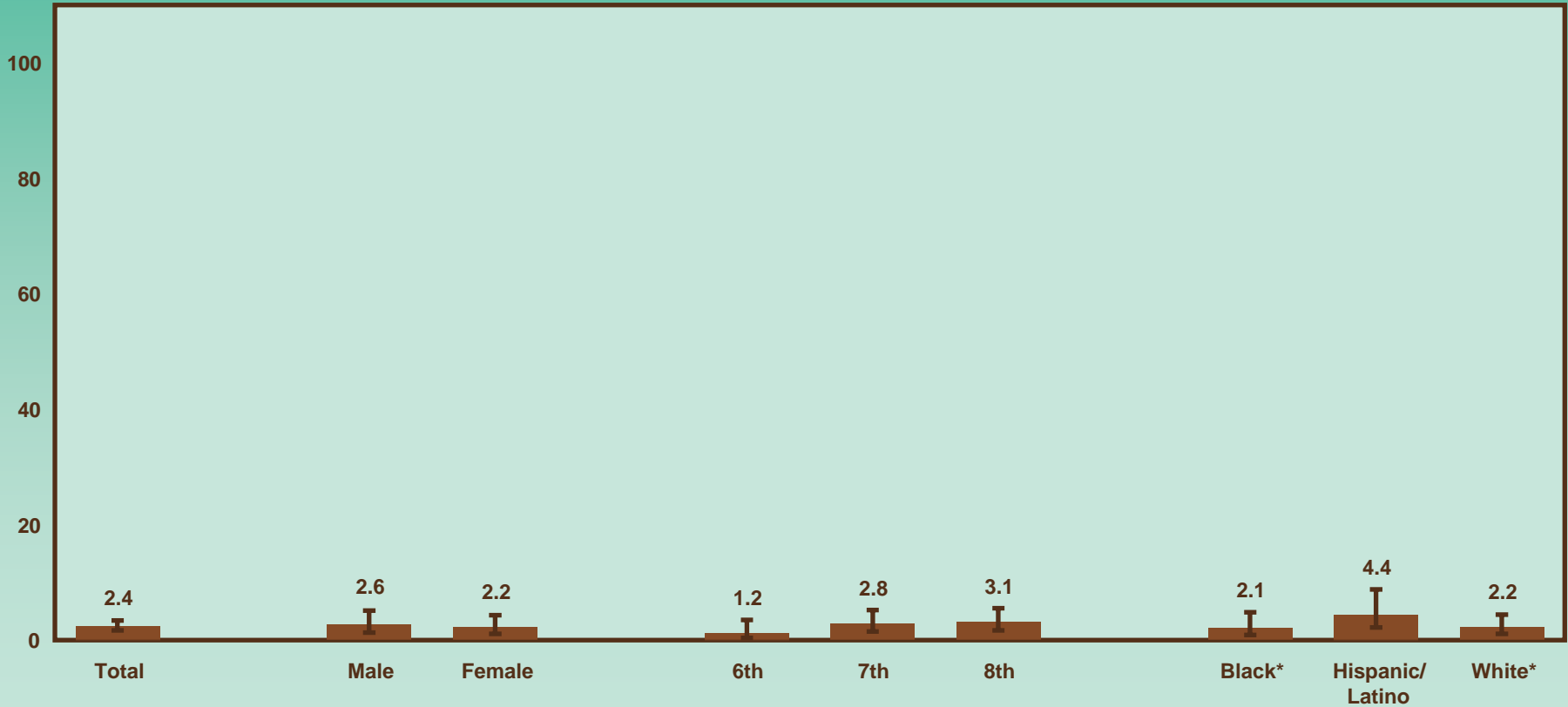

Percentage of students who tried marijuana for the first time before age 11 years

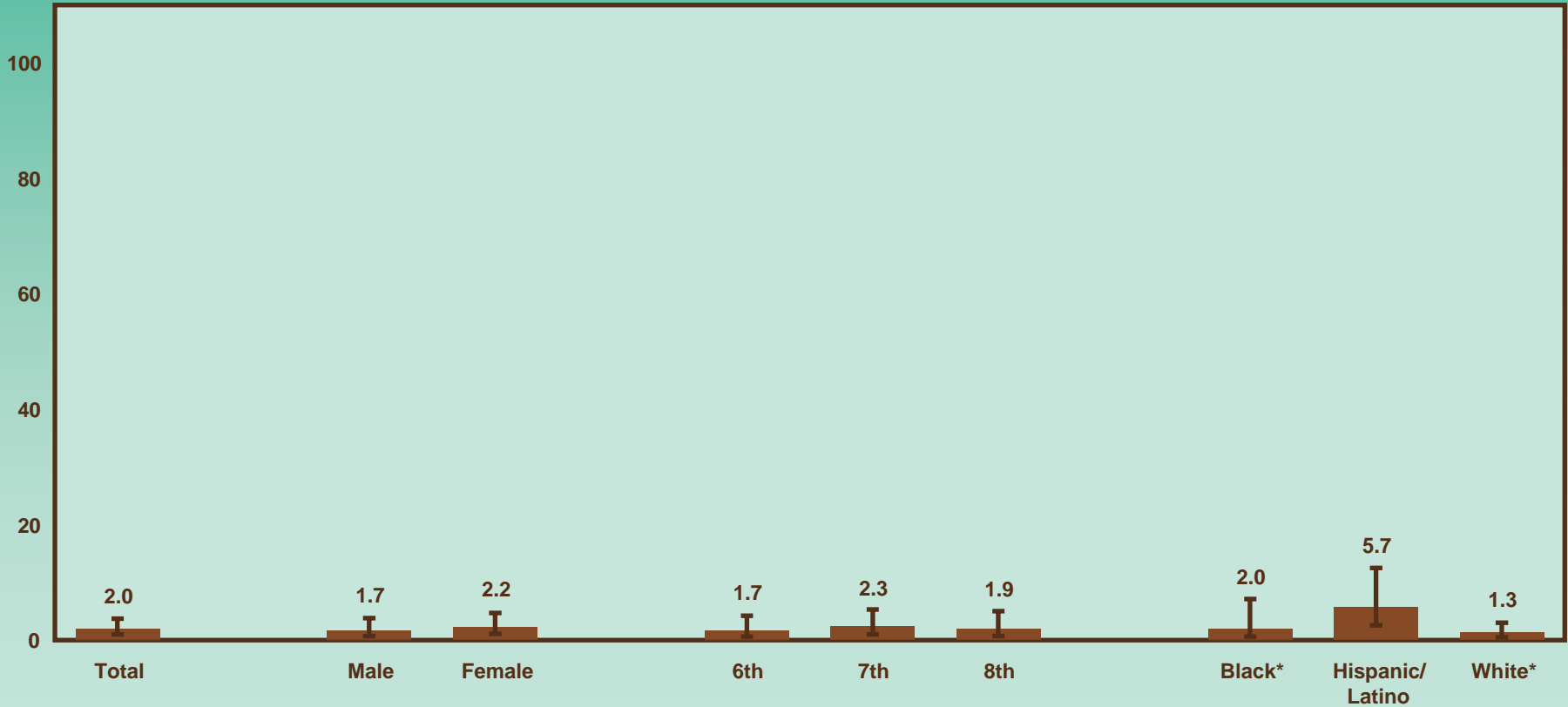

Percentage of students who ever used any form of cocaine, including powder, crack, or freebase

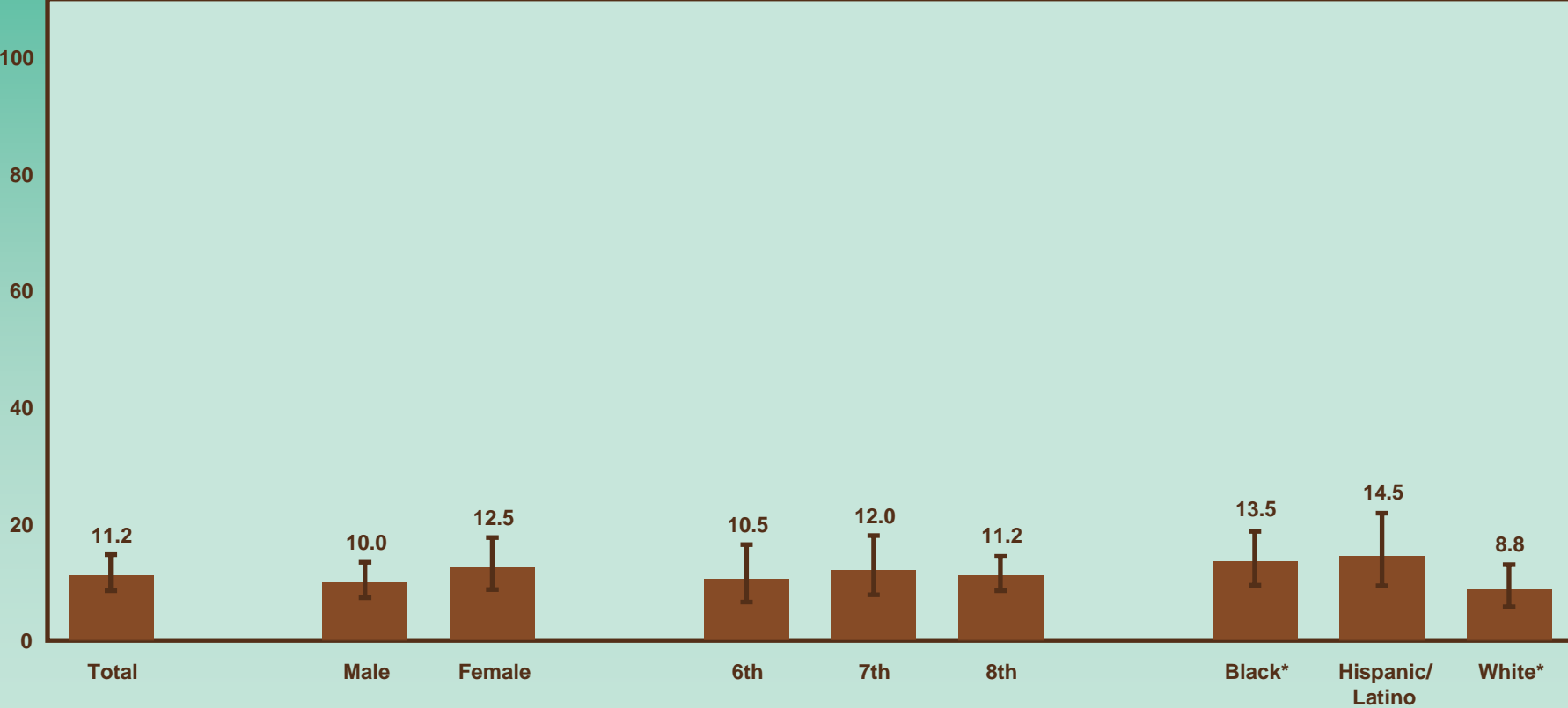

Percentage of students who ever sniffed glue, breathed the contents of spray cans, or inhaled any paints or sprays to get high

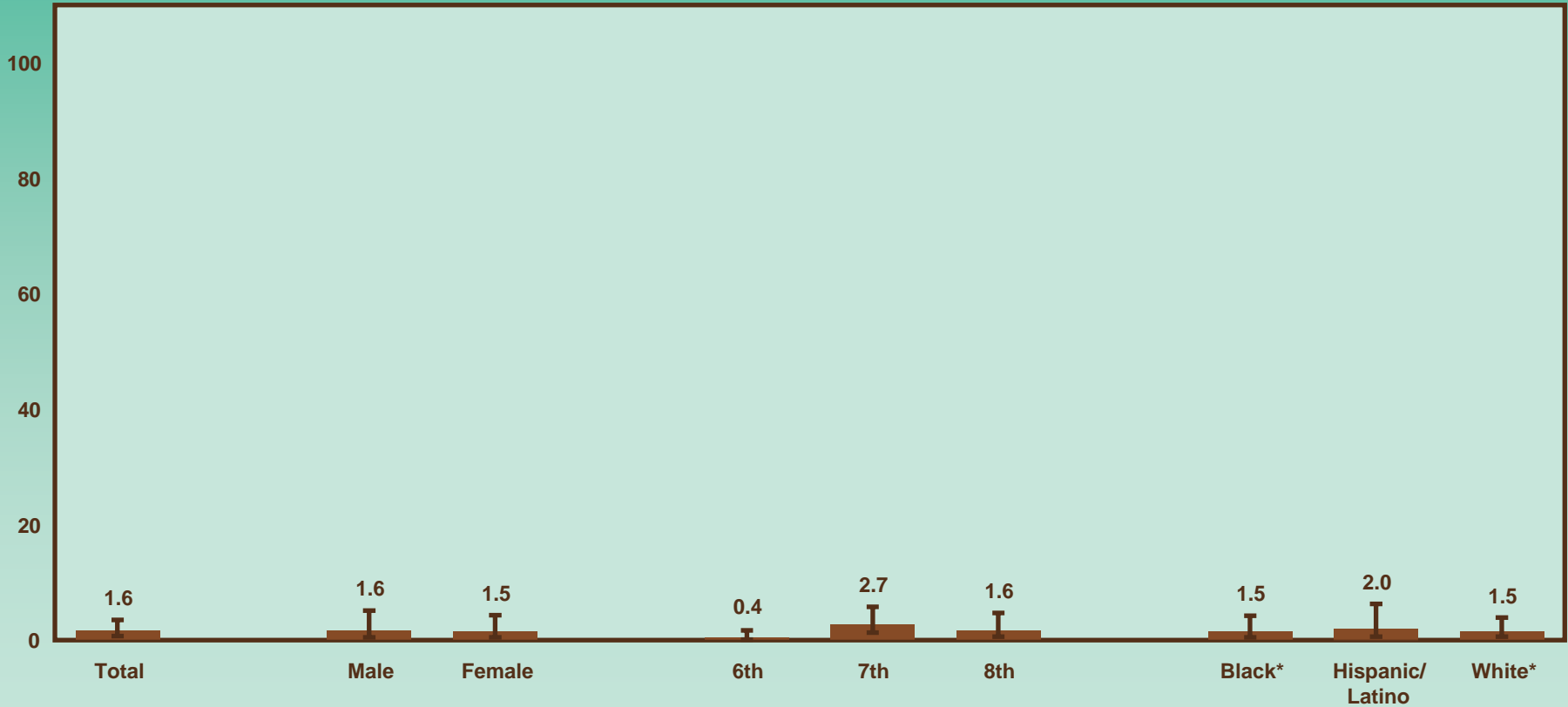

Percentage of students who ever used steroid pills or shots without a doctor's prescription

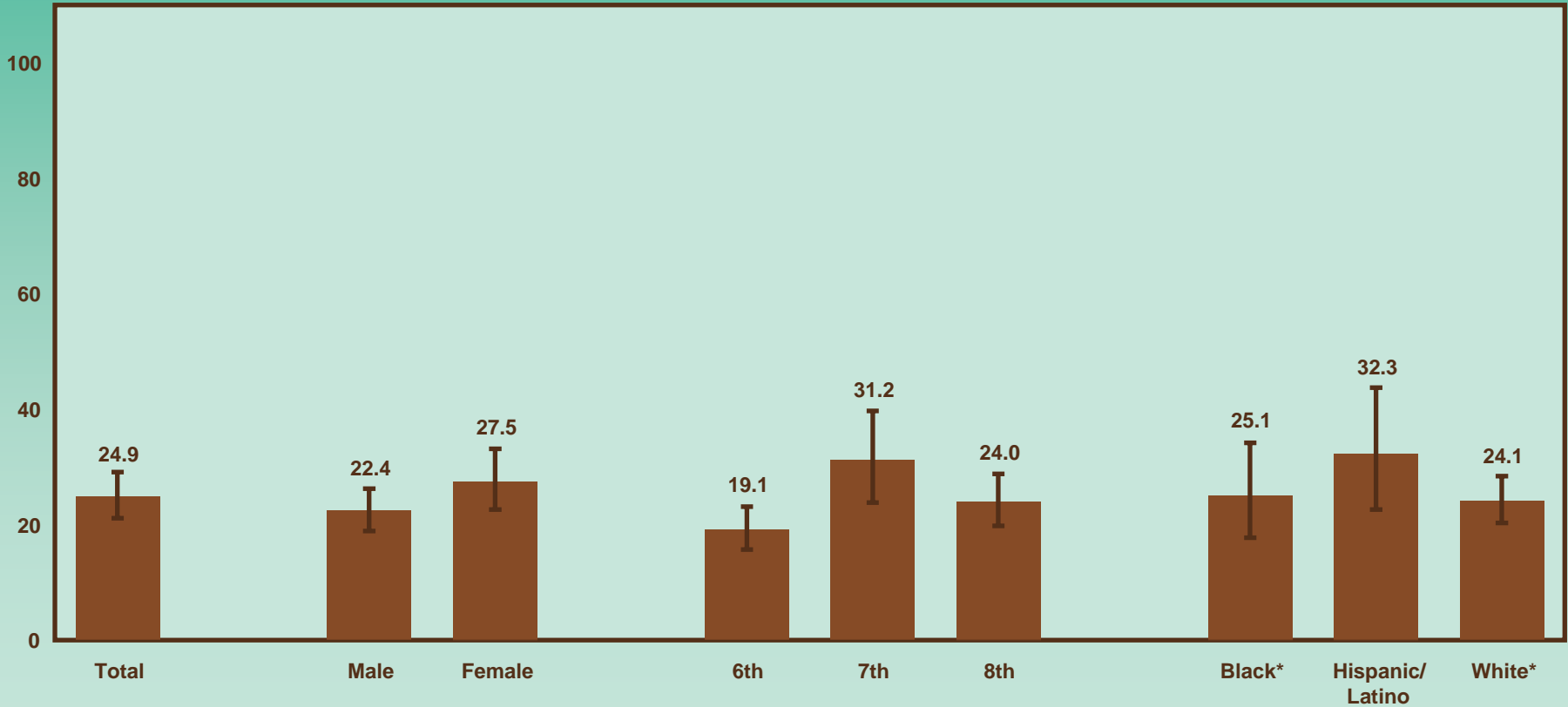

Percentage of students who described themselves as slightly or very overweight



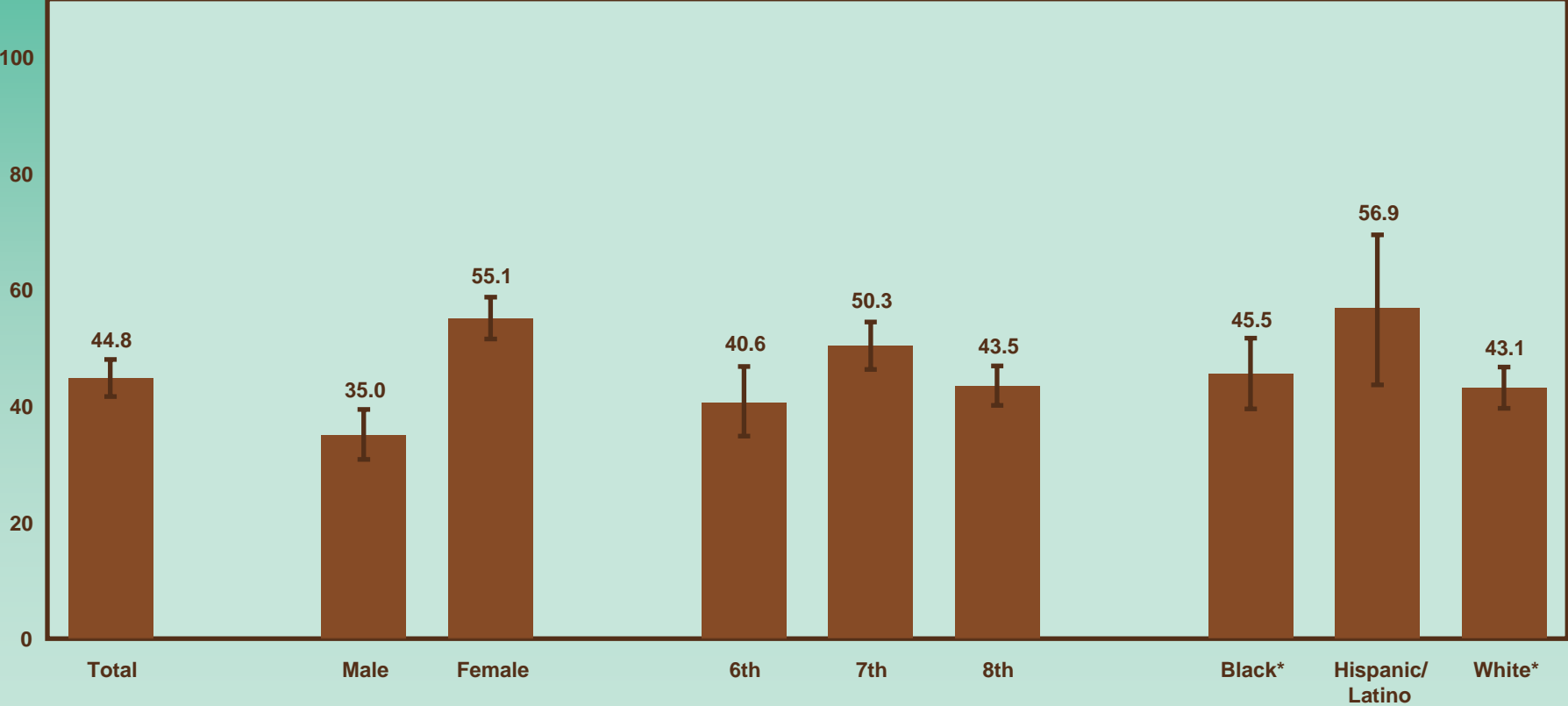

Percentage of students who were trying to lose weight

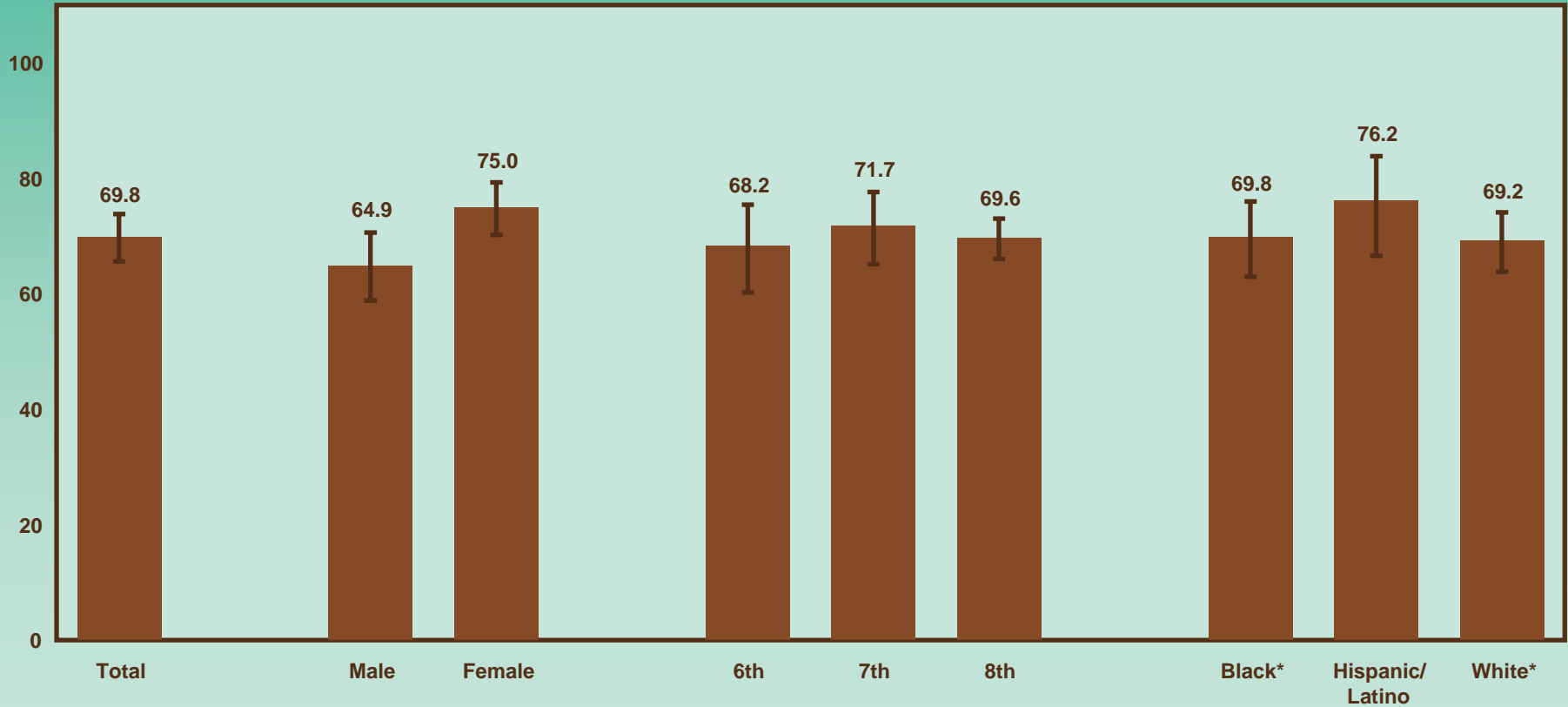

Percentage of students who had ever exercised to lose weight or to keep from gaining weight

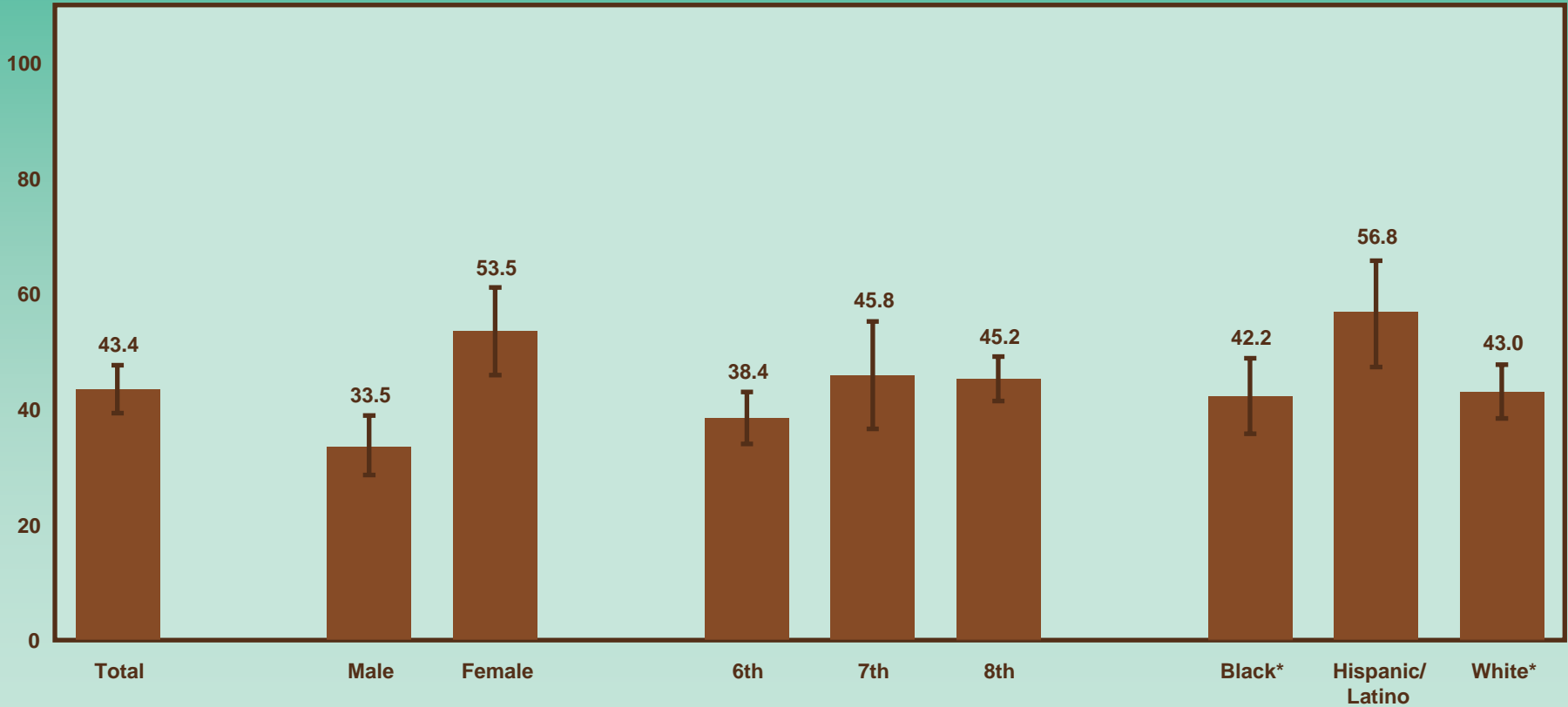

Percentage of students who had ever eaten less food, fewer calories, or foods low in fat to lose weight or to keep from gaining weight

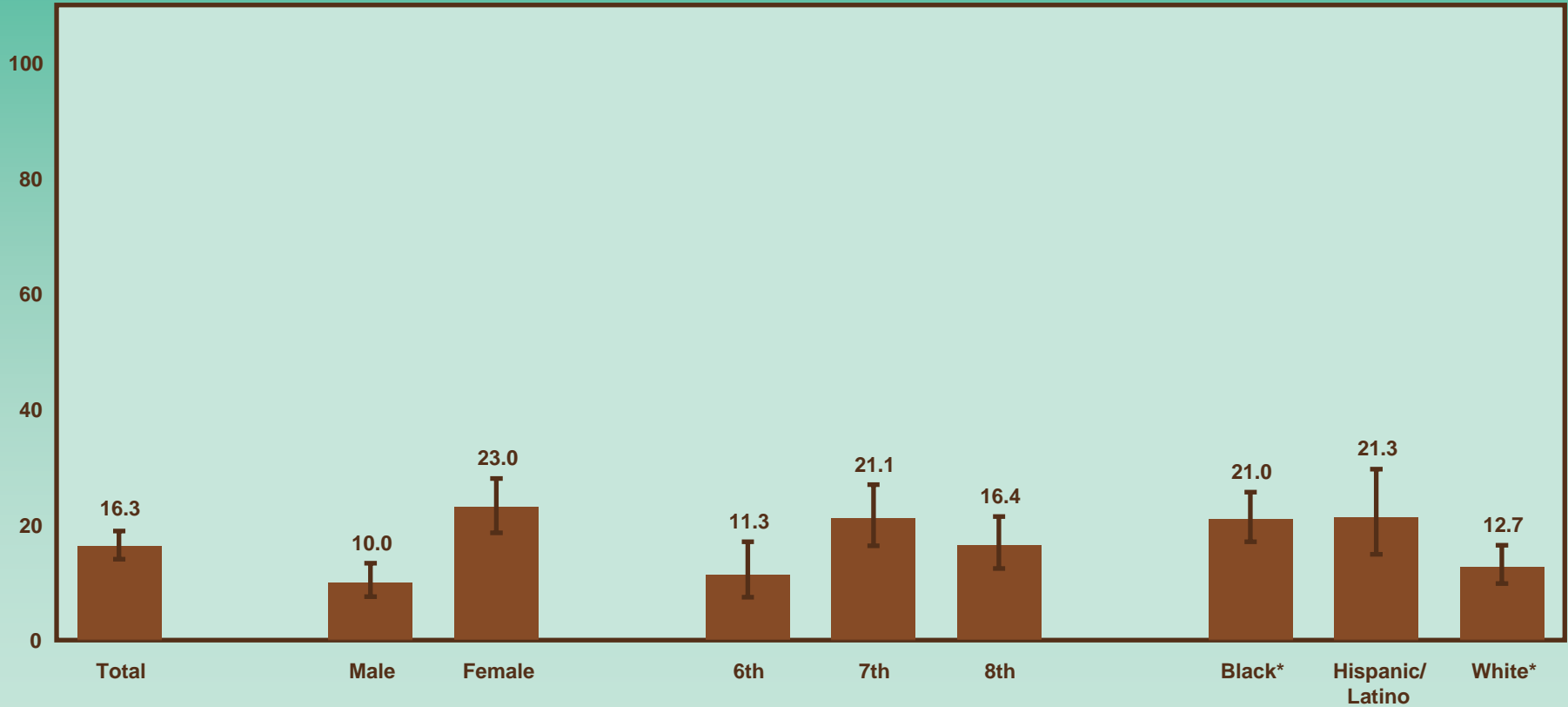

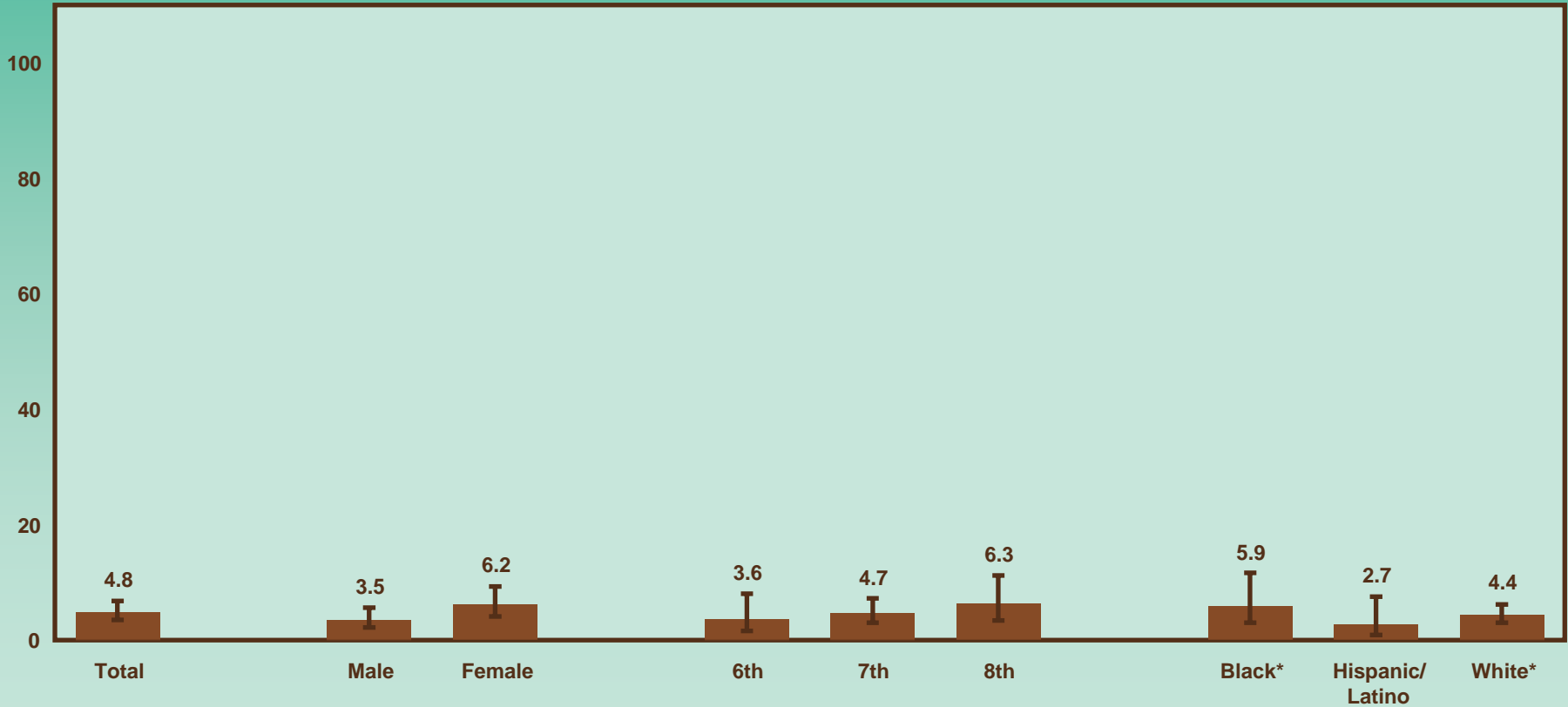

Percentage of students who had ever taken diet pills, powders, or liquids without a doctor's advice to lose weight or to keep from gaining weight

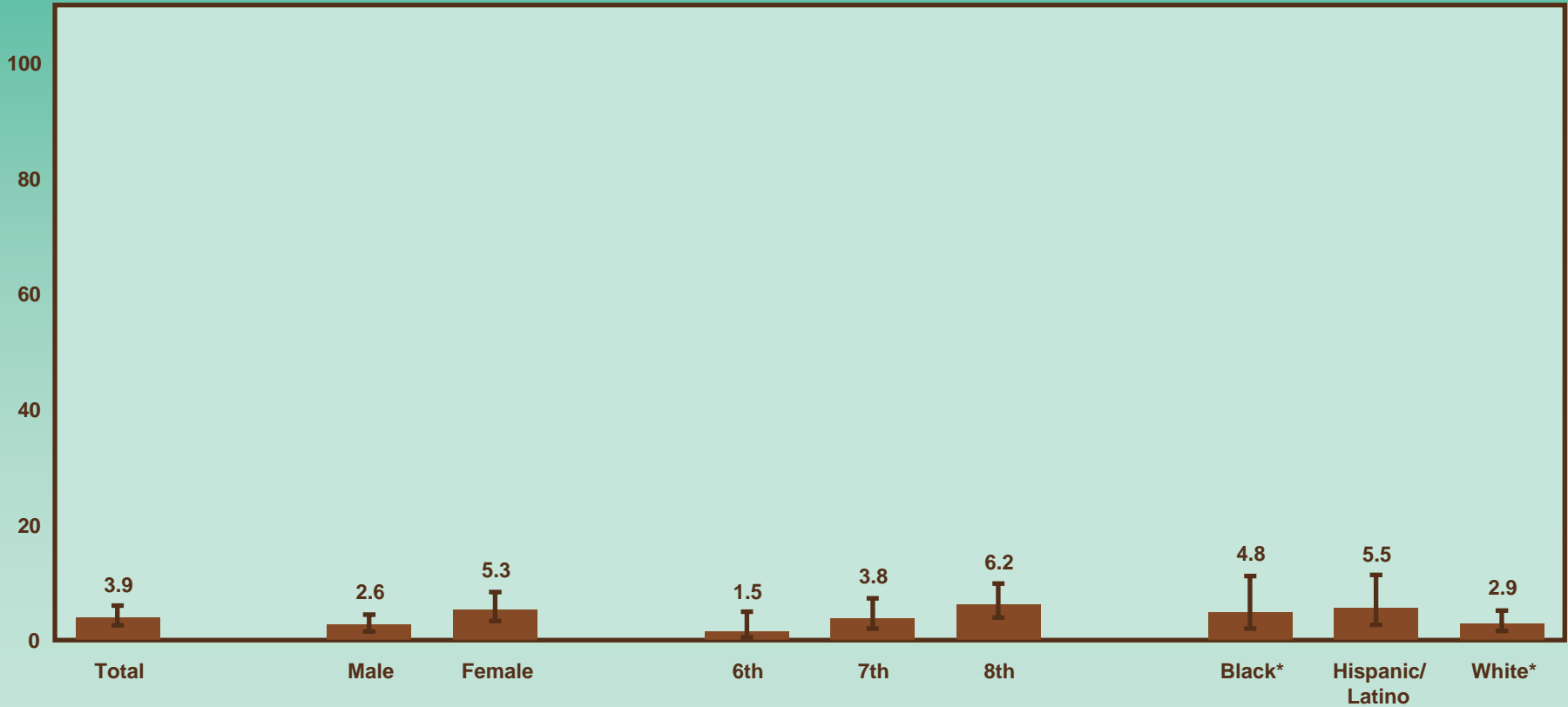

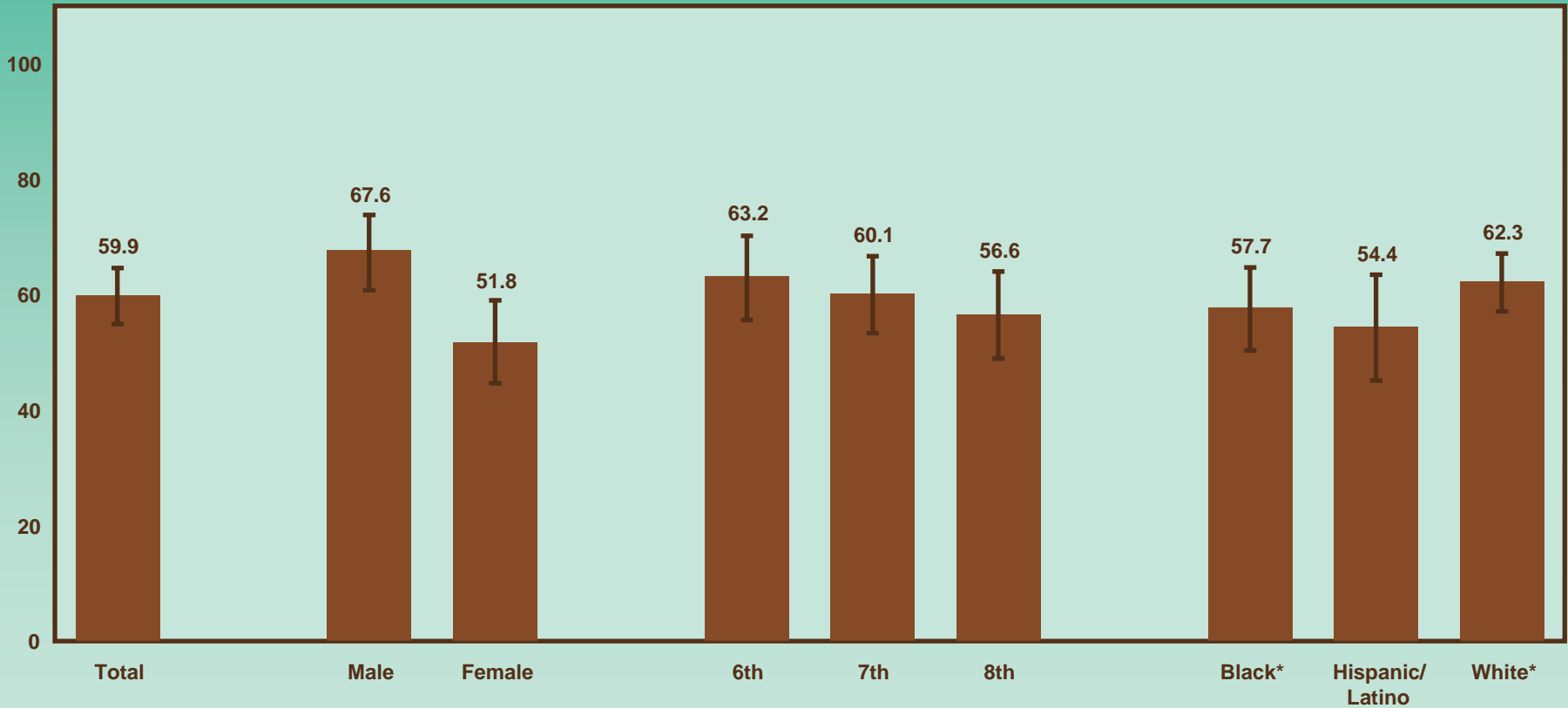

Percentage of students who were physically active for a total of at least 60 minutes per day on five or more of the past seven days



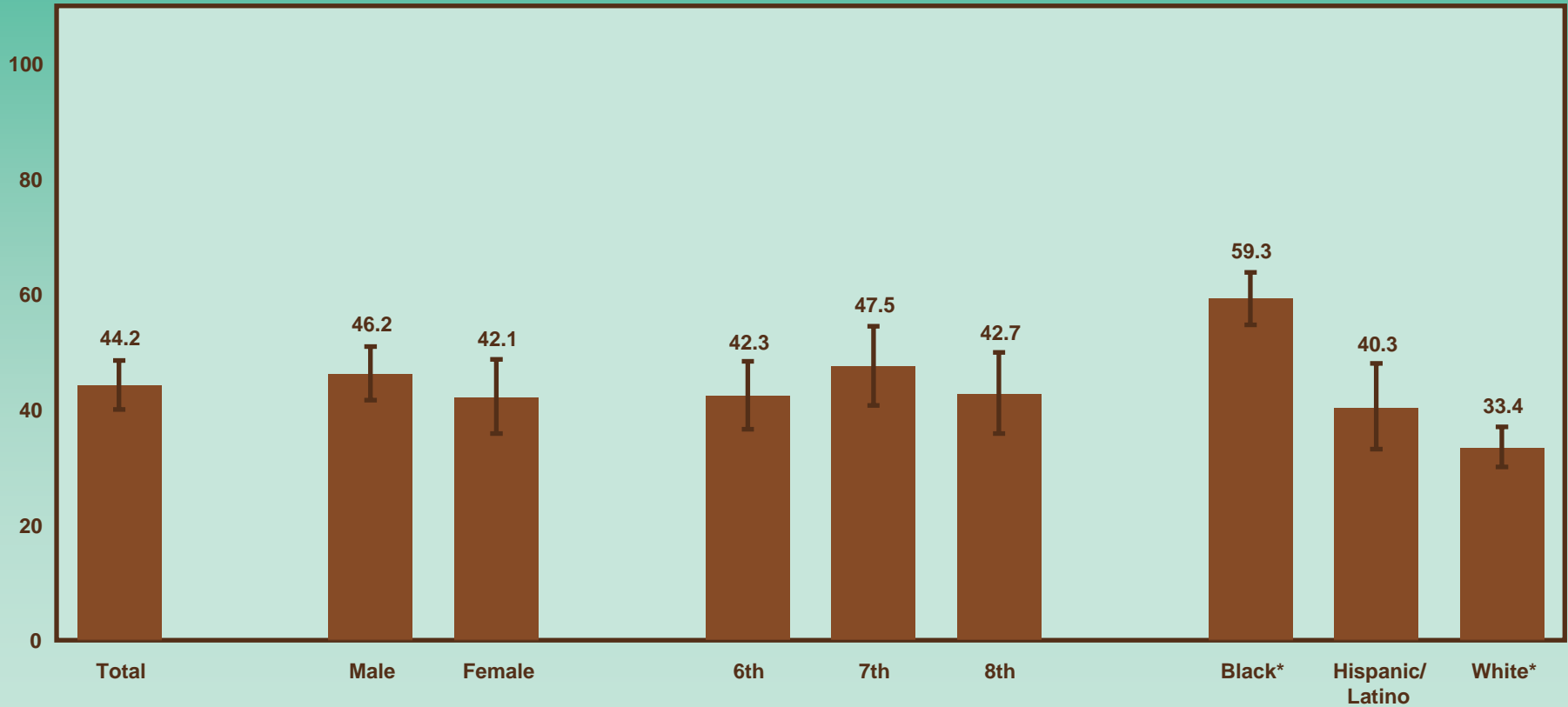

Percentage of students who watched three or more hours per day of TV on an average school day

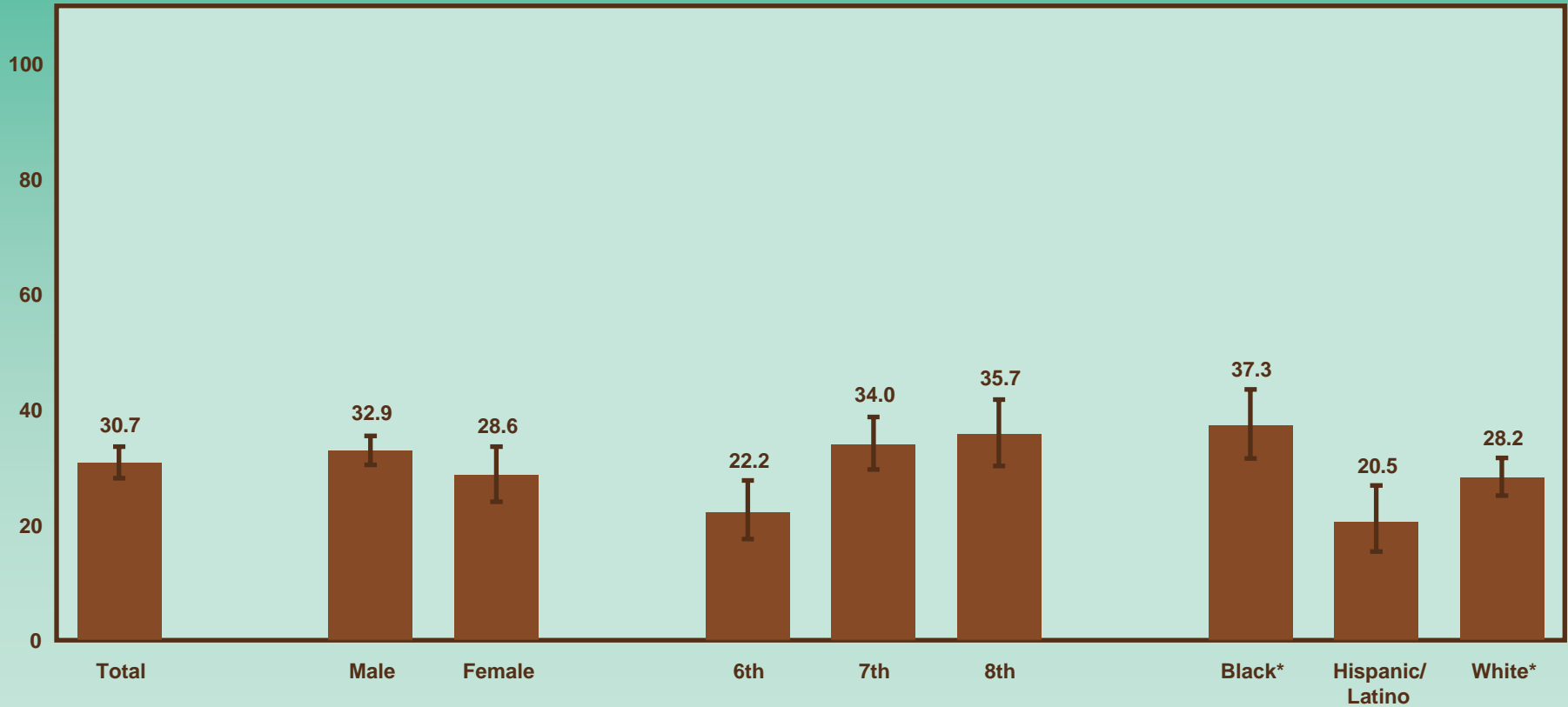

Percentage of students who played video or computer games or used a computer for something that was not school work three or more hours per day on an average school day



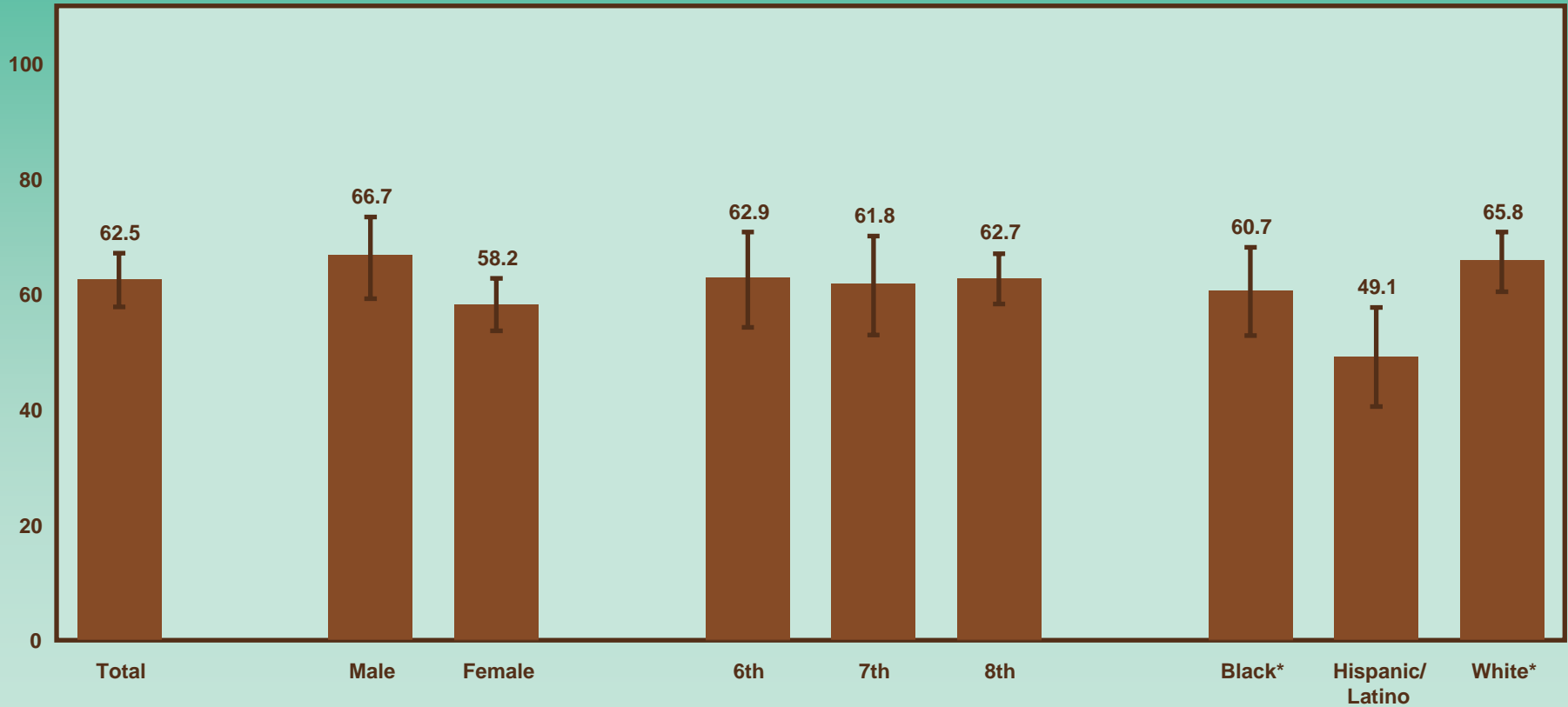

Percentage of students who played on one or more sports teams during the past 12 months



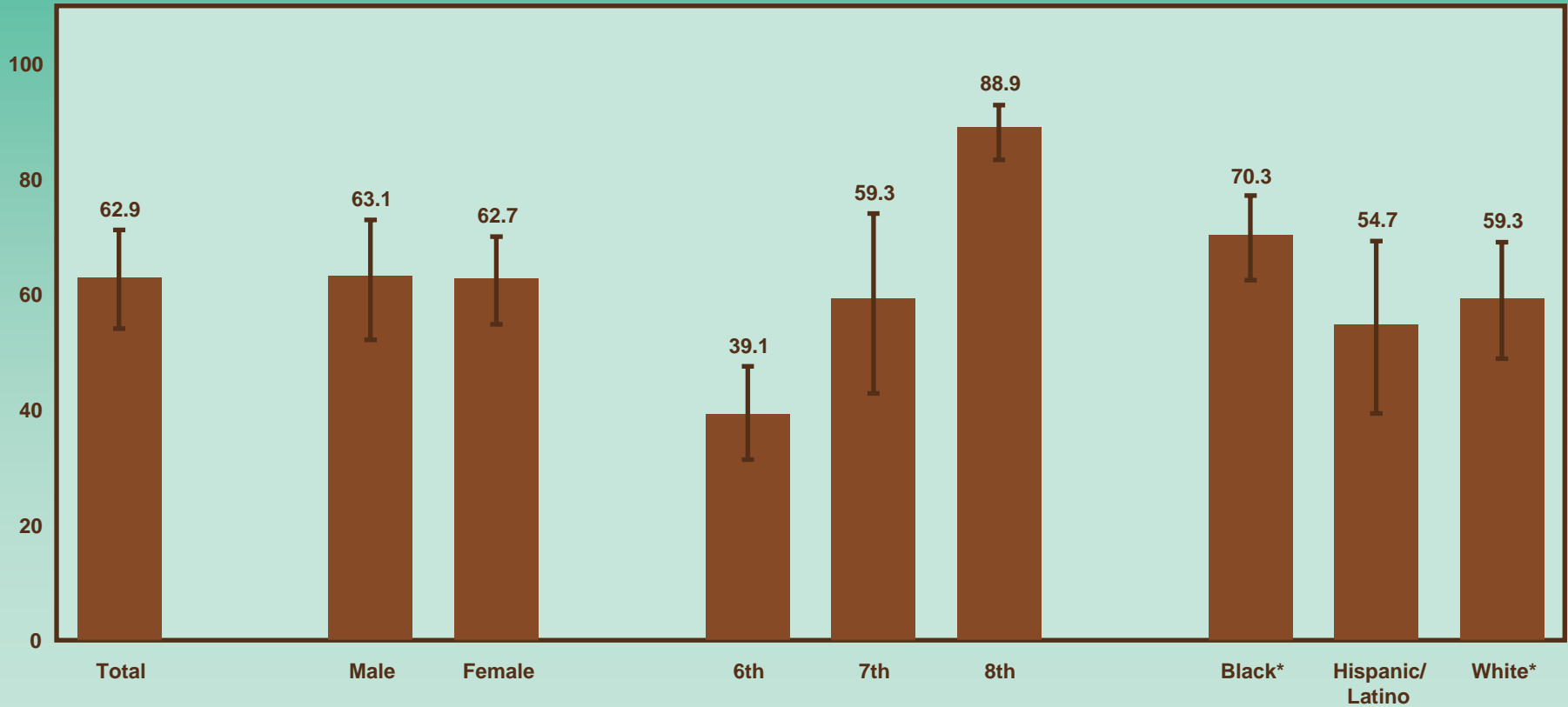

Percentage of students who had ever been taught in school about AIDS or HIV infection

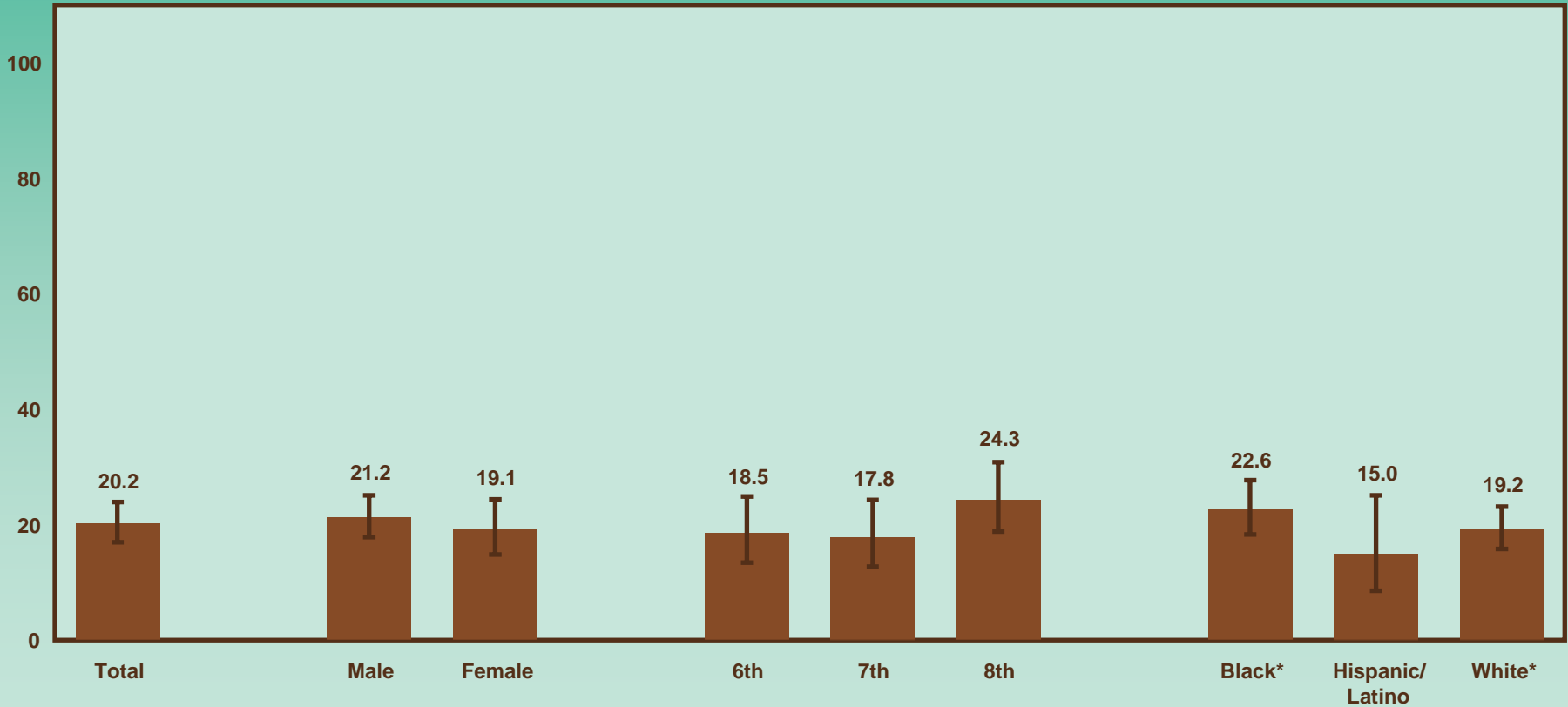

Percentage of students who had ever been told by a doctor or nurse that they had asthma

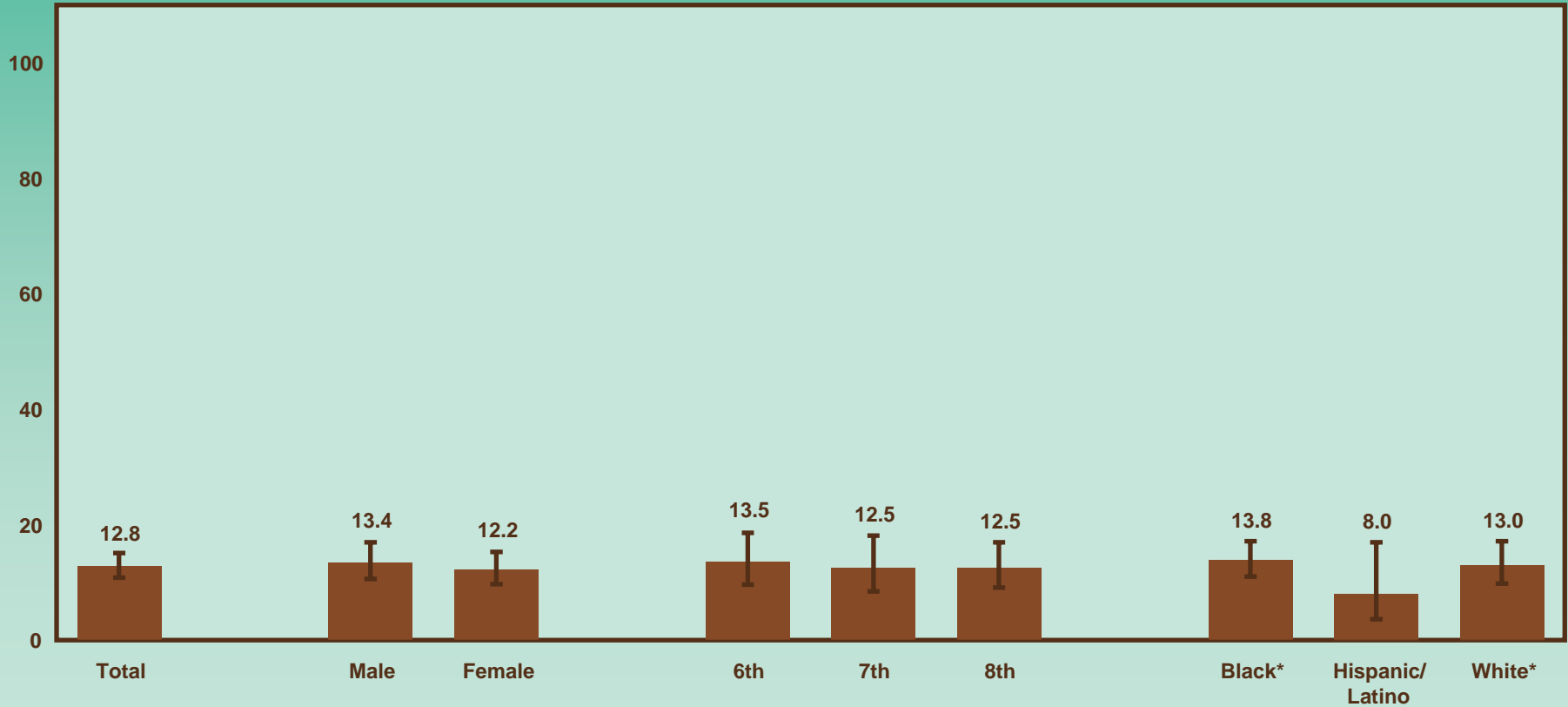

Percentage of students who had been told by a doctor or nurse that they had asthma and who still have asthma



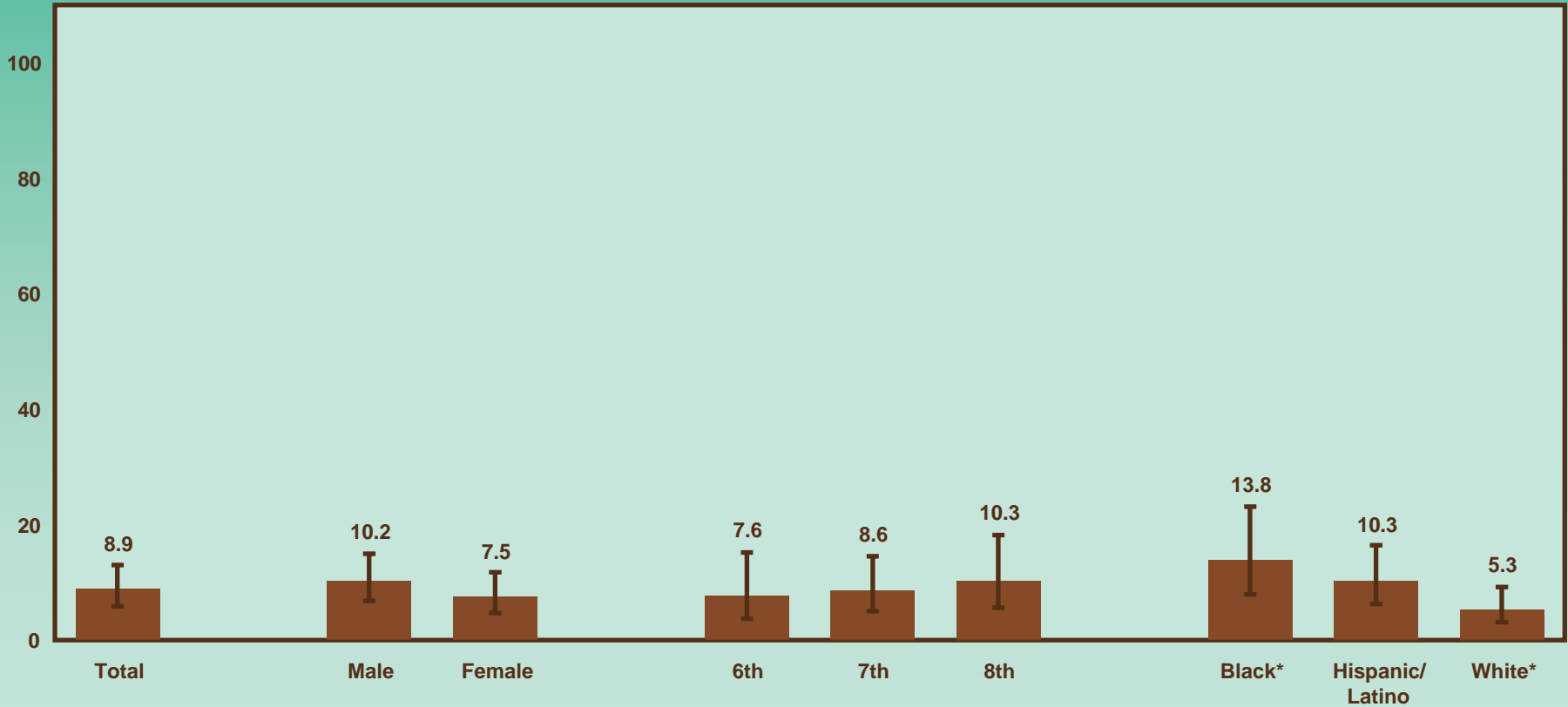

Percentage of students who would describe their grades in school as mostly D's or F's during the past 12 months

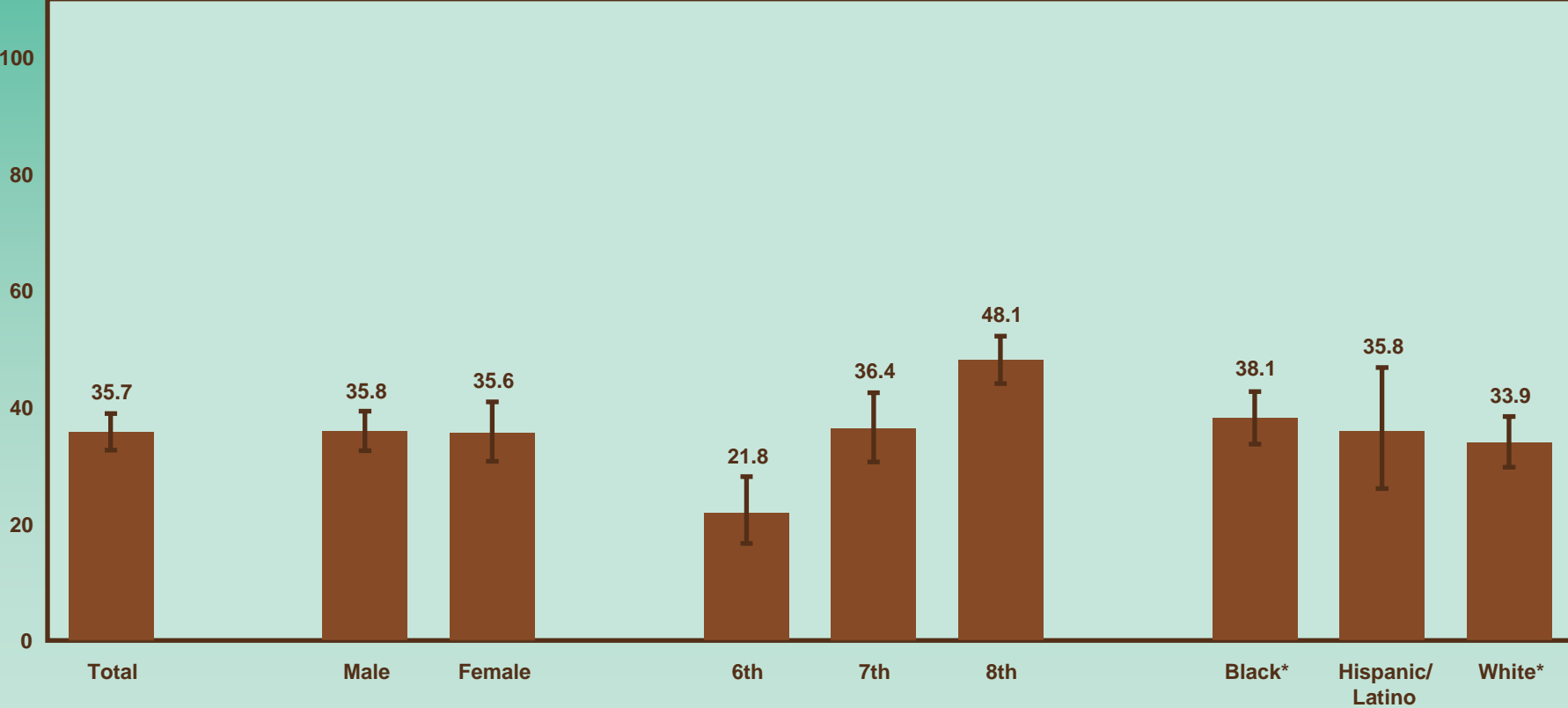

Percentage of students who have ever ridden in a car or other vehicle driven by someone who had been recklessly speeding

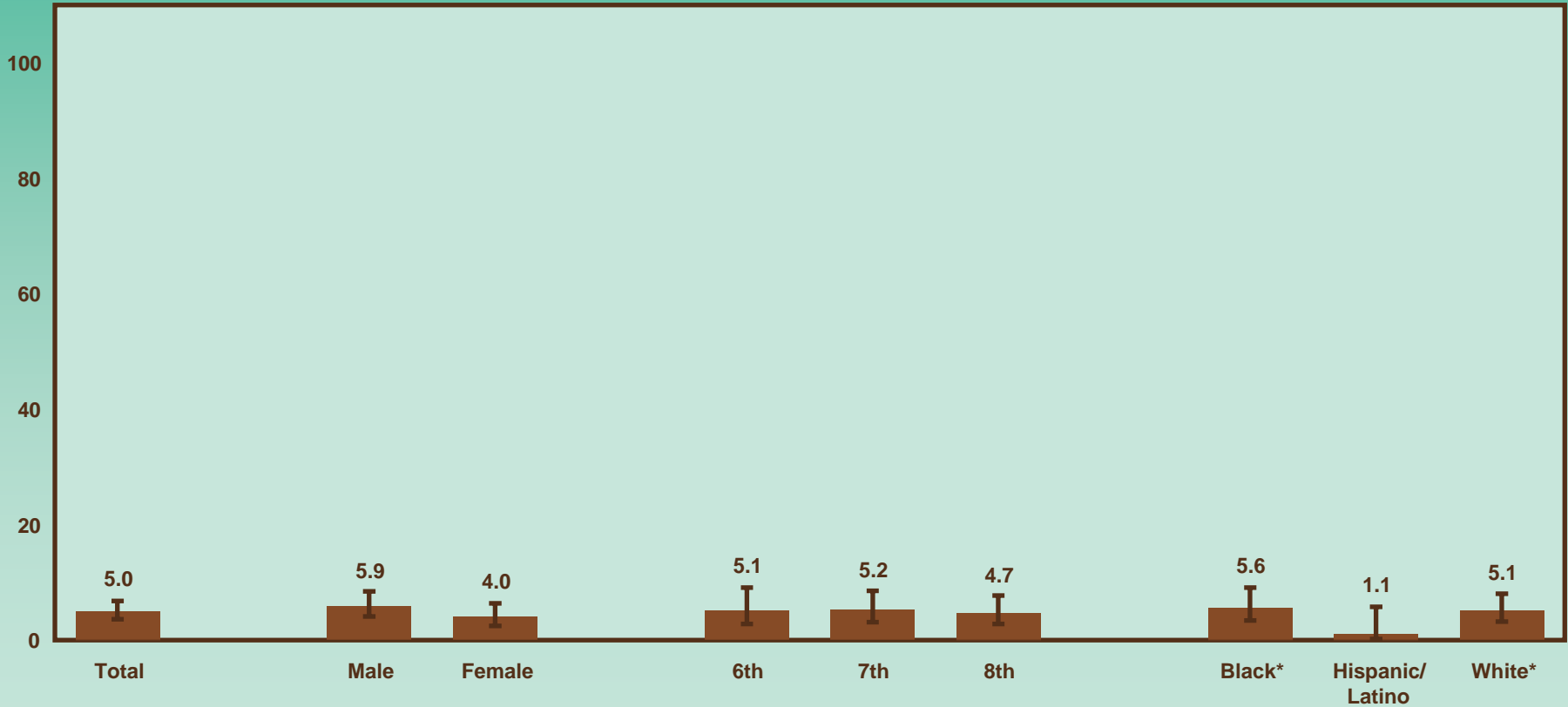

Percentage of students who were threatened or injured by someone with a weapon such as a gun, knife, or club on school property during the past 12 months



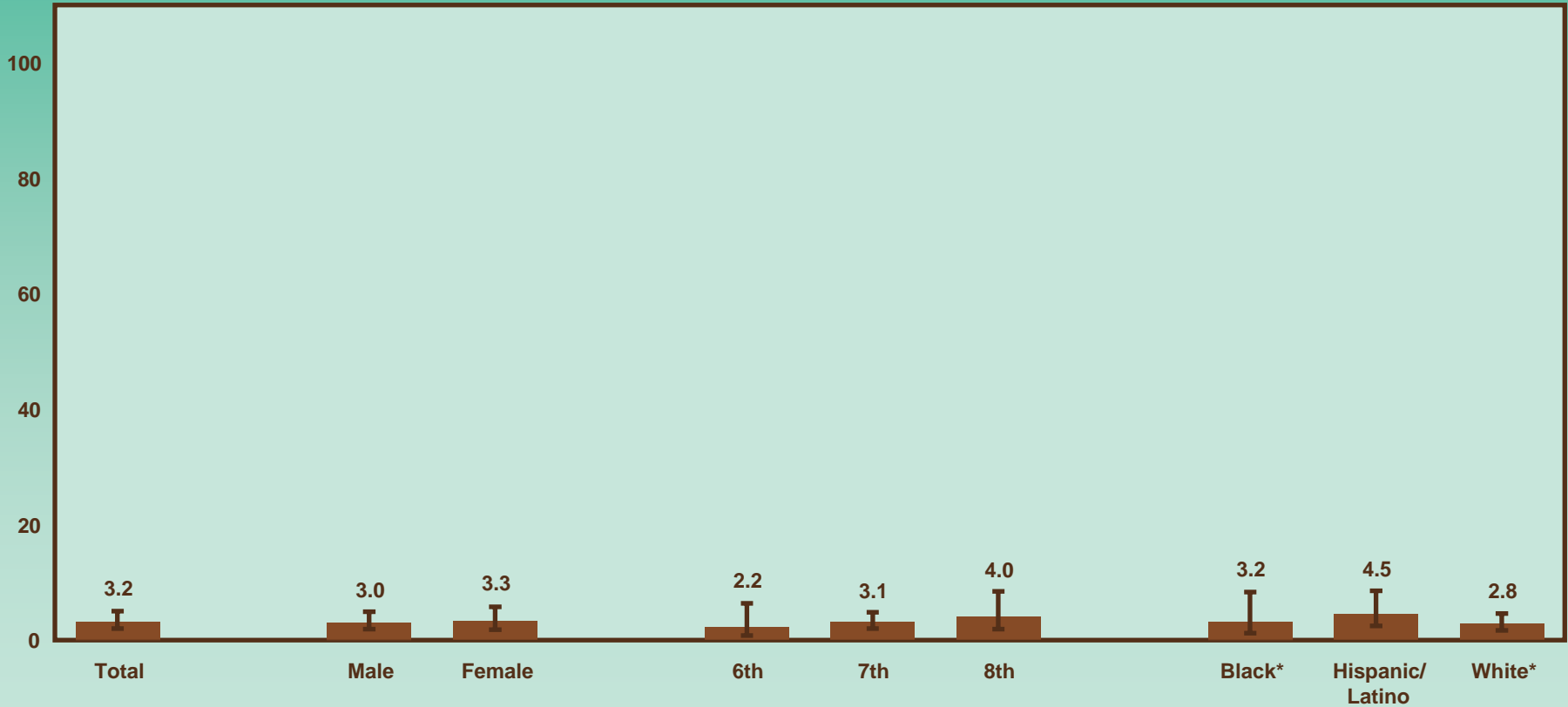

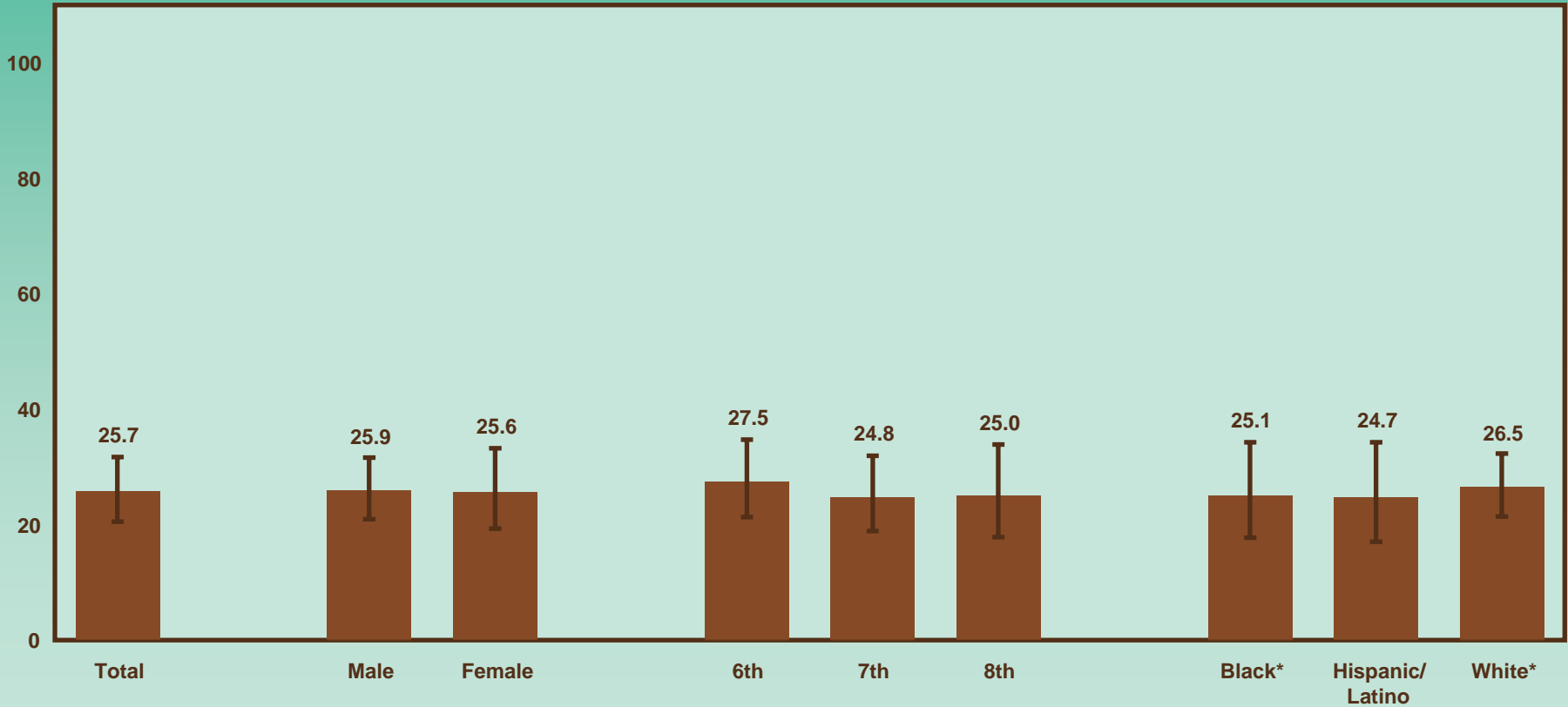

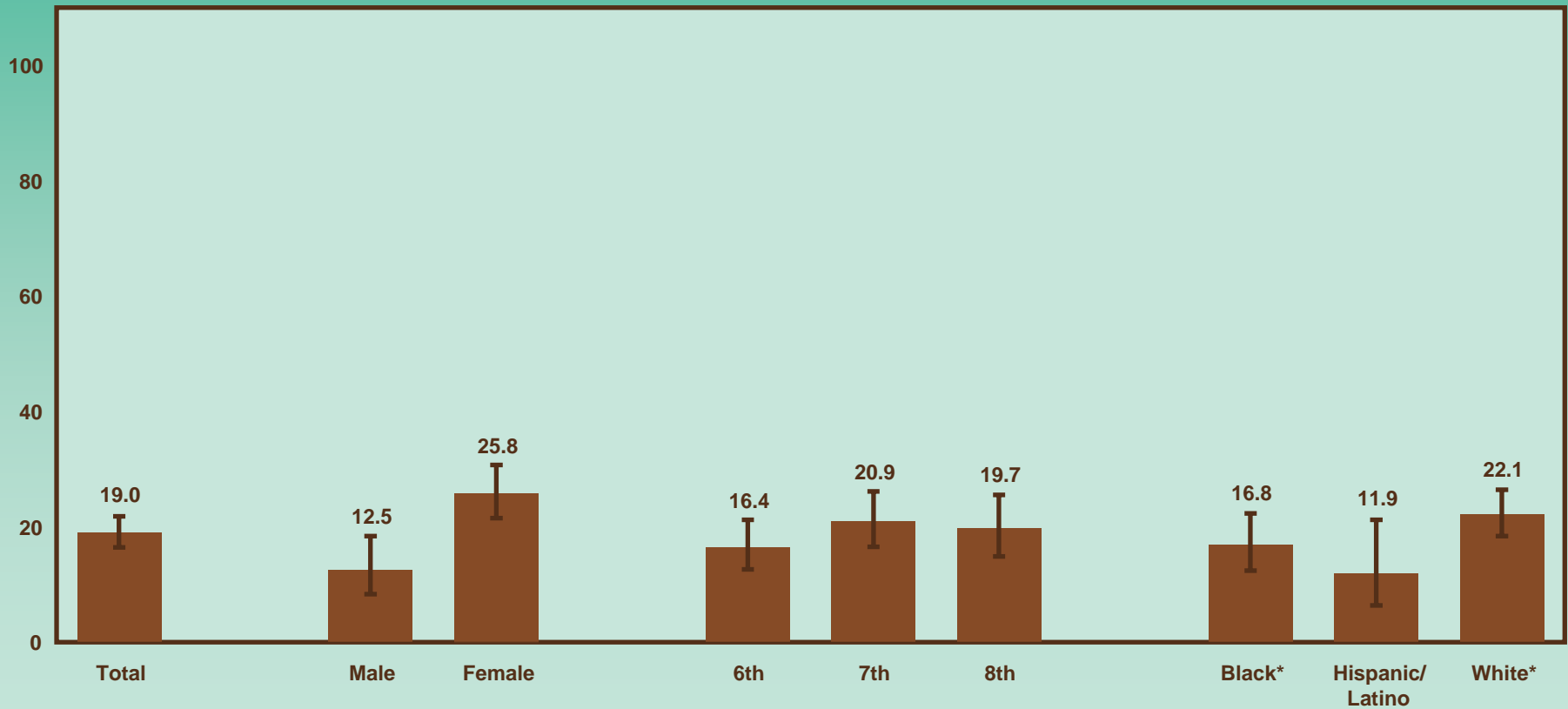

Percentage of students who have ever been electronically bullied, such as through e-mail, chat rooms, instant messaging, Web sites, or text messaging

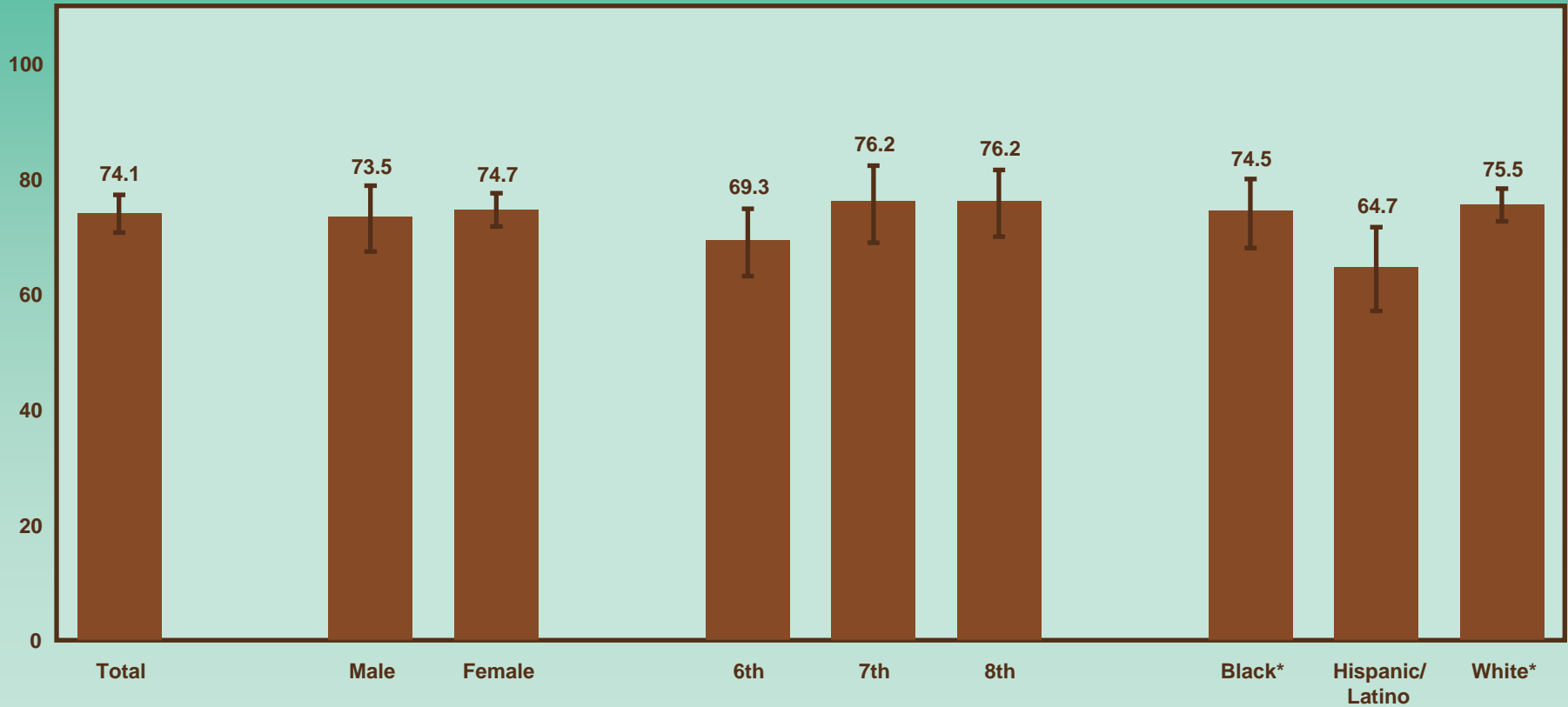

Percentage of students who have seen other students being bullied in their school



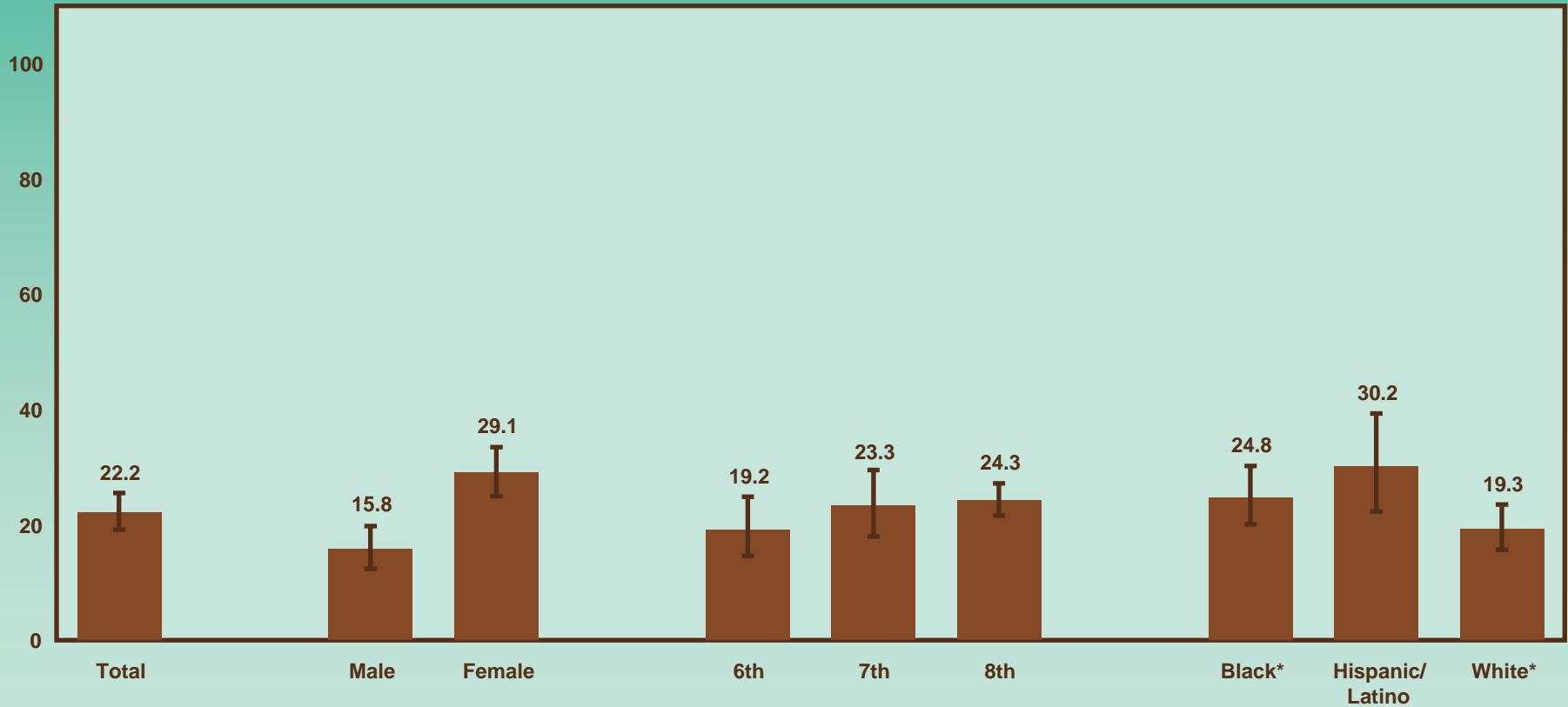

Percentage of students who ever felt so sad or hopeless almost every day for two weeks or more in a row that they stopped doing some usual activities during the past 12 months



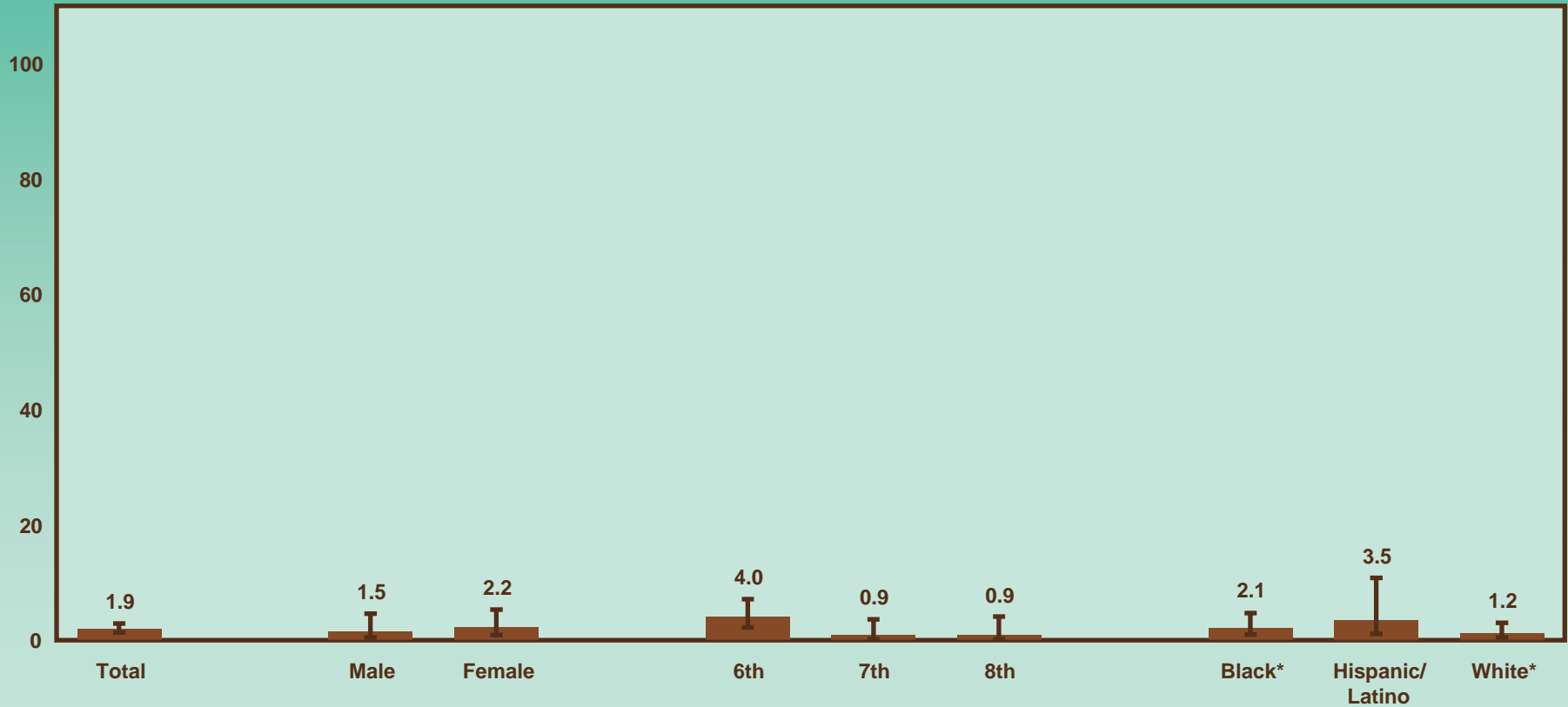

Percentage of students who usually talk with teacher or other adult in this school when they feel sad, empty, hopeless, angry, or anxious

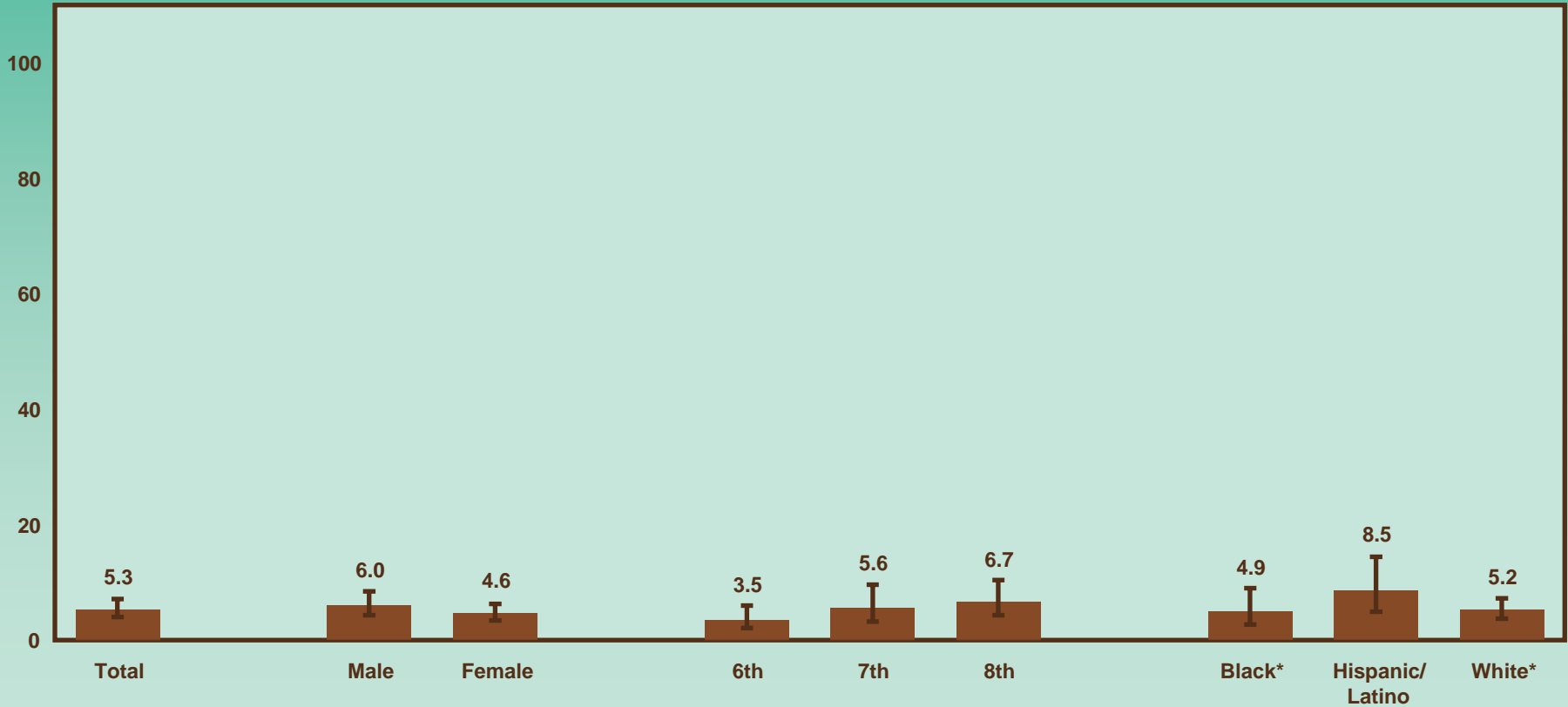

Percentage of students who ever tried to quit smoking cigarettes during the past 12 months

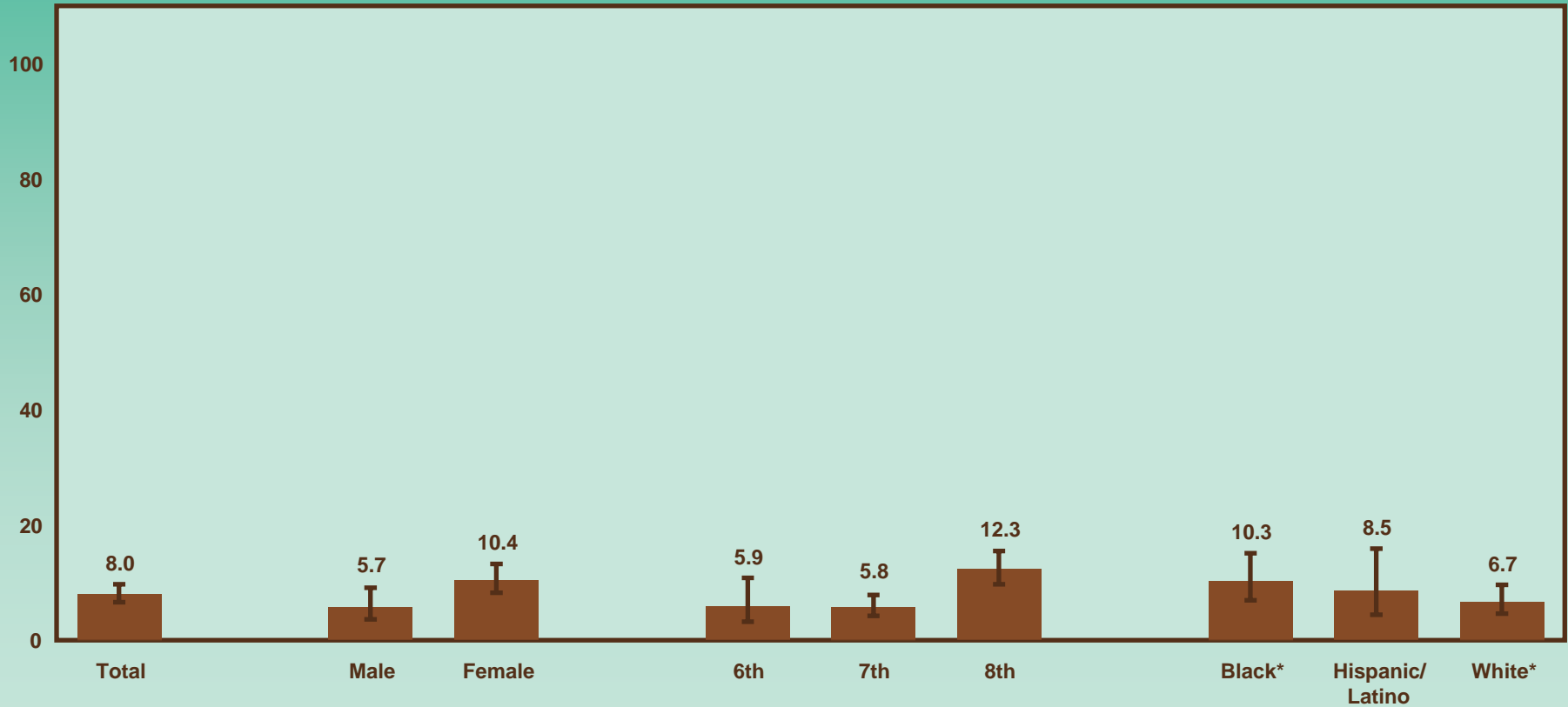

Percentage of students who usually got the alcohol they drank from someone who gave it to them during the past 30 days



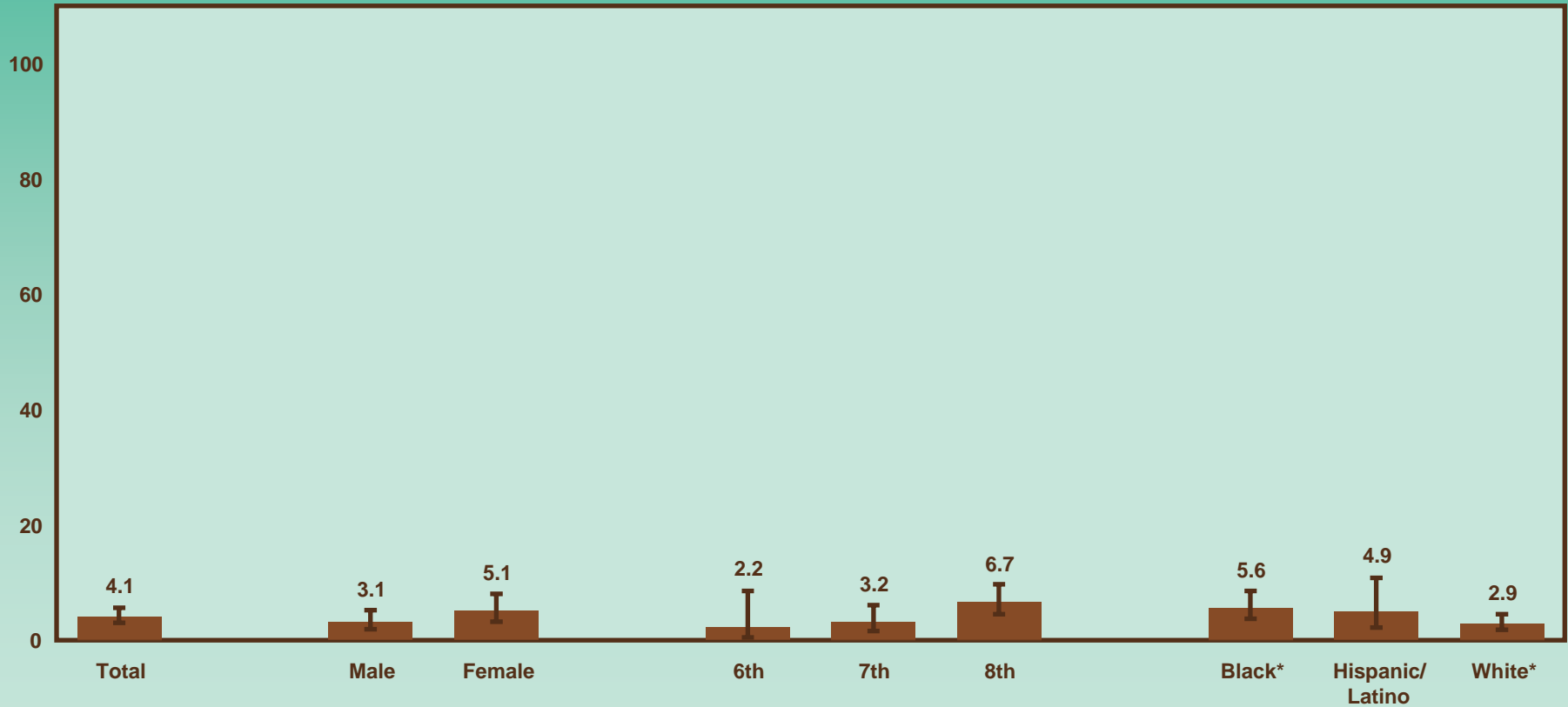

Percentage of students who used marijuana during the past 30 days



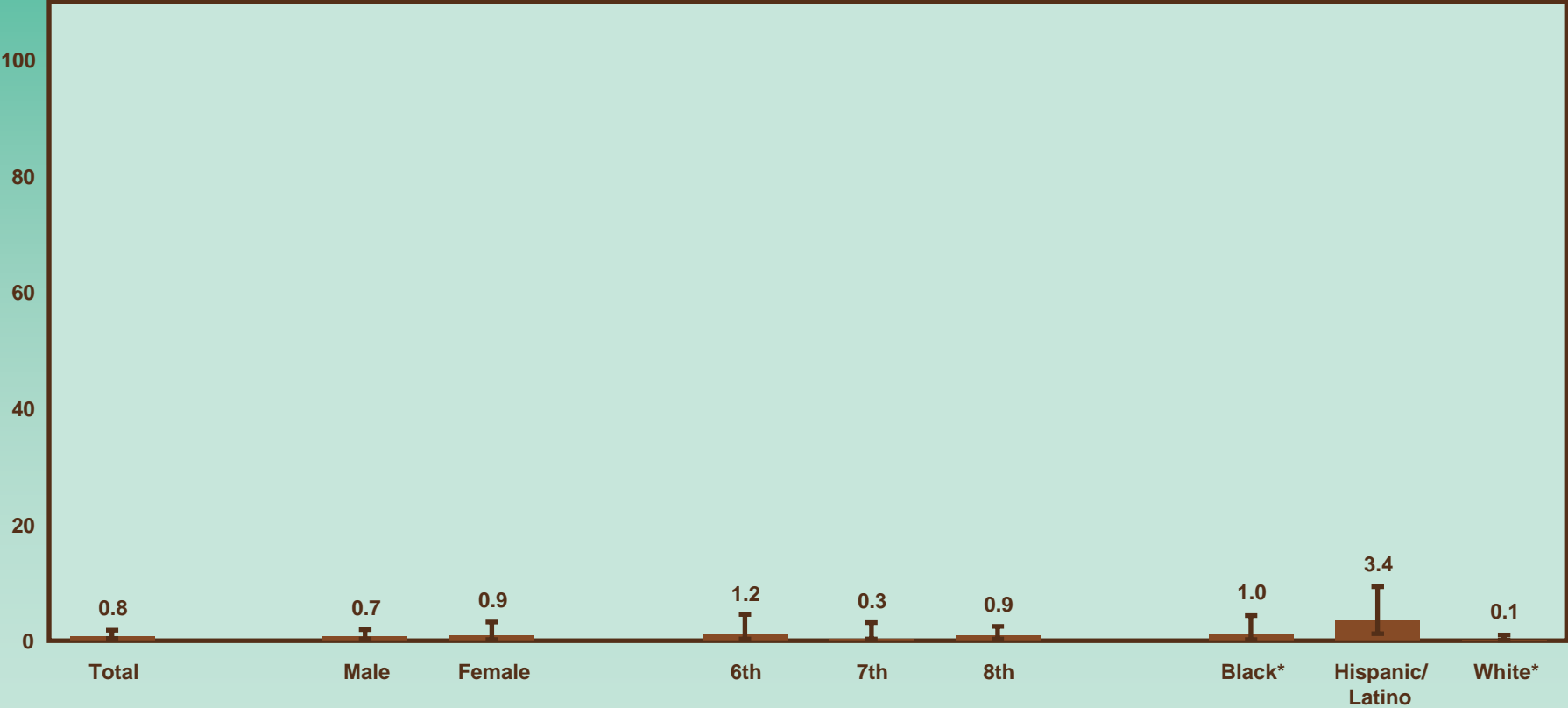

Percentage of students who used marijuana on school property during the past 30 days

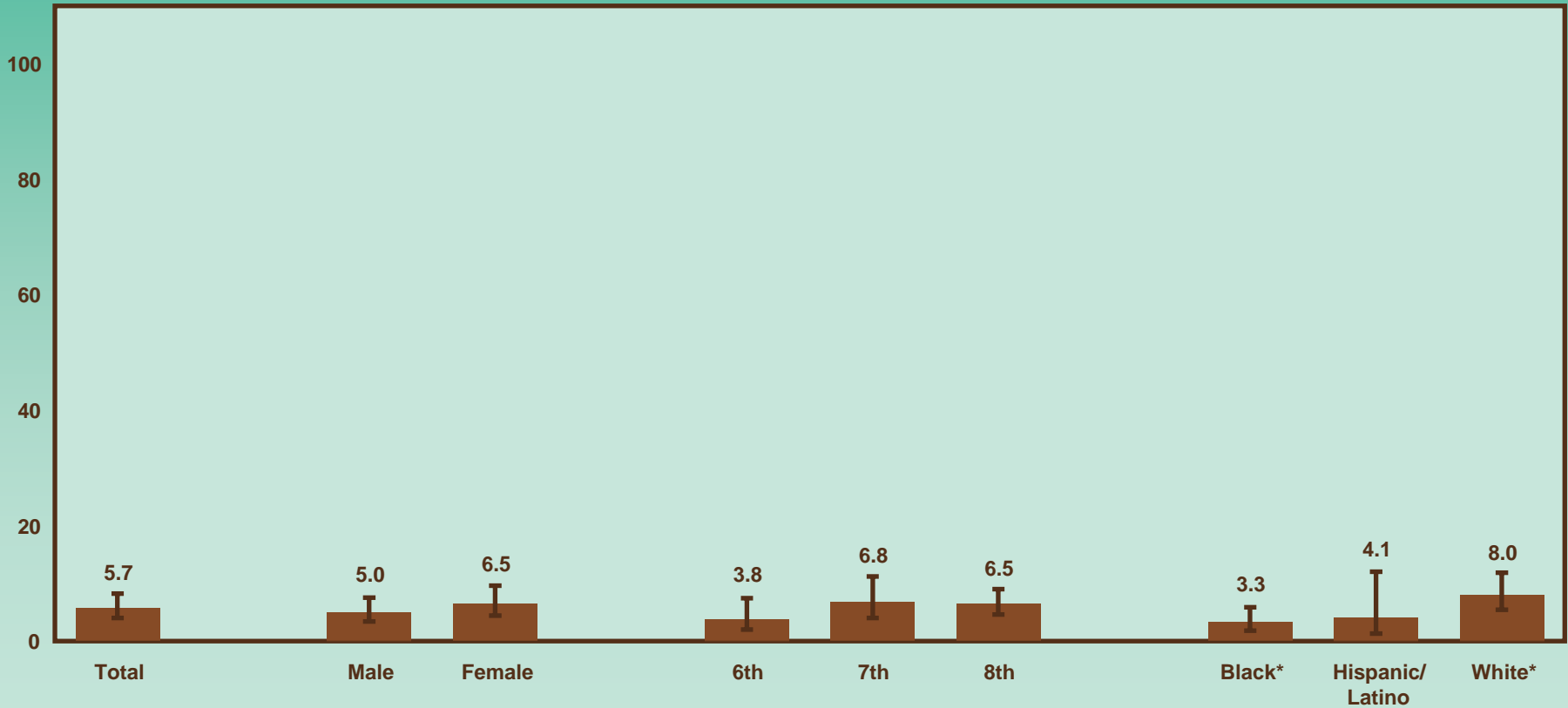

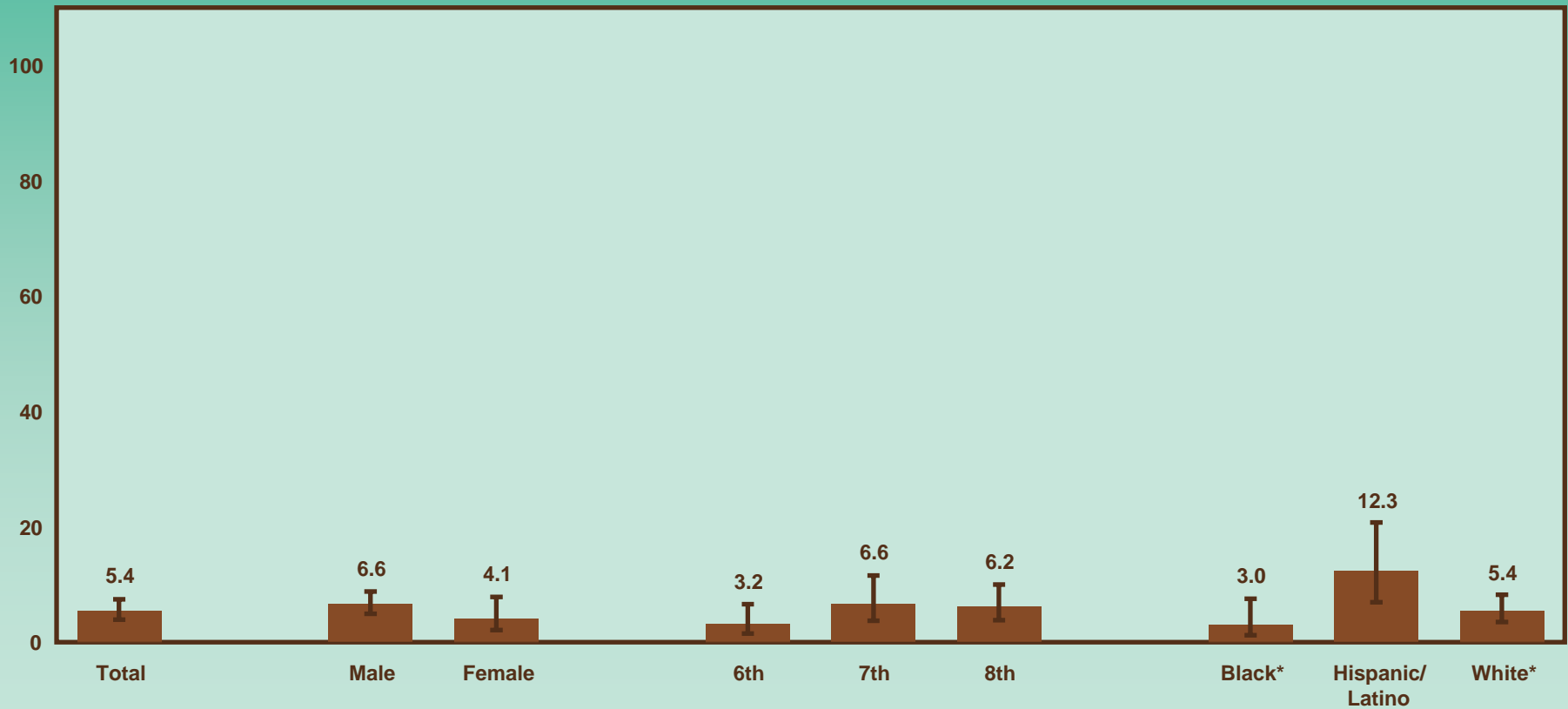

Percentage of students who have been offered, sold, or given an illegal drug on school property during the past 12 months



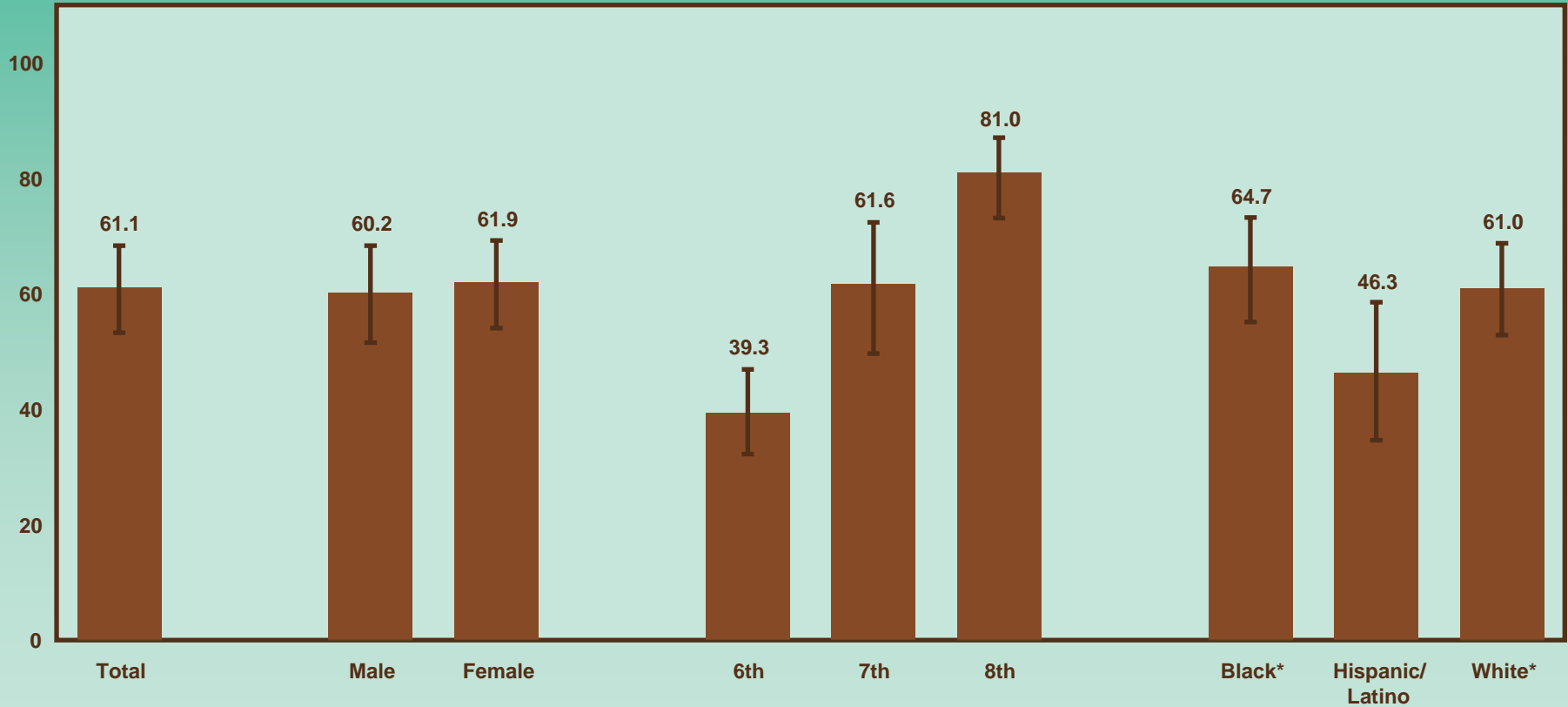

Percentage of students who have ever been taught about abstaining from sexual activity



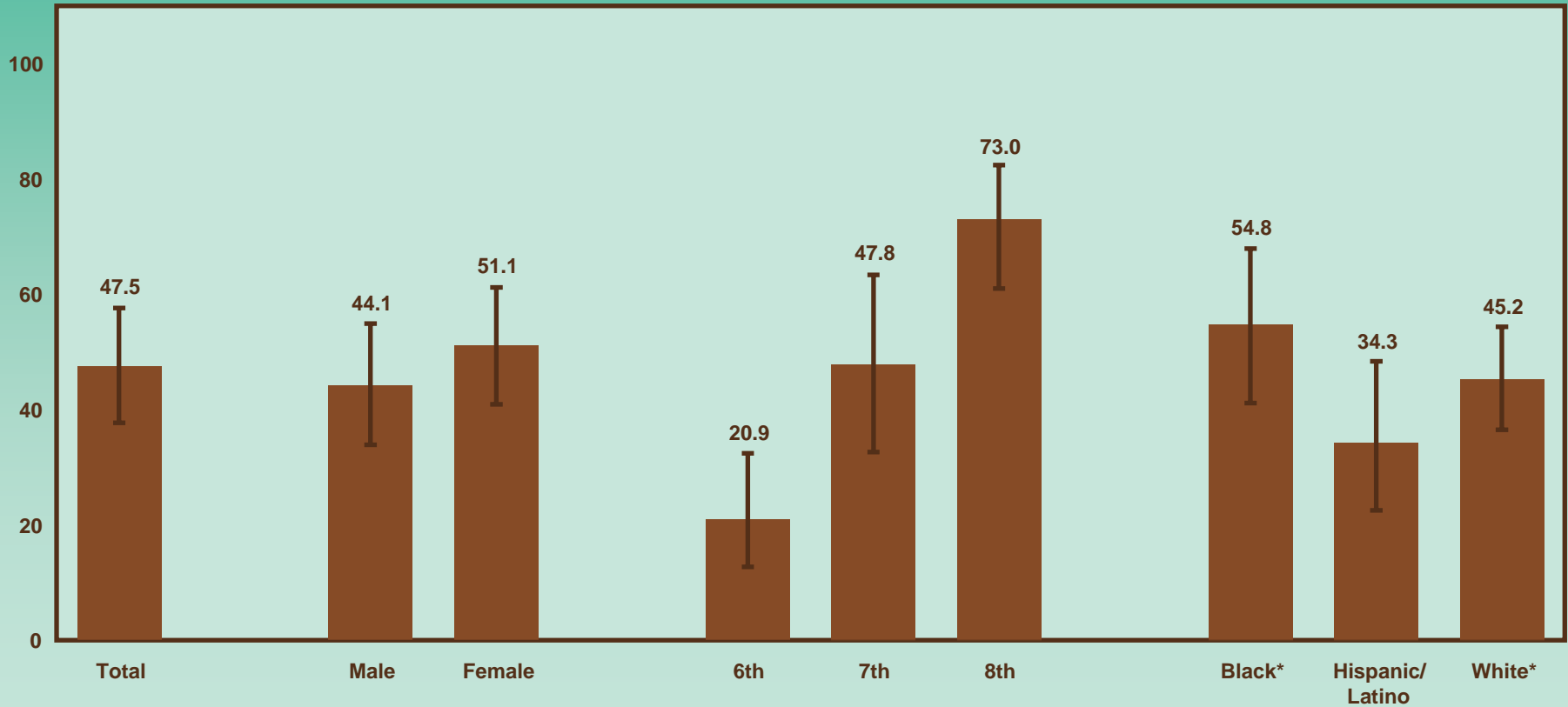

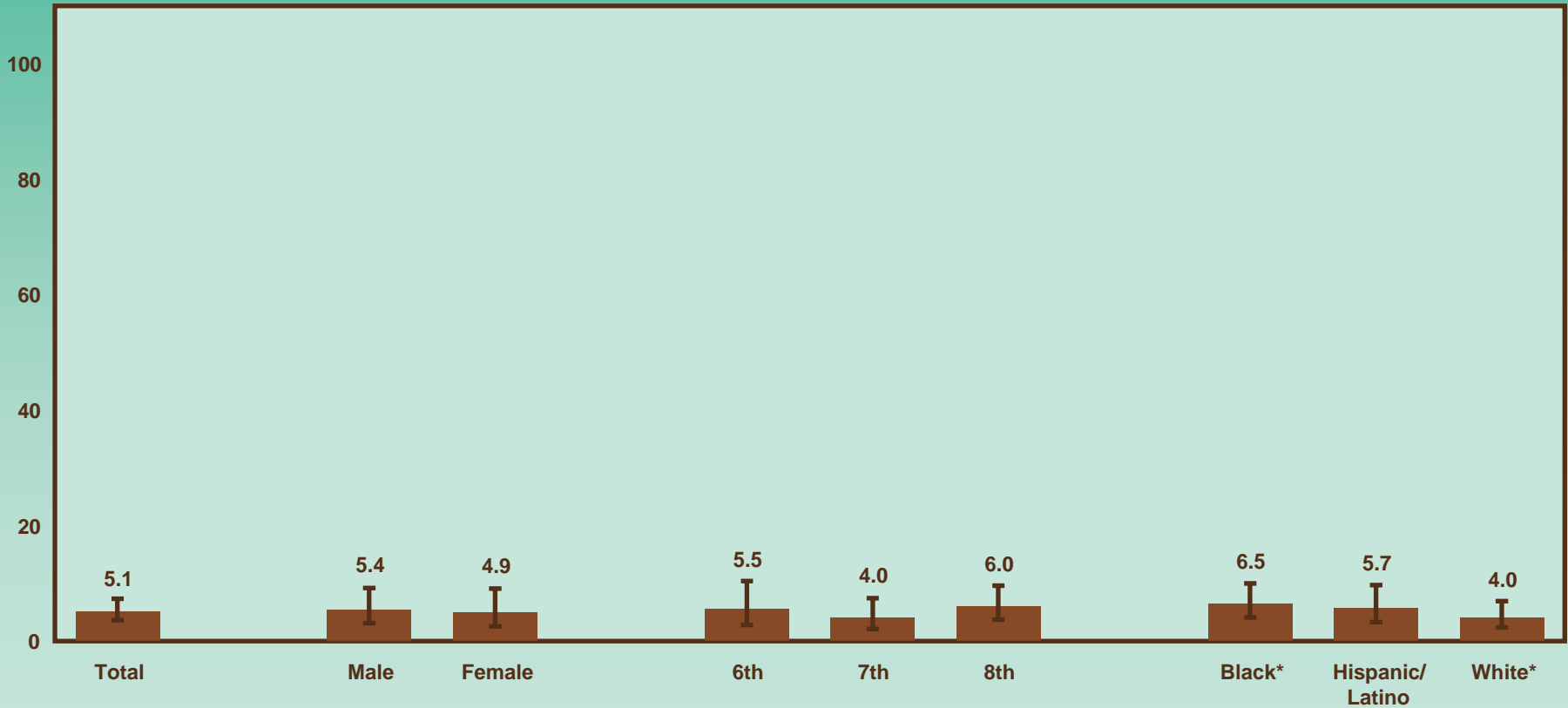

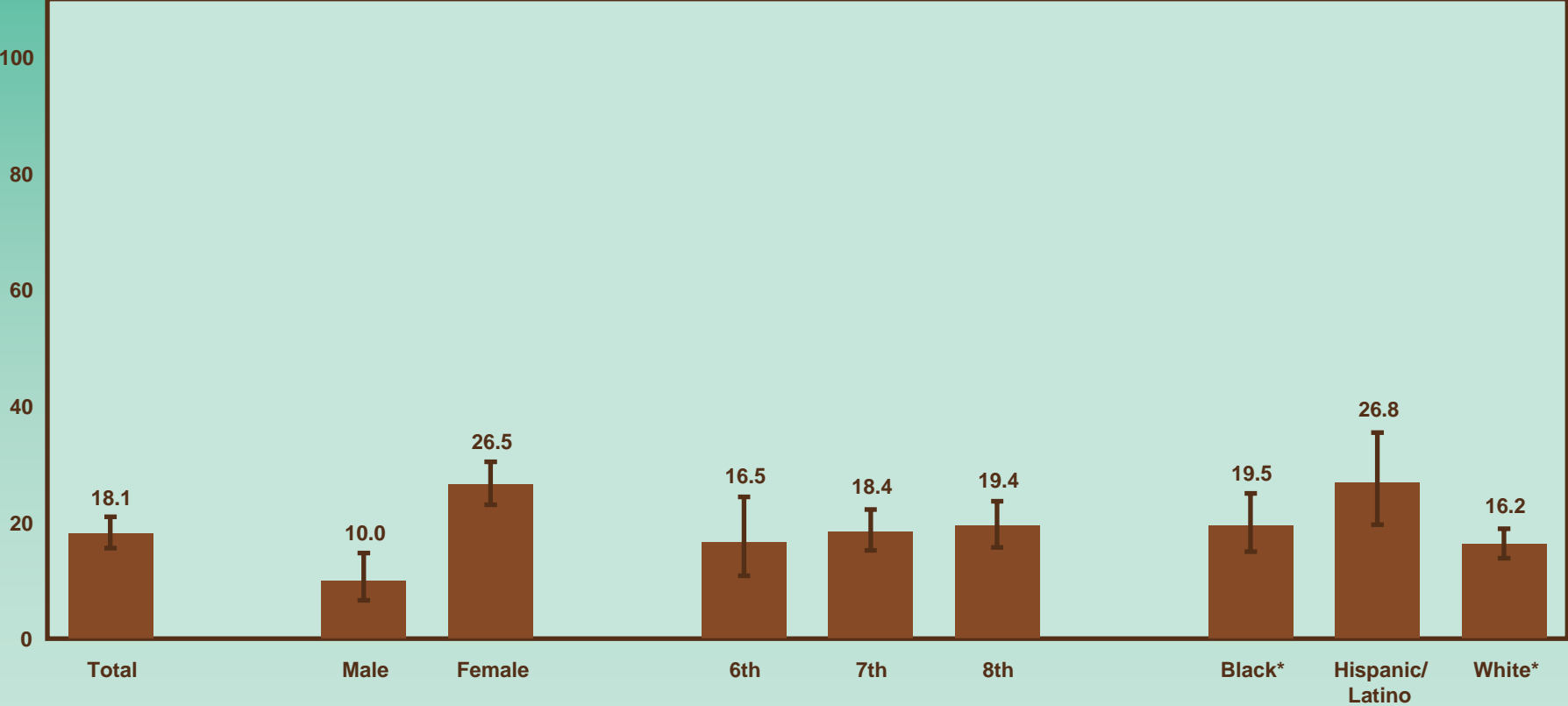

Percentage of students who skipped meals to lose weight or keep from gaining weight during the past 30 days

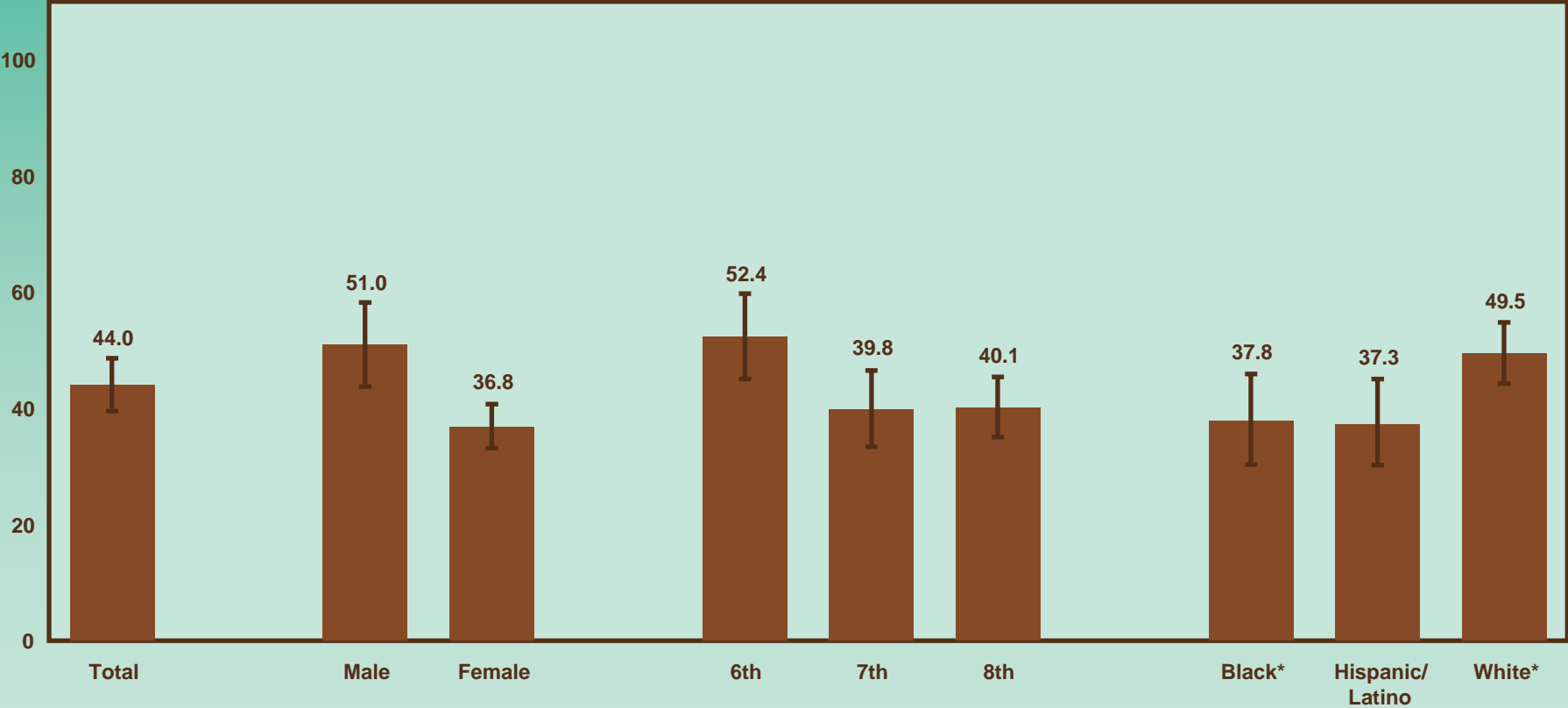

Percentage of students who ate breakfast on seven of the past seven days

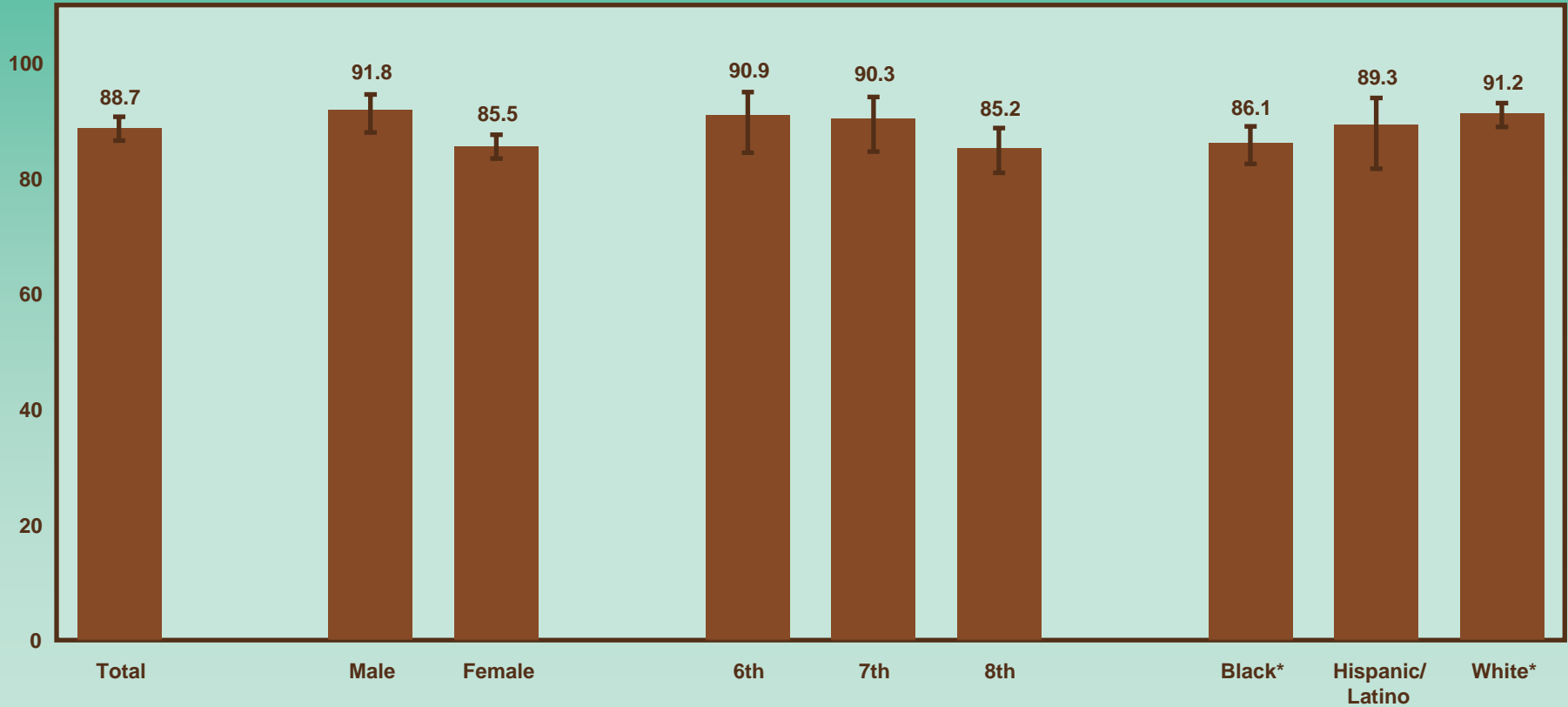

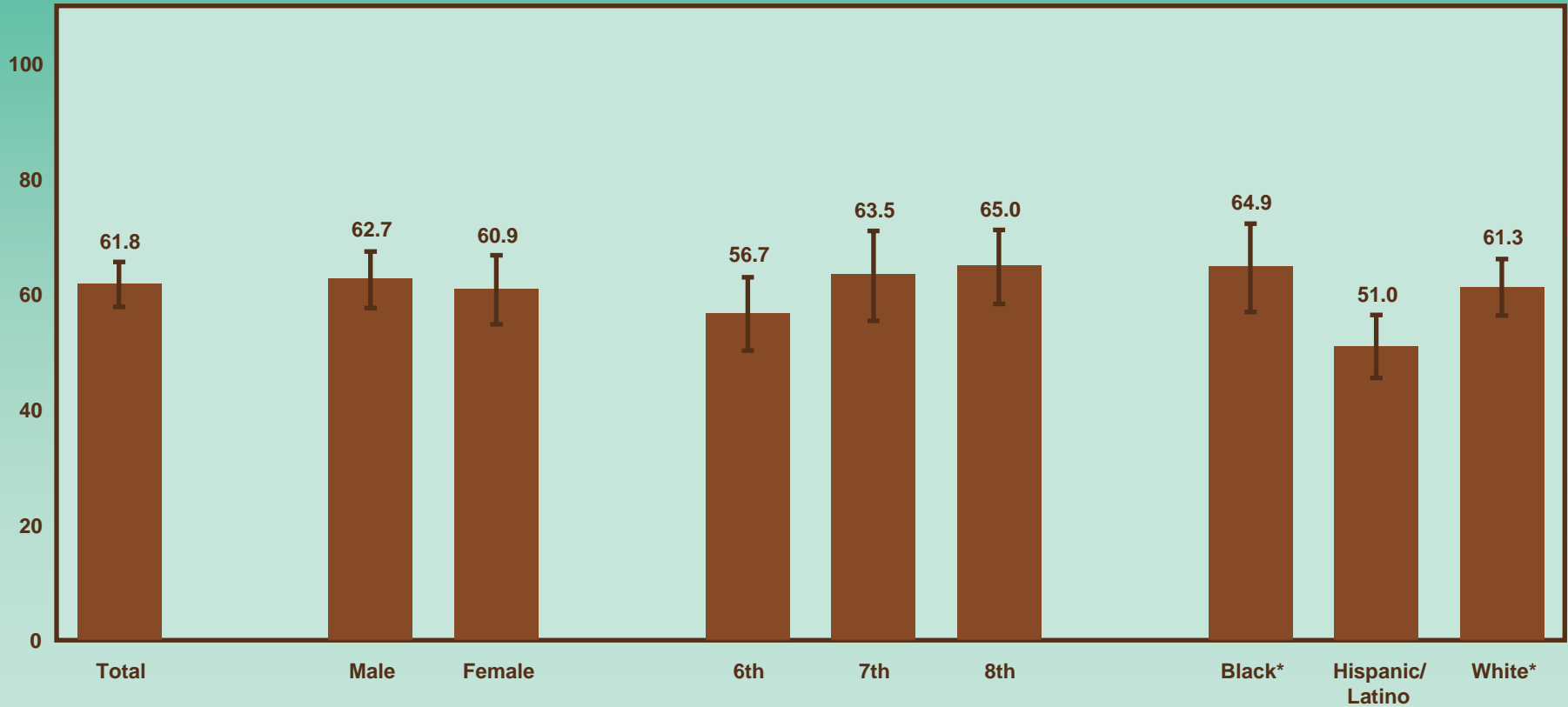

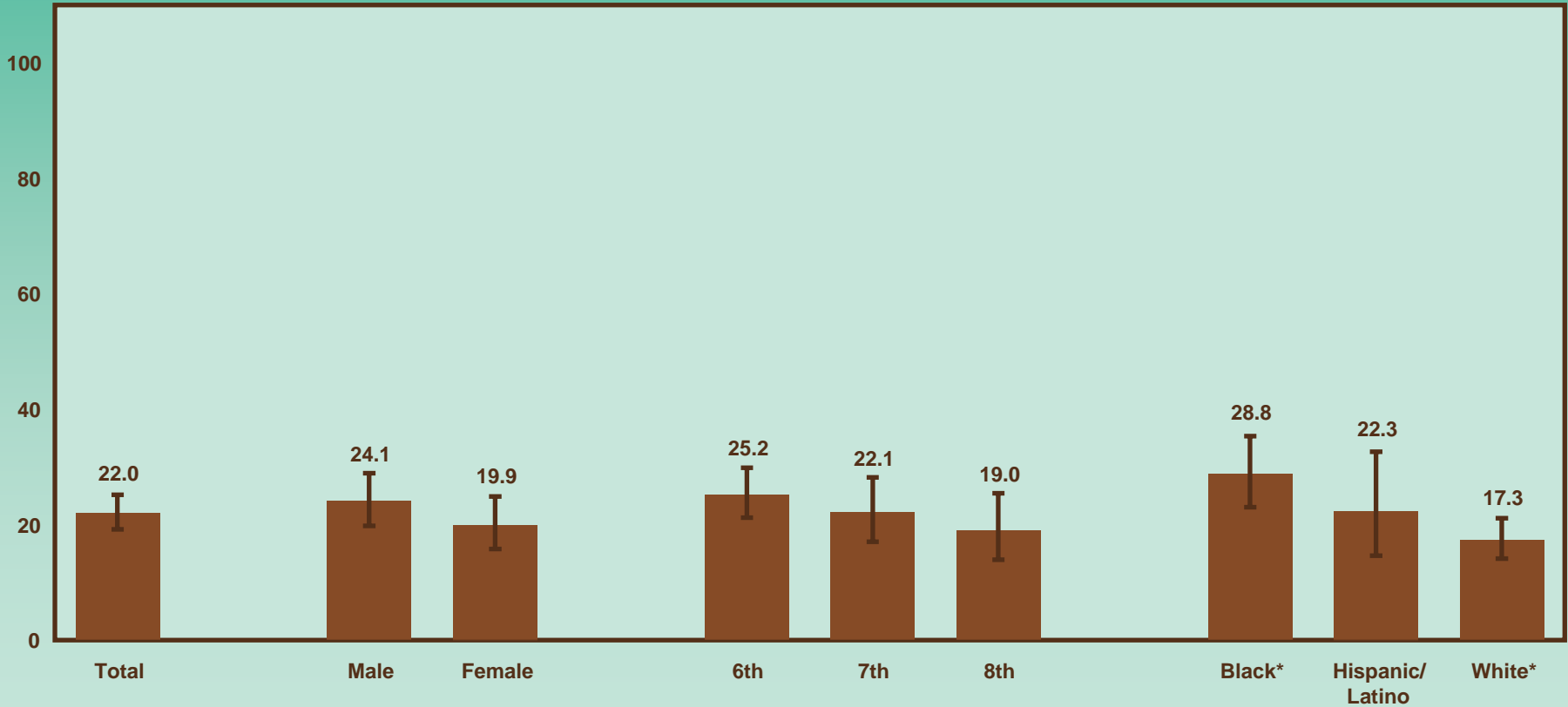

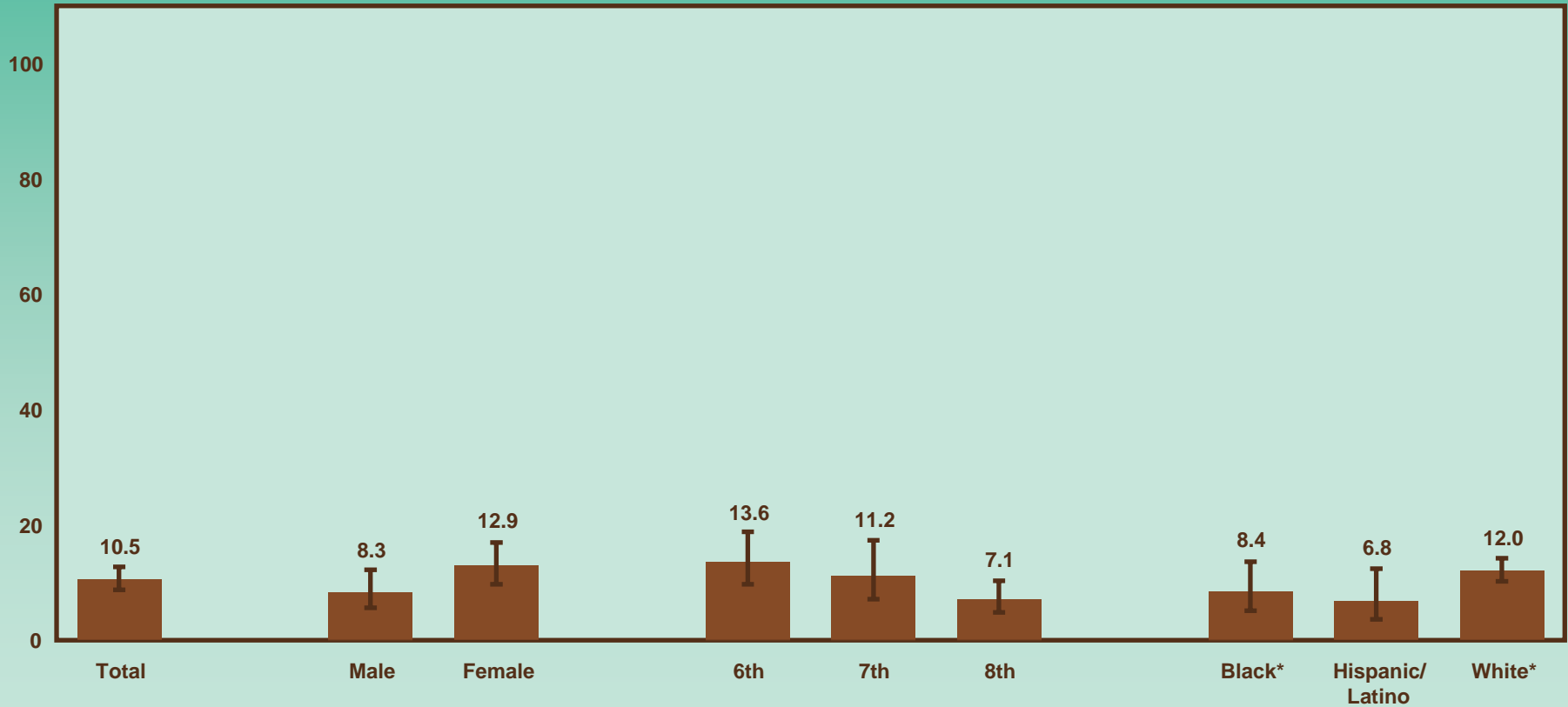

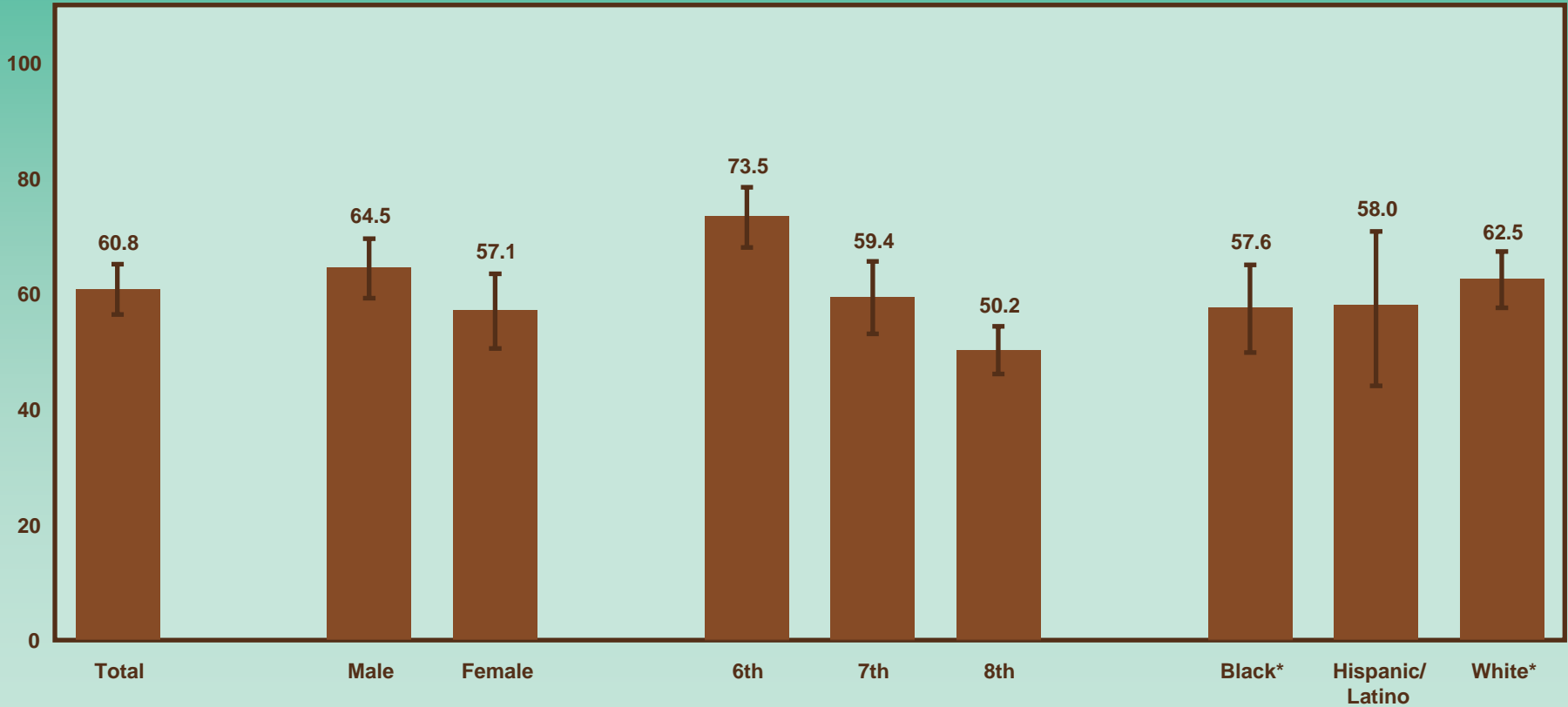

Percentage of students who get eight or more hours of sleep on an average school night

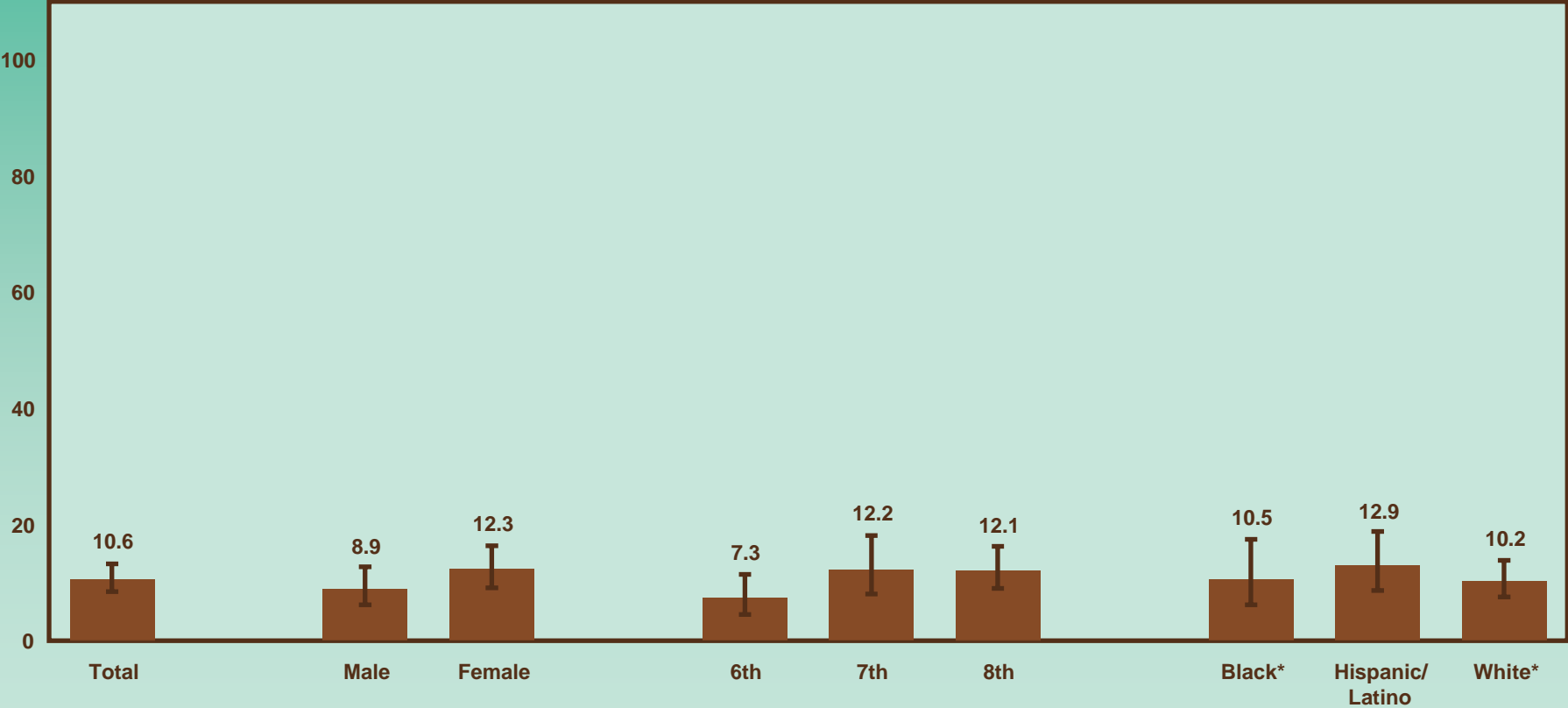

Percentage of students who consider themselves to have a disability

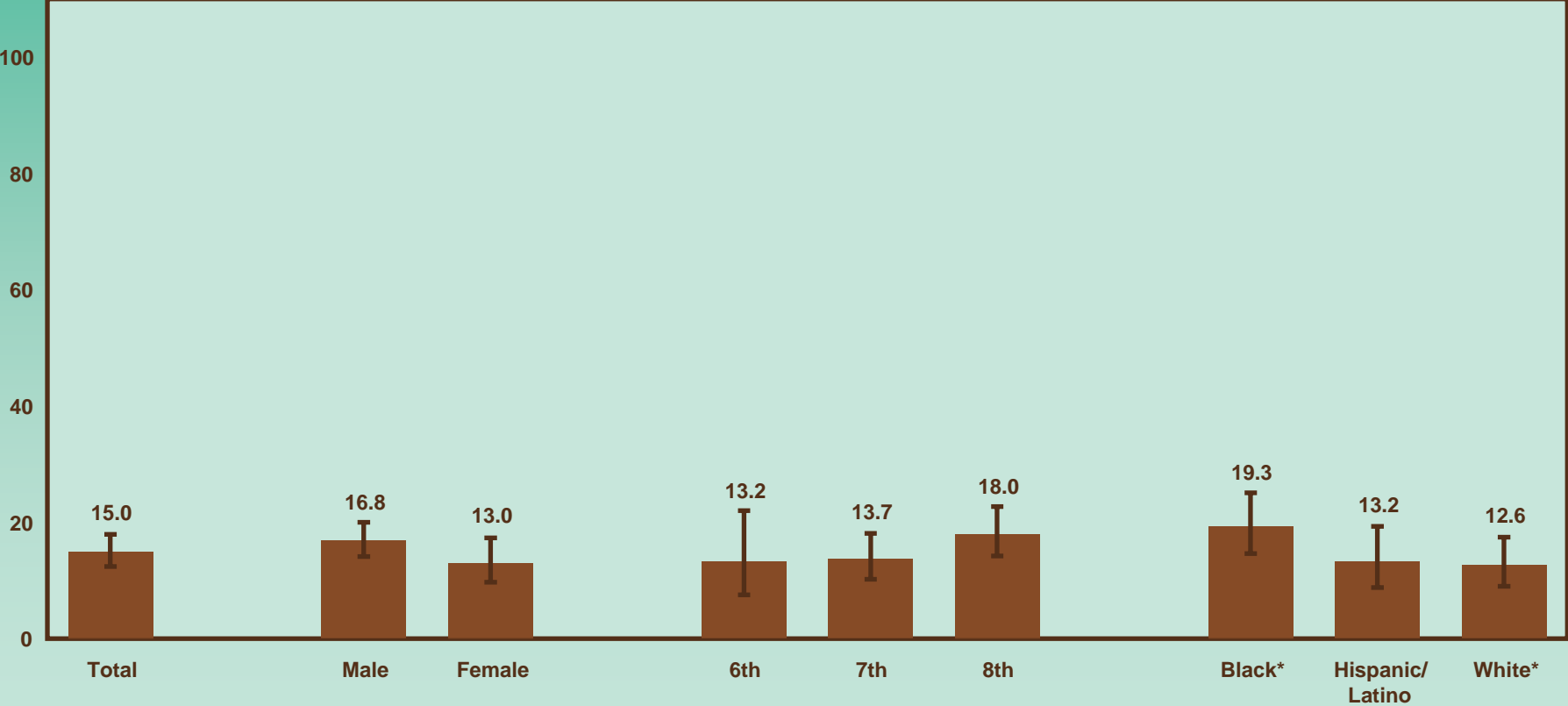

Percentage of students who are alone without a parent or adult three or more hours on an average school day

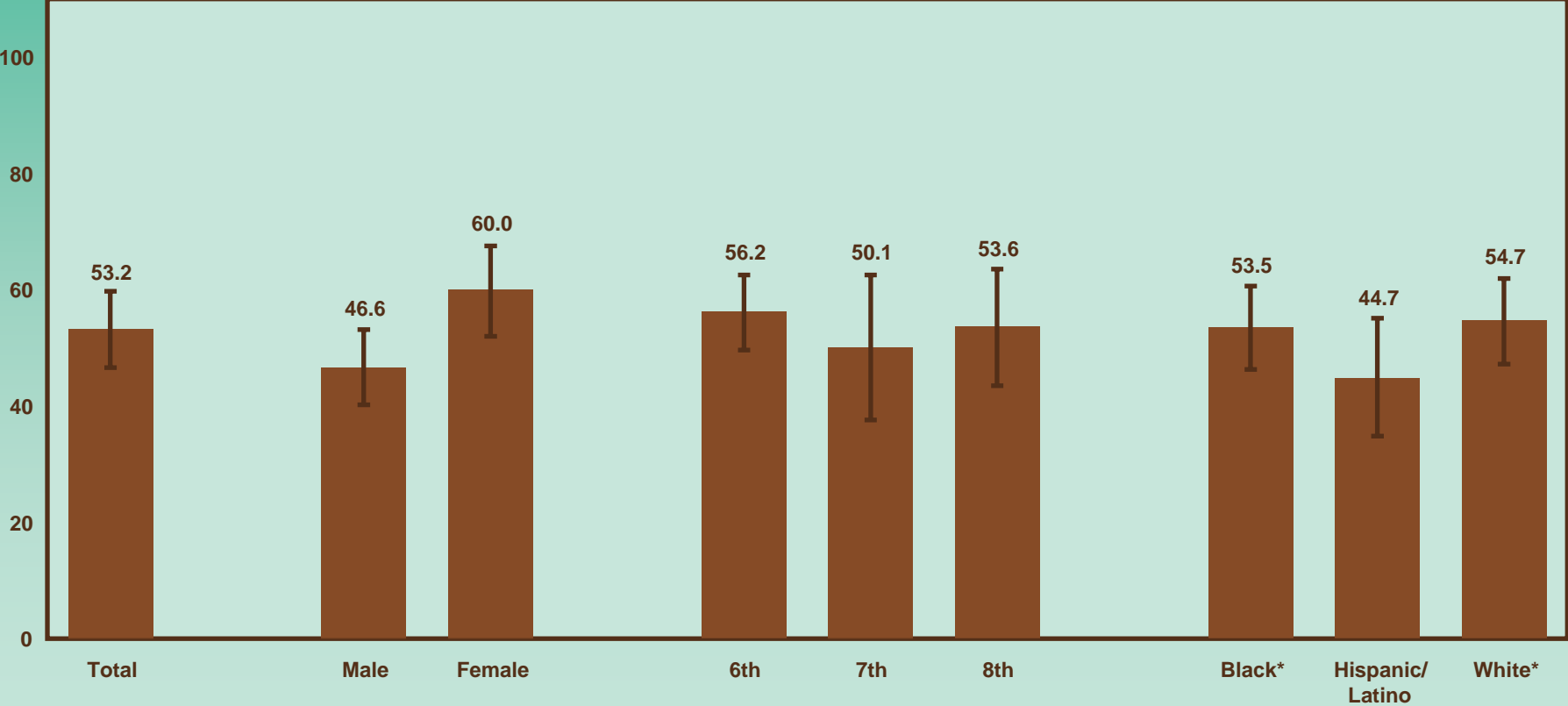

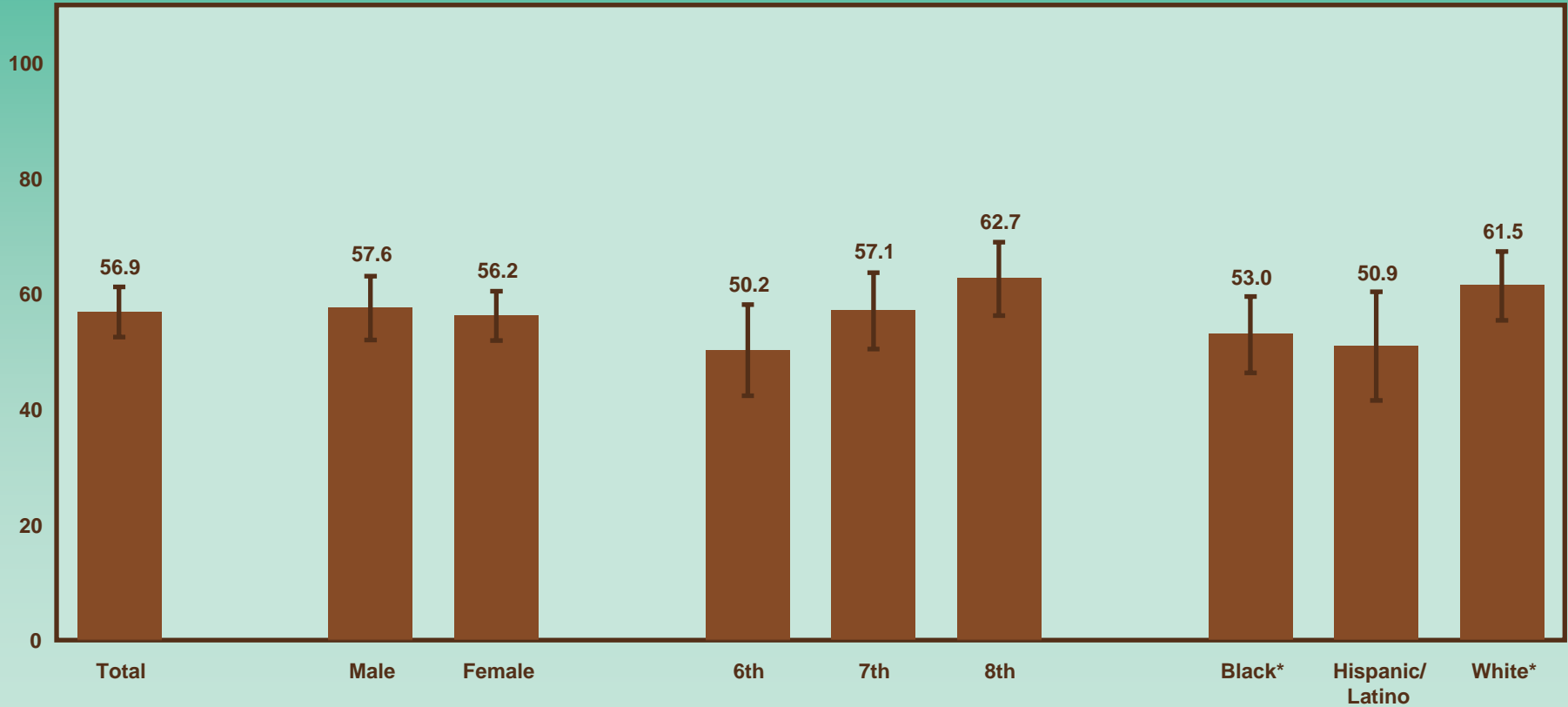

Percentage of students who last saw a doctor or nurse for a check-up or physical exam when they were not sick or injured during the past 12 months

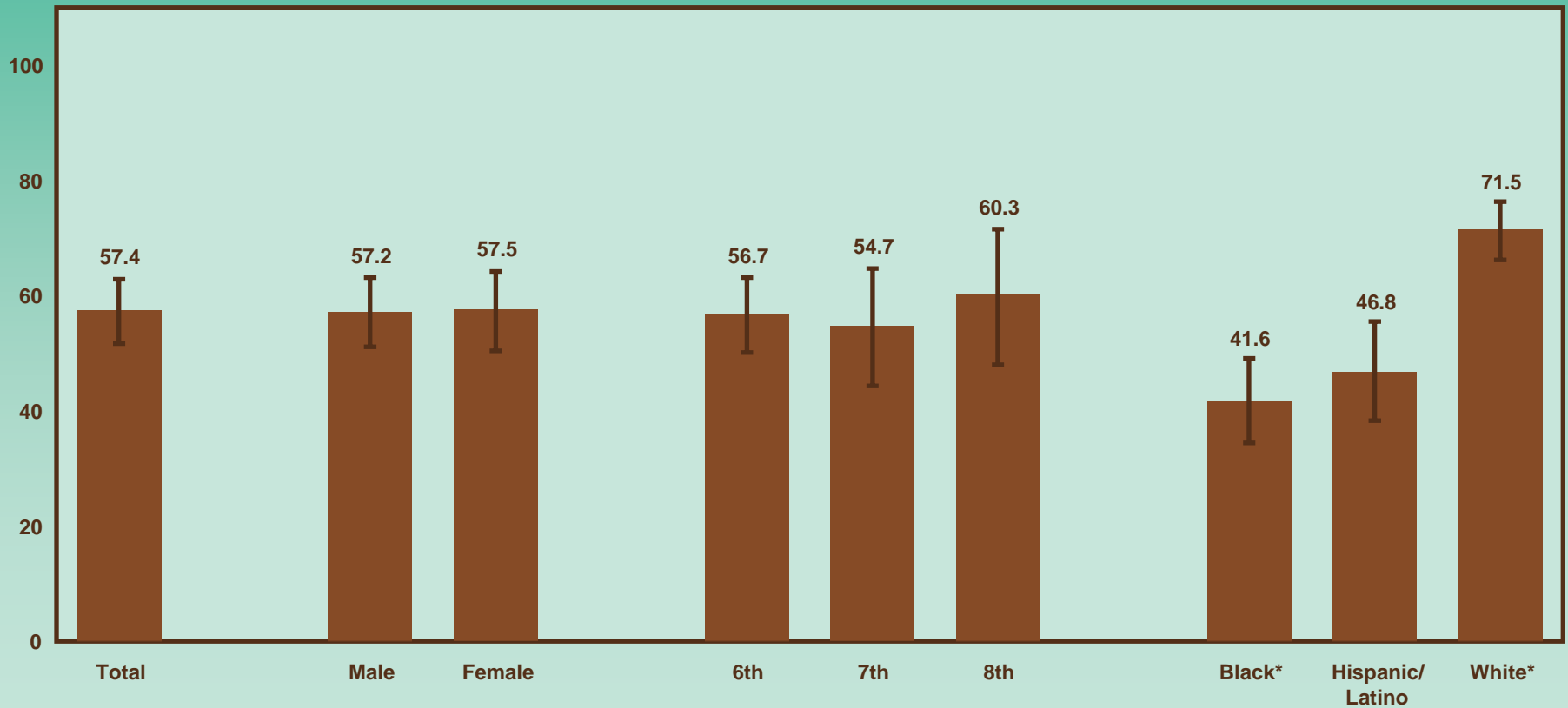

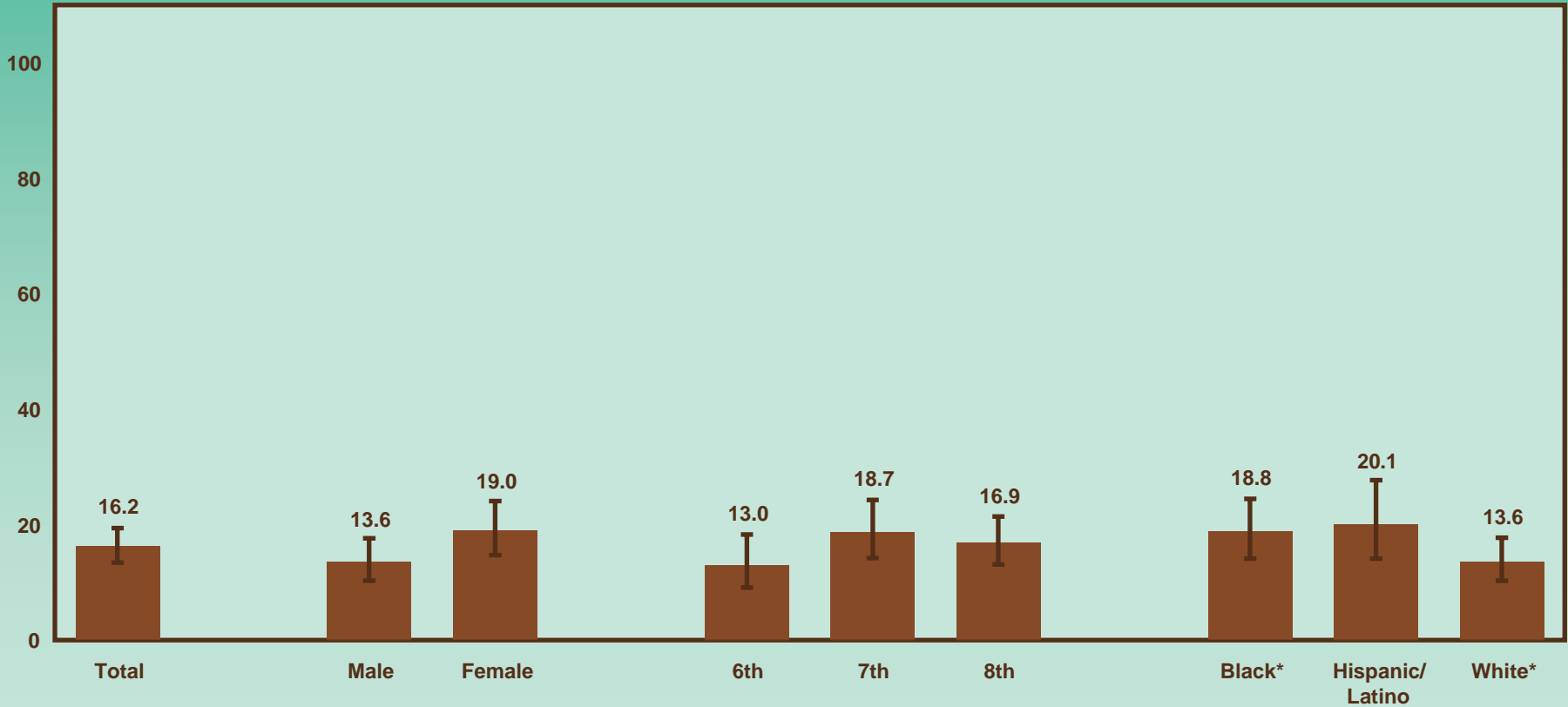

Percentage of students who strongly agree or agree that they feel alone in their life

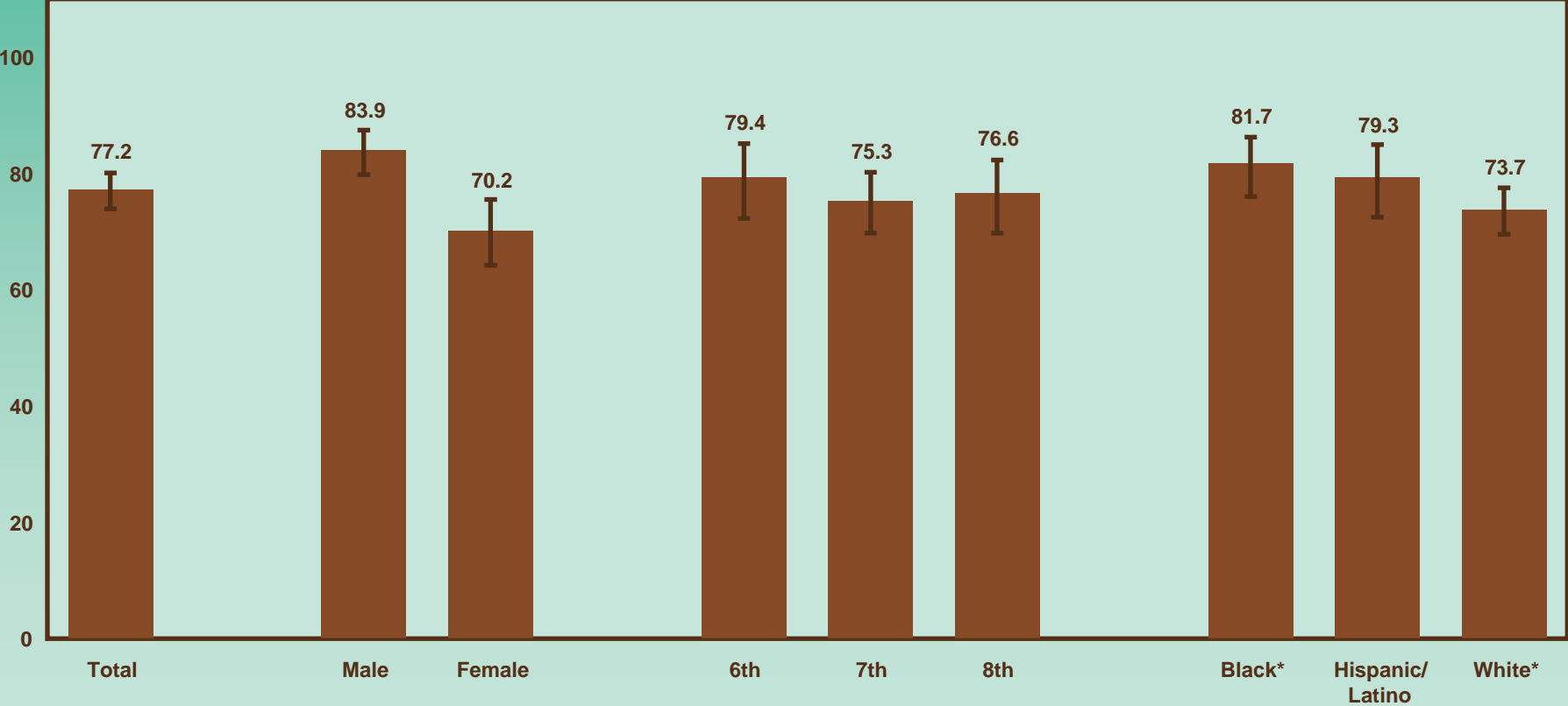

Percentage of students who strongly agree or agree that they feel good about themselves

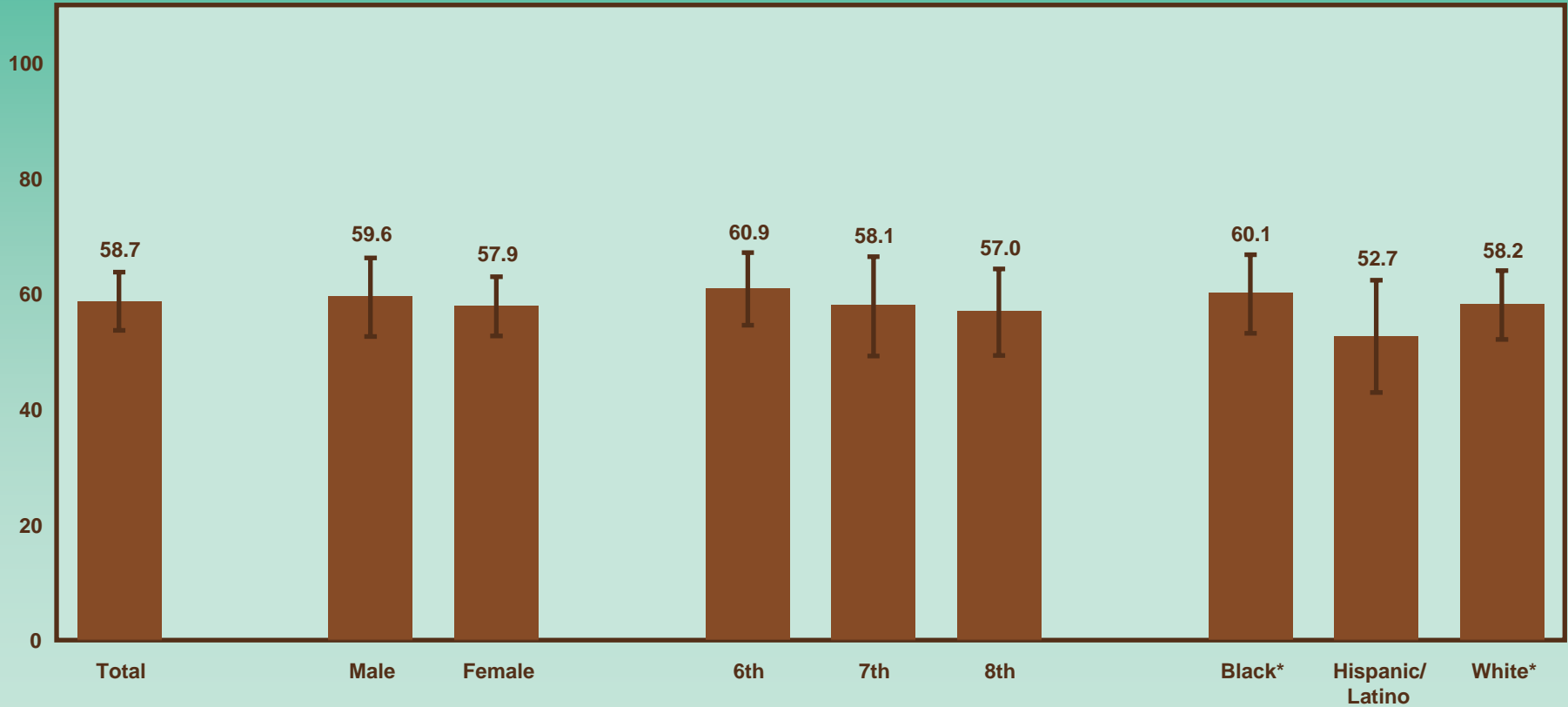

Percentage of students who strongly agree or agree that their teachers really care about them and give them a lot of encouragement

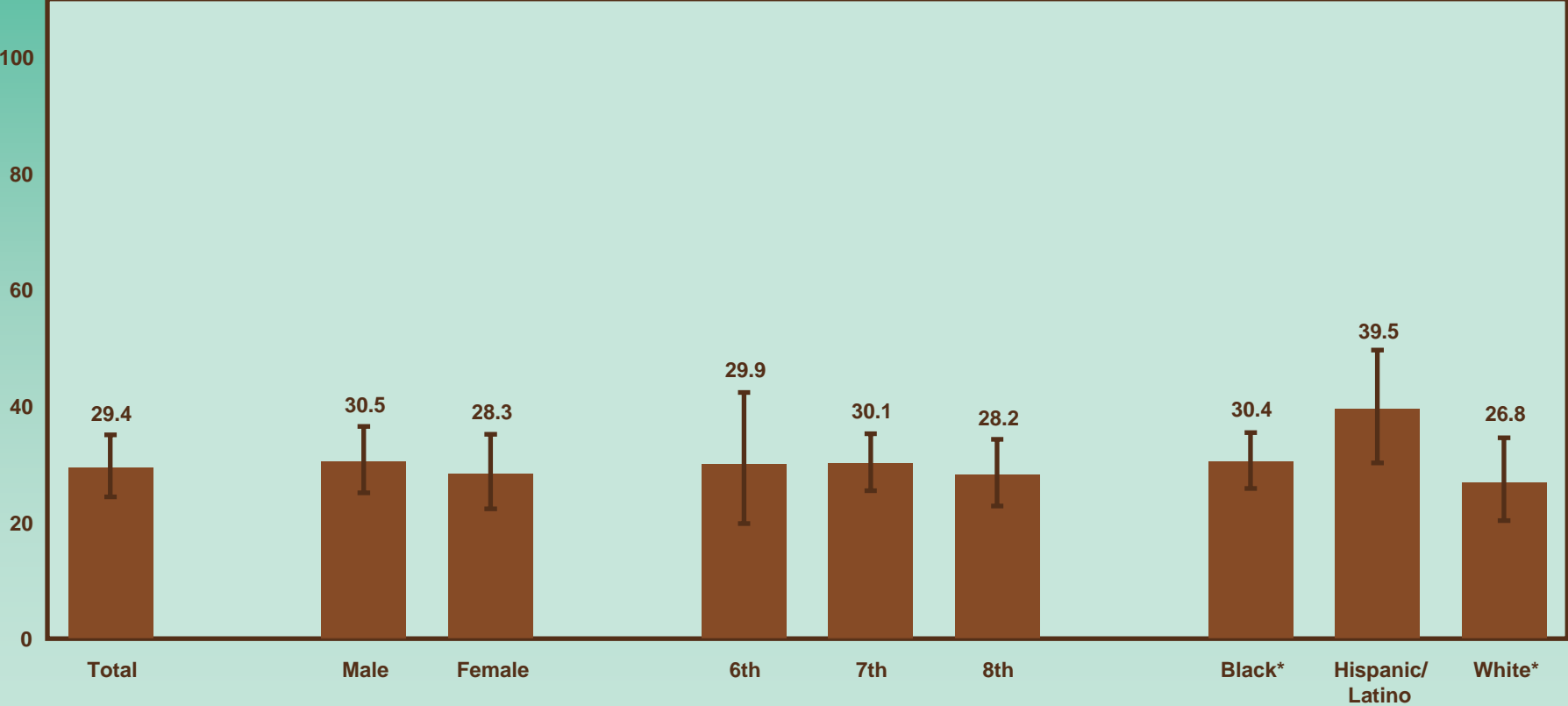

Percentage of students who strongly agree or agree that drugs are a problem at their school

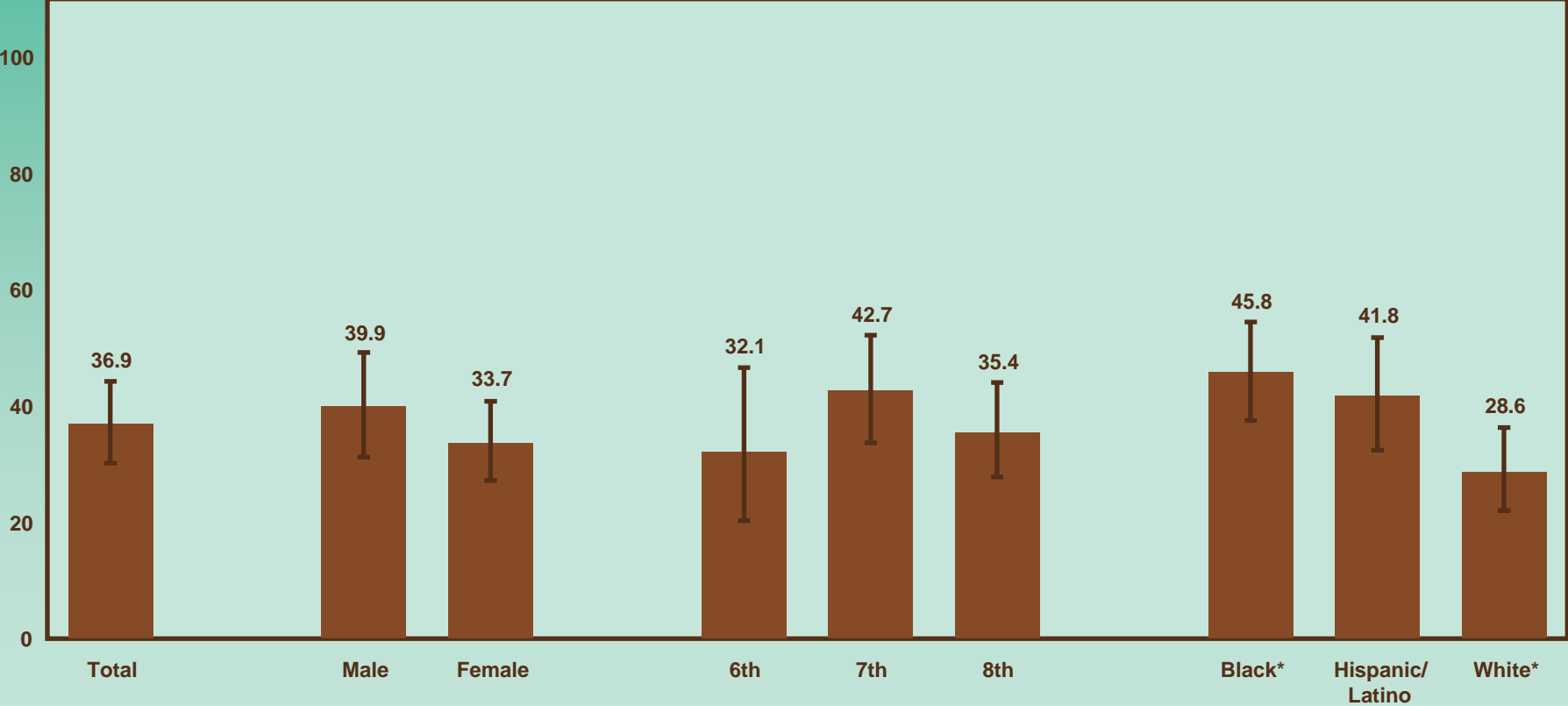
